TIME TO CELEBRATE

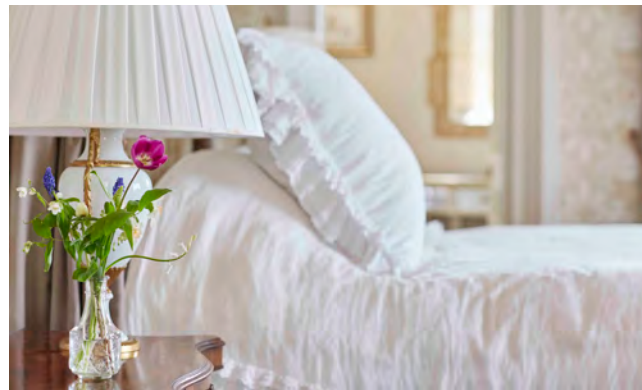
Dance the night away with live music and dancing in the Dining Room where you and your guests can celebrate until the early hours.

WIDER ESTATE ACCOMMODATION



Located just a few minutes' drive from Cowdray House are four rural holiday cottages that sleep 13 guests.

The Lodge sleeps 16 guests and offers Bed and Breakfast.

Across the Estate, over 70 wedding guests can be accommodated overnight.





STAY A WHILE

Guests can enjoy the amazing facilities when staying at Cowdray House including indoor and outdoor swimming pools, bowling alley and tennis court. There is also the opportunity to make use of the activities on the wider Estate from a round of golf on the 18-hole championship course, to fly fishing for brown trout on the River Rother, wildlife tours and clay pigeon shooting.



Cowdray is the home of British polo and the sport is played throughout the summer months. Lessons and tickets to polo matches can also be arranged.
