You can create the perfect wedding to suit your requirements. With a variety of rooms available, you can hold just your ceremony or just your reception. Alternatively, have everything under one roof.

York House Gardens

York House is famous for its beautiful gardens located at the back of the house. Many features of the grounds remain from Sir Ratan Tata's previous ownership in the late 19th Century including the sunken lawn, marble statues and the restored Japanese gardens. These all provide an elegant

background for photographs which lead down to the riverside.

Exclusive access to the gardens is not guaranteed as they are public.



Clarendon Hall

The Clarendon Hall is the largest of all our licenced rooms. It has a stage, dressing rooms and a grand piano. A PA system and stage lighting are available for hire. The room is licensed for up to 280 guests for a ceremony. This room can also be used for a sit down wedding breakfast for up to 150 guests. Should you require more space for your wedding, the Clarendon Hall connects to the Hyde Room next door. This can provide seating for an additional 60 guests, and is perfectly positioned for a photo-booth, entertainment or evening buffet.



The Hyde Room

The room can accommodate a ceremony for up to 70 guests. Alternatively, it can be used for a drinks and canapés reception following a ceremony.

If you are having your wedding breakfast in Clarendon Hall and require more space, the Hyde Room can accommodate a further 48 guests when seated alternatively. The room is perfectly positioned to provide ample space for a photo-booth, entertainment or an evening buffet when hosting your sit down meal in the Clarendon Hall, as an additional space when used in conjunction with the Salon.



Winter Garden

The Winter Garden is a beautiful Victorian conservatory with a black and white marble tiled floor and a variety of plants. It can be accessed directly from the Salon and in turn leads out onto the terrace and the sunken lawn. The Winter Garden is licensed for up to 50 guests for a ceremony. The Winter Garden is a perfect place for drinks following a ceremony in the Salon or the Terrace Room. It is also a great space for guests to mingle while you are having photographs taken in the gardens.

The room can accommodate a small party of 40 people for a seated wedding breakfast, during which you can access the terrace. If choosing to have your wedding breakfast or buffet in the Salon, the Winter Garden can provide a superb setting for an evening of dancing.



The Salon

The Salon is an ornate room at the front of the house with a beautiful chandelier. The room is licensed for ceremonies for up to 70 guests. The Salon can also be used for a sit down meal, which can accommodate up to 60 guests, or 80 guests for a drinks reception. Venture through the mirrored doors and into the light airiness of the Winter Garden for the perfect setting to toast your ceremony. We offer a combined reception-hire rate for both the Salon and Winter Garden. When both rooms are hired, they can accommodate up to 120 guests for a canapé and champagne reception or 100 for a seated meal.



Terrace Room

The Terrace Room is a traditional room at the back of the house which overlooks the gardens, and allows for direct access to the terrace leading onto the gardens. This is licensed for 40 seated guests and 10 standing.

Following a ceremony in either the Salon or Winter Garden, the Terrace Room can provide a space for you and guests to toast your ceremony and enjoy canapés. You can also use the terrace and public gardens for photos.



Options available at York House

York House is steeped in history and is adorned with many portraits and canvases, providing a perfect setting for a truly memorable wedding. We offer a choice of beautifully unique spaces to suit your wedding day wishes.

You are welcome to have your wedding with us at York House on a Friday afternoon, Saturday or Sunday. It may be possible to book your wedding during the week pending the availability of our rooms. Please ask a member of staff from the Hall Lettings Team for availability.

With the variety of rooms available, we can offer a ceremony, drinks reception or evening reception all within our unique venue giving you the flexibility of choosing to celebrate part of, or all of your day with us.

With a list of experienced caterers who have worked at York House and are familiar with our venue or the option of choosing your own caterer, the possibilities are endless.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do you provide furniture, tableware and cooking utensils?

Tables and chairs are provided. Your caterer will need to provide all the linen, crockery, cutlery, glassware and cooking/serving utensils etc.

Can I serve alcohol?

Yes, we are licensed for you to give alcohol away but not to sell it. If you wish to provide alcohol for your guests free of charge you are welcome to do this as long as you purchase/sale of alcohol takes place off site. There is a Small corkage fee. If you would like to have a pay bar then you would need to hire in one of the Council's approved bar service providers (Please note that you are only allowed to use an approved bar supplier).

What is the latest time the rooms are available?

We are licensed until 1am on a Friday and Saturday, and midnight on a Sunday. All music/entertainment and bar must cease 1 hour before the end of the booking to adhere to Licensing regulations so that adequate time is left for clearing to ensure the building is vacated by the end of the hire time.

Is the registrar included with the cost of the room?

You will need to book and pay for the registrar separately. Please call 0208 891 1411 for more information or see www.richmond.gov.uk and select Registration Services under the A-Z menu

How long can I provisionally hold our wedding date for?

We can hold up to two provisional dates for 14 days'.

How do I confirm my booking?

We ask for your booking form(s) to be completed and sent back to us. We shall then confirm the costs and will require a 25% non-refundable deposit to be made.

Do you offer a discount for multiple rooms?

We have combined room hire rates when having a drinks and dinner reception in the Clarendon Hall & Hyde Room, and the Salon & Winter Garden.
