Picpoul de Pinet 'La Viste' Languedoc, France 2019 Aromas of red apple and blossom deliver a palate that is dry and bursting with mouthwatering fruit and acidity.	10	26	37
Garnacha Blanca Nativa Care, Carinena, Spain 2019 Packed with juicy, ripe tropical fruit but balanced by refreshing acidity. Rather like squeezing a piece of lime onto a plate of cool tropical fruit. Dangerously moreish.	10.25	28	40
Gavi di Gavi 'Figini' La Chiara, Piedmont, Italy 2019 The palate echoes the nose with fresh green apples and citrus but with the addition of a riper edge. The finish is clean and dry with a delicate pith and almond bite.	12	31	44
Grechetto Antonelli, DOC Montefalco Italy 2020 (Organic) The structure makes this a worthy wine to have with food. A light concentration of fruit is enveloped within a frame of fennel, lemon and a pithy note that adds a pleasant almond bitterness to the finish. Try with cheese too.	12.25	31	44
Chenin Blanc Oldenburg, Banghoek Valley Stellenbosch, South Africa 2018 A truly beguiling wine. Weighty, textural and complex, this is not your average Chenin. Nero d'Avola Cipollina, Sicily, Italy 2018 Light, fine tannins that offer gentle grip to the damson fruit. An all round soft, easy drinker.	8.50	23	32
Pinot Noir 'Sanziana' Recas Cramele, Benat, Romania 2019 *available chilled* Pretty and delicate but loaded with strawberry fruit and classic Pinot character. It finishes with a dash of darker fruits, hint of spice and delicate tannins. Superb value.	9.75	27	37
Primitivo Varvaglione, Puglia, Italy 2018 (Organic) Succulent plum, damson and red fruits epitomise this grape and region. A total crowd pleaser and oh-so-moreish.	11	30	42
Pedra a Pedra Tinto Quinta da Pedra Alta, Douro Portugal, 2018 *available chilled* A generous , fuller red, laden with plum and boysenberry fruit flavours, a touch of richness and light dusting of spice. The finish long with fine tannins. One to savour and enjoy.	11.50	31	44
Pinot Noir Stoneburn, <i>Marlborough, New Zealand 2018</i> Firm fruited with cherry leading the charge and a smokey edge. Light grip brightened up by gentle acidity. A smokey, toasty, super pale Pinot loaded with flavour.	12	32	46
