## Bar arrangements

A fully licensed bar on board serves alcoholic, soft and hot beverages accepting cash and card payments.

We include a welcome drink in our standard hire package as this allows guests to have a drink at the start and relieves pressure on the bar, so guests are not queuing for a long time.

The bar will close 30 minutes before the end of the event to allow guests to finish their drinks and aid disembarkation.

There are several options on how the bar can operate for your event.

Cash or Card	Guests can purchase their own beverages during the cruise.
Account bar	Guests can order drinks from the bar or have stations set up around the boat with a selection of drinks that will be recorded until the end of the cruise when the account will need to be settled. The account can be invoiced after the event, but a 10% admin charge will be applied. You can specify or restrict what guests can order on accounts, such as no shots or double-measure spirits.
Pre-paid limit	You can put a set amount behind the bar, for example, £500, that guests can use to purchase their drinks. Once this amount is used, the bar will revert to a cash or card arrangement. If you would like, a bar team member can come and find you once we are close to the limit to see if you would like to extend this to a new amount. A signature from you would be required to authorise the new limit. You can specify or restrict what guests can order, such as no shots or double-measure spirits.
Drinks Package	There are a selection of drinks packages available, please see the separate page that can be chosen for guests to enjoy.
Corkage	If we are unable to source the drinks that you would like, we do accept corkage at the following rates per bottle:
	Wine (750ml) - £8.00 Sparkling Wine (750ml) - £10.00 Champagne (750ml) - £12.00 beer (565ml) £1.50)
