



Our Fish

Our fish is 100% sustainably sourced. We supply MSC certified and all our suppliers comply with conservation guide good fish to eat along with ASC, GAP and BAP accredited practices.



Our Tea

Our tea supplier is UK supplier Clipper, chosen for its Fairtrade and sustainable credentials- natural. biodegradable, organic & B corp certified.



Vegan/Vegetarian

We offer a Green DDR with all plantbased menu. Ask for more details. We always offer a Vegetarian/Vegan options to our meals and clearly label those options. In 2023 41% of main courses on menus across all Elior sites were Vegan and Vegetarian.



We adopt Red Tractor standards for fresh meat from our UK suppliers. All eggs are sourced from the UK and Red Lion accredited. We have a range of free range and organic products. As part of our carbon reduction strategy we have replaced high carbon ingredients with low carbon based proteins.



Healthy Eating

We provide innovative and nutritious dishes which are dietitian approved and contain a balance of macro and micronutrients to support the health and wellbeing of our quests.



Our Produce

Working closely with our catering partner 'Elior' favouring sustainable choices - our event menus are local and seasonal, and the majority of products we source are British and do not involve high air miles.



We carefully specify the correct amount of food we produce. In the case, we do have food waste, after being enjoyed by staff or offered on the 'to good to go' app - any leftover is processed in our bio-digester to provide compost for our grounds team to use on campus.



We are a certified Fairtrade University and serve Fairtrade and ethically sourced coffee.



Special dietary requirements

Please let us know if there are any special diets. We cater to all special and religious dietary requirements and it is very important for us to create an inclusive environment for all.



Packaging

We use crockery and glassware where possible. If we do need to use disposable catering products, these are supplied by Vegware, all their products are plant-based and compostable. Any waste is processed in our bio-digester.

We provide and promote ethically sourced food and drink. All suppliers must adhere to our charters for ethical procurement.
