**Ammontillado El Tresillo 1874** *Jerez Hidalgo NV £150*  
 100% Palomino aged for 8 years under Flor before 4 more years of oxidative ageing It tastes like a rich, full oxidised Fino. Despite the winning notes of dried fruit, old oak and toasted hazelnuts, has a powerful and long lovely umami-saline finish.

## Italian White Wines

**Trebbiano D'Abbruzzo** *Abruzzo Masciarelli 2022 £35*  
 100% Trebbiano d'Abruzzo grapes. Pale yellow with greenish tints, subtle flavours of green apples, yellow plums, apricots and almonds, crisp finish.

**Vermentino di Sardegna** *Sardegna Romangia 2022 £42*  
 100% Vermentino grapes. Dry, full, warm, with good firmness of flavour and texture, characteristic, well balanced, harmonious, good structure, especially delicate, elegant, with a pleasing slightly bitter finish.

**Pinot Grigio Alto Mincio IGT** *Lombardia Prendina 2020 £59*  
 100% Pinot grigio grapes. Fine concentration of flavors and highly refreshing character.

**Pecorino "Le Merlettaie"** *Marche Ciu Ciu Bio 2022 £43*  
 100% Pecorino grapes. Colour deep straw-yellow Scent very intense and persistent, grassy and hawthorn blossoms aroma, with vanilla perfume Flavour fresh and sapid.

**Gavi di Gavi** *Piemonte Picollo 2022 £43*  
 100% Cortese handpicked slightly ripe, with a golden yellow colouring. A complex aroma of ripe fruit, honey and candied fruit characterizes the wine obtained.

**Sauvignon blanc** *Friuli Forchir 2022 £43*  
 100% Sauvignon grapes. Light straw-yellow wine. Fine, fresh and harmonious aroma that brings to mind exotic fruit and melon. Aromatic, delicate and lean to the taste.

**Frascati superiore** *Lazio Marchese 2022 £44*  
 Malvasia del Lazio, Trebbiano toscano, Bonbino and Bellone grapes. hints of tropical fruit, a zesty wine, that is robust, with a soft, elegant, mouthfilling finish.

**Erbaluce "Miranda"** *Piemonte Castellengo Nat 2022 £44*  
 100% Erbaluce di Caluso. At nose has a ripe yellow stone fruit, hazelnut and acacia. On the lean, light-bodied palate, fresh acidity accompanies suggestions of ripe peach and a hint of grapefruit before finishing on a bitter note.

**Muller Thurgau doc** *Trentino Alto Adige Toblino Bio 2019 £44*  
 100% Muller Thurgau. yellow with greenish tints, hints of white flowers, apple and citrus on the nose, crisp, lively palate with green apple fruit. Good length and minerality

**Falanghina "Caulino"** *Campania Alois 2020 £44*  
 100% Falanghina grapes. delicate bouquet of tropical fruit, citron and aromatic herbs. The mouthfeel is saline, nervous, taut and very persistent

**Verdicchio "Evelyn"** *Marche Accadia 2021 £44*  
 100% Verdicchio grapes. A light orange wine, Fermentation takes place on the skins for 20/40 days, followed by the ageing on the lees for about 12 months. The aroma is persistent and rich thanks to the aromatic substances extracted. On the palate, it is well balanced, with a full and smooth taste and a pleasant savouriness.

**"Friulano" Lusor** *Friuli Venezia Giulia Forchir 2022 £58*  
 100% Tocai Friulano grape, a delicious and intensely flavoured wine a perfume of honeysuckle and tropical fruits and a long finish.

**Grillo "Fileno"** *Sicilia Canicatti 2022 £46*

100% Grillo grapes. ripe nose with tones of citrus and on the palate a rounded and depth followed by a nicely balanced finish.

**Gezuztraminer** Trentino Alto Adige Toblino Bio 2021 £52

100% Gezuztraminer grapes. elegant and aromatic white wine.

The designation "Aromatico" expresses the great intensity of this wine's bouquet

**Soave "Castelcerino"** Veneto Filippi Bio 2021 £52

100% Garganega grapes. Lovely firm yellow colour, lovely soft, creamy nose and firm

creamy nose and firm rounded flavours on the palate, with richness and length, nicely balanced.

**"Occhio di terra" Malvasia delle Lipari** Salina Caravaglio Nat 2022 £56

100% Malvasia delle Lipari, yellow with golden reflections. The palate has notes of fresh fruit with yellow flesh and hints of Mediterranean flowers.

The acidity is muted and has a long, rich finish. The grape variety "Malvasia di Lipari" is pure, powerful and finely expressed. Perfect with rich seafood dishes or white meats

**Greco di Tufo** Campania B.Ferrara 2022 £56

100% Greco di Tufo grapes. This Greco di Tufo is floral, fragrant and

crisp, with rich tropical fruits on the nose and a textured, persistent palate

made effortless by nervy acidity.

**Arancio** Marche Cà Liptra Org Bio 2018 £56

100% Trebbiano grapes, produced from a single vineyard exposed to the East on clay-gypsum soils.

It ferments with indigenous yeasts and ages for 8 months in steel.

Owes its orange nuance to maceration on the skins for about 15 days

**Vernaccia di S. Gimignano "Tradizionale"** Toscana Montenidoli Nat 2020 £56

100% Vernaccia grapes, straw-yellow, almost gold in colour.

Notes of citrus, dried herbs and almond perfumes, rich flavours.

Slight nuttiness and great minerality leading to a dry.

**Etna bianco** Sicilia Cottanera 2021 £57

100% Carricante grapes

Made with Carricante grapes, without oak to show off the wine's precision and elegance.

Bright lemon-peel and mineral notes last beautifully on the finish.

**Fiano di Avellino** Campania Favati 2019 £59

100% Fiano grapes. natural wine, organic vineyard, volcanic soils, smokey, unique flavour.

Maturation 7 months on the lees in vat

**Sicilia Bianco "Pietra Nera"** Sicilia De Bartoli Nat 2022 £64

100% Zibibbo, Pantelleria's nature is as complex as Marco's was but he managed, in that wonderfully challenging terroir, to be first to imagine that Zibibbo grapes could also successfully be vinified as a dry wine. Pietranera's grapes are grown in north facing vineyards in Cufurà district produce a wine with enviable mineral notes that is aromatic.

**Malvazja** Friuli Skerk Org £72

100% Malvazja grapes, Peculiar notes on the nose including peaches, apricots and white currants hues. It's very dry and medium-bodied, elegant on the palate, with ripe pear and fresh cut apple notes.

**Vitovska** Friuli Skerk Org 2018 £73

100% Vitovska grapes.

The Vitovska variety is apparently a cross between Prosecco Tondo and Malvasia Bianca Lunga grapes.

The grapes macerate in contact with their skins and ferment with their native yeasts the resulting wine is aged in barrels at a controlled temperature before being bottled without filtering or adding sulphites.
