A great champion of British excellence, the House of Commons has carefully selected Arundel-based Digby Fine English as the maker of its official English sparkling wine. The wine selected is the new vintage of Digby’s flagship style, which is often held up as one of the finest wines in the country.

The House of Commons Vintage English sparkling wine has been aged in the cellars for seven years prior to release and shows a personality which combines Digby’s signature English freshness with a deep, rich complexity and long finish. It all comes with a bottle design honouring the first wine bottle in modern times, which was invented by Sir Kenelm Digby.

The first vines were planted in 1973, when local wine retailer Alan McKechnie started harvesting the vines on his small fruit farm. With a little help from the 1976 record summer temperatures and bumper harvest, his small fruit farm began to expand. Under the ownership of John Oldacre the vineyards flourished and the name was changed from Fairfield Fruit Farms to Three Choirs Vineyards due largely to John's connections to the Three Choirs Festival, England's oldest choral festival.

A crisp, refreshing wine with distinctly English hedgerow aromas and hints of crisp apple, fragrant elderflower and freshly cut grass. The ripe fruit flavours, balanced acidity and subtle residual sugar combine to create a refreshing wine, perfect on its own or with fish dishes.

The Artacho family had a long history of winemaking and winemaking traditions when they founded Bodegas Riojanas with Rafael Carreras in 1890. After the restoration of the vineyards destroyed by phylloxera, the times of prosperity began in 1930. In 1933, the French winemaker Gabriel Larrendat returned to his country after several years of work at Bodegas Riojanas, he oversaw the production and aging of wines, and it was he who christened one of the winery's wines "Monte Real", the name under which wines are still produced today. Today, Bodegas Riohanas is one of the largest producers of Rioja with over 100 years of history, which harmoniously combines advanced technology and tradition in the manufacturing process.
