THE BLOOMS BURY

THE STAGE FOR A NEW CONVERSATION IN LONDON'S LITERARY HEARTLAND

In the beating heart of London, close to Theatreland, The British Museum, and Covent Garden, The Bloomsbury, a magnificent Edwin Lutyens' Grade II-listed, neo-Georgian building sits amid the historic 18th century neighbourhood of the same name; a literary heartland filled with galleries, antiquarian bookshops and a wealth of cultural heritage. Following a multimillion pound redesign, the hotel has been sensitively and beautifully transformed.

Complementing the grandeur of The Bloomsbury are its broad range of meeting and event spaces. The expansive George V and Queen Mary Halls are stately ballrooms with lofty ceilings and Waterford crystal chandeliers. While the double-height, Lutyensdesigned Chapel and the book-lined, Chesterfield-laden Seamus Heaney Library – offer more intimate event spaces with real character.





GEORGE V HALL

The imposing and striking George V Hall offers an unusually large and eclectic space for such a central London location. Original high windows and lofty ceilings flood the room with natural light, complementing the stunning contemporary interiors and bespoke Waterford Crystal chandeliers.

Located on the ground floor of the hotel, with natural daylight, fully air conditioned. The dimensions of the room are: 26 x 10.3 and its maximum capacity is 160 delegates in cabaret style.

THE CHAPEL

Recalling the building's original incarnation as the flagship of the Young Women's Christian Association, the now deconsecrated chapel is a spectacular Lutyens-designed hall with double-height ceilings, original architectural features, elegant furnishings and magnificent chandeliers.

Located on the 1st floor of the hotel, with natural daylight, fully air conditioned. The dimensions of the room are: 9.1 x 6.7 and maximum capacity of 30 delegates in theatre style.







THE SEAMUS HEANEY LIBRARY

An intimate, central London setting with book-lined walls, The Seamus Heaney Library is named after the Nobel Prizewinning Irish poet, playwright and translator, who was a regular guest at the hotel and personally opened the refurbished room in July 2011. A unique and atmospheric space, it houses hundreds of first editions dating from the 1930s as well as a range of 20th century classics. Located on the first floor of the hotel, with natural daylight, fully air conditioned. The room dimensions are 9.6 x 6.8 and the maximum capacity is 40 delegates in theatre style.

QUEEN MARY HALL

With its exquisite original features, lofty ceiling height, beautiful Waterford Crystal chandeliers and the option of a separate bar area, the Queen Mary Hall is the ideal venue for dinner-dances, banquets and a wide range of other large-scale events. Located on the 2nd floor of the hotel, with natural daylight, fully air conditioned. The room can accommodate 110 delegates in a cabaret style or 250 delegates in caberet style

THE BEDFORD SUITES

Located on the lower ground floor of the hotel, the Bedford Suites offer flexible meeting space for either boardroom or theatre style. Located on the lower ground floor of the hotel, these rooms are fully air conditioned but do not have natural daylight.

THE TAVISTOCK SUITES

Tavistock Suite is located on the lower ground floor, fully air conditioned with partial natural daylight. Designed as a blank canvas space, as it is a spacious room with lots of flexibility on the layout and the opportunities for personalisation.


