

#### COOKS' ROOM


The Cooks' Room at Hawksmoor Borough, a mid-19th century former hops warehouse-come-auction hall for 'colonial and foreign fruit', is a creative hub for our chefs and unique private dining room for customers. With its own private kitchen, offering the most impressive feasting in the capital, The Cooks' Room looks and feels as though it has been there forever. The walls are lined with glazed tiles reclaimed from the London underground, the floor features parquet blocks from an RAF base in the Midlands and original black and white quarry tiles from a Welsh chapel.

A short walk from London Bridge, The Cooks' Room can be laid out for communal dining for up to 18 people. The kitchen is open-plan with cookbooks lining the shelves and a wide copper counter top, which has 4 further seats for those who wish to be even closer to the action.

### **GUILDHALL**

#### SUBLIME SOCIETY ROOM


Hawksmoor Guildhall is just a stone's throw away from what may very well be the world's first steakhouse which went by the unlikely name of Dolly's Chop House. If the story to be believed is true, it was given by Queen Anne to her favourite cook, Dorothy as a present. Dorothy first stoked up her grill between 1702 and 1714 and it was frequented regularly by the likes of Fielding, Defoe, Swift, Dryden, Boswell and Pope.

Situated in the heart of The City of London, right next to the famous Guildhall, the private dining room boasts a 22-person dining table centred in an elegant wooden panelled private room which pays tribute to the medieval history, making this a unique space for a variety of events. The discrete audio visual equipment, including a 40" flat screen also makes the space suitable for meetings and presentations.

### **SPITALFIELDS**

#### **VESTA TILLEY ROOM**

Located down the road from our namesake Nicholas Hawksmoor's Christ Church, Spitalfields was our first restaurant opened in 2006, and the general view is that it is where the 'Hawksmoor spirit' is best embodied.


The private dining room at Hawksmoor Spitalfields is named in honour of local legend Vesta Tilley, a trailblazing gender-bending music hall star who played to packed houses across the road at the once-was Royal Cambridge. The highest paid star of the day she mimicked and mocked men from all walks of life. Beloved by men and women, she broke down barriers of gender and class, achieving stardom and social change every time she took to the floor.

A mere 2 minutes' walk from Shoreditch High Street and 10 minutes' walk from Liverpool Street, Old Street and Aldgate stations, the Vesta Tilley Room is ideal for private hire for groups of up to 55. The space is perfect for team lunches, private dinners and other celebrations.

### WOOD WHARF

#### **QUEENIE WATTS**


Hawksmoor Wood Wharf takes inspiration from our first international launch in New York and from the Golden Age of Travel: the glamour of Hawksmoor in Manhattan, with a little high-end ocean liner mixed in. A stone's throw from Canary Wharf station, the ground floor restaurant has a dramatic, double-height dining space featuring a marble-topped bar and vibrant green leather banquette seating, all elegantly lit by bespoke chandeliers.

Seating up to 20 people, our <u>private dining room</u> is named after local legend Queenie Watts. Back in the early sixties rowdy dockers, gangsters (the Krays and more), celebrities and thrill-seeking high society flocked to see Queenie – singer, songwriter, actor and self-confessed bawdy landlady (think Peggy Mitchell meets Joni Mitchell) – and she welcomed them all. "I just love people. People are life, aren't they?" Pictures of Queenie adorn the walls and while it may not be quite in keeping with her boozer, the long-gone Iron Bridge Tavern, we hope she would approve.
