The BP Lecture Theatre has fixed tiered seating for 323 people, a raised stage, lectern, four translation booths, large screen and an audio-visual control room providing access to state-of-the-art projection equipment.

Included in the hire of the theatre is the East Foyer, an elegant curved space suitable for registration, refreshments, exhibition stands, displays, branding and a cloakroom. All delegates can be served a standing lunch or drinks reception here, and up to 150 people can enjoy a seated meal.

The Hugh & Catherine Stevenson Lecture Theatre is suited to presentations, lectures, product launches, screenings, performances, AGMs, press conferences and road shows.

The Hugh & Catherine Stevenson Lecture Theatre is an elegant auditorium with fixed tiered seating for 142 delegates. It is fully equipped with a screen, lectern, two translation booths and an audio-visual control room fully fitted out with state-of-the-art projection equipment.

Included in the hire of this theatre is the use of the West Foyer and cloakroom. This is an ideal space for registration, refreshments, displays, branding, exhibitions or breakout sessions. All delegates can be served a standing lunch or drinks reception here, and up to 150 people can enjoy a seated meal.

The Claus Moser Room offers a flexible layout and is just the right size for seminars, presentations, brainstorming sessions, or breakout space on the side of a larger event. This versatile space can be set up theatre style for 35, as a boardroom for 18, or as a classroom for 16 delegates. The room is fitted with audio-visual equipment, and has wheelchair access. This room is available as a stand-alone space or as a breakout area when hiring other spaces in the Centre.

The Raymond & Beverly Sackler Rooms offer you flexible spaces for brainstorming sessions, seminars, presentations or as a breakout room.

The two rooms can be used as one large space or separately for smaller meetings and events using the soundproof temporary partition.

Each room can hold up to 45 delegates theatre style, 18 boardroom style, or 20 classroom style. Alternatively the two rooms can be joined together to create one larger space accommodating 90 in a theatre style, 35 as a boardroom, 45 as a classroom, or 50 for a cabaret style layout. The rooms can be arranged to suit your seminar schedule.

The Studio is an intimate space providing an ideal breakout area during conferences or a stand-alone space for brainstorming sessions, seminars or presentations.

The Studio can be hired as a meeting room or as part of an add-on to other rooms. It can convert from theatre seating for 35 to a boardroom for 18 or a classroom for 16.

It comes with the use of audio-visual equipment and a resilient laminate flooring for practical workshop sessions.

The East and West foyers are used in conjunction with the BP and Stevenson Lecture Theatres respectively but can be hired individually for receptions, dinners or as an exhibition space.

The foyers extend the aesthetics of the Great Court and are constructed from limestone, providing a clean, sophisticated space in which to impress guests or delegates. They provide a welcome 'blank canvas' for clients wishing to brand the space and to exhibit their company or products with elegance and style.

The large open space of the foyers is also perfect as a venue for a seated dinner for up to 120 people or a reception for up to 329. Each foyer has ample space for registration and cloakroom facilities.
