This glorious glass and stone venue flooded with natural daylight is located in one of London's most beautiful settings, within the grounds of Holland Park.

Outside, venture through the fragrant rose garden as the scent drifts across the lawn encapsulating the ambience of the day. Just a stone's throw away you will find the tranquil Kyoto Garden featuring a Japanese-style landscape adding a unique charm to this beautiful location.

Regarded as a true hidden gem in Kensington, the Orangery, Holland Park is the perfect backdrop for a range of corporate and private events, including wedding ceremonies and receptions, summer parties, drinks receptions, dinners and luncheons.

HERITAGE

Holland Park is the Royal Borough's largest park, featuring 22.5 hectares of gardens, it boasts children's play facilities, sports areas, a café and large areas of woodland abundant with wildlife, including friendly squirrels and proud peacocks.

The park grounds originally belonged to Sir Walter Cope who built Cope Castle in the early 17th century, a large Jacobean mansion hidden in the woods.

The Earl of Holland's wife, Lady Rich, inherited the property and it was renamed Holland House. The Orangery was built by the fourth Lord Holland in 1849 as part of extensive improvements to the grounds. The building then played host to Lord and Lady Holland's many receptions and to this day boasts elegance and charm.
