13. TE AKA SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND



The gentle aroma of an sunny garden in a glass! Bursting with an apple green hue with enticing aromas of guava and melon, interlaced with tomato leaf and ripe herbal notes and subtle grapefruit are supported by a succulent stimulating and moreish acidity.

14. CAMEL & JOSEPH VILLA BLANCE CHARDONAY, IGP PAYS D'OC, FRANCE



Often typified by warm tropical fruit and a touch of oak. It has a lovely aroma of ripe citrus, nectarine and passionfruit, with characteristics such as peach, apricot, nectarine, pineapple, passionfruit, melon and butter.

15. SEA CHANGE PINOT GRIGIO, TERRE DI CHIETI, ITALY



Full of bright citrus fruit: the zest of ripe lemons is married beautifully with the delicate floral notes of Jasmine and Orange Blossom. On the palate, the wine's lively acidity and underlying minerality make it mouth-wateringly moreish.

16. TERRE DE LUMIERE VIOGNIER LANGUEDOC- ROUSSILLON, FRANCE



The unique mix of terrains here makes for an extensive array of wines, all boasting a trademark freshness and juicy fruit. This Viognier is no exception, with orange blossom notes and ripe, orchard fruit flavours

17. GEWÜRZTRAMINER, PARAIISO SUR, CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

Typically grown in the cool regions of Alsace and Germany, this Gewürztraminer's tropical flavours shine through prominently thanks to the temperate climate of the valley. Medium-bodied and off-dry, lending plenty of floral aromas of jasmine, rose and lychee, complimented by a persistent fruity finish.

RED

13. COTE DU RHONE VIGNOBLES GONNET, FRANCE 🌿

Bertrand and his brother Guillaume's combined international experience makes for a beautifully balanced range of wines at the family run Vignobles Gonnet. Their Côtes du Rhone is exceptional for its elegance and structure, exuding all the violet, dried herb and spicy dark fruit for which the appellation is fameuse.

29. LANGTIDES ESTATE, NEMEA AGIORGITIKO, PELOPONEESOS, GREECE

A robust, unoaked Malbec hailing from the heart of the southernmost wine region of Argentina. The combination of mountainous soils, warm days and cool nights results in a fresh, pure and expressive wine. The palate velvety, structured and teeming with plenty of juicy, dark fruits.

29. MALBEC, ALPATACO, PATAGONIA, ARGENTINA 🍷

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29. VERGELEGEN RESERVA, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, SOUTH AFRICA 🌿

This is a medium to full bodied beautiful red wine with subtle flavour hints of Bramble fruit, tobacco notes and spice, supple tannins and a long finish fruits.

30. TEMPRANILLO, BODEGAS PRÍNCIPE, DE VIANA, RIOJA, SPAIN

Initial ripe, red cherries on the nose, diving into deep black fruits and hints of toast, cinnamon and toffee. Structured and meaty, this is a vivacious Crianza!

32. PIQUEPOUL NOIR, VILLA BLANCHE, LANGUEDOC, FRANCE 🍷🌿

Due to its scarcity following the phylloxera epidemic, single variety Picpoul Noirs are rare and mysterious! The nose is fresh and floral with notes of cherry, woodland and star anise. The palate is equally as delectable and juicy, flowing with strawberry, pomegranate, redcurrants, and a touch of peppermint. Irresistibly versatile!

36. MERLOT/CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CHATEAU ARGADENS, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 🌿



Clad in a beautiful hue of garnet, this wine has a rich, intense aromas of ripe, concentrated black-berried fruit and elegant oak. The same impression of generous fruit is found on the powerful, rich and chewy palate, which is structured by a touch of taut Cabernet Franc, dense tannins and lingers to a long and spicy finish.

37. ZINFANDEL, SCOTTO WINES,
LODI, CALIFORNIA  

The Zinfandel "Old Vines" in California can be up to 150 years old, and in high demand! Spicy, red fruit aromas with a hint of dark chocolate. Brimming with elegant plum and cassis flavours, balanced by vanilla and oak spice on the finish.

37. CHATEAU LA COUROLLE, MONTAGNE SAINT
EMILION, FRANCE 

This merlot blend wine is transferred to oak barrels, 33% new, wherein the wines become more supple and textured, without incurring any overtly oaky character. This very inviting, early-drinking Right Bank claret, is rich in ripe cherry and cassis, with floral notes and earthy, mineral undertones.

37. HOSPICES DE BEAUJEU, DOMAINE BROUILLY,
COTES DE BEAUNES, FRANCE  

The granite and clay soils in the region provide ideal conditions for the Gamay grape variety, which produces colourful and aromatic wines. This wine is distinguished by their brilliant ruby hue and intense aromas of red berries, such as strawberry, cherry, and raspberry, often complemented by floral and spicy notes. On the palate, these wines are generally fresh and delightful, with fine tannins and a lovely finish.

ROSÉ

39. CHATEAU MINUTY CÔTE DE PROVENCE,
FRANCE 

Chateau Minuty is a provence winery in saint tropez, beautiful wine with a dry, herbal usually crisp acidity, with lovely hints of strawberries, summer berries, cherry and grapefruits

40. FETEASCA NEAGRA BLEND, BALAURI,
BANAT, ROMANIA   





An intriguing fusion of a local Romanian grape, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir and Syrah creates a truly complex and delicious rosé! Cascades of floral raspberry on the nose; a full-bodied and festive palate of strawberries, green apples and winter spice that rally towards a zesty finish. Trust us on this one!

41. BOBAL, LA CEPA DE PELAYO,
MANCHUELA, SPAIN

Dark garnet in colour; you could mistake this wine for a red! Jam-packed with fresh red fruit, violets and citrus blossom aromas. A dry, yet lush, palate; perfectly balanced between acidity, alcohol and sweetness. A rosé like no other!

42. WHISPERING ANGEL, PROVENCE, FRANCE

Predominantly Grenache, with splashes of Cinsault, Syrah and Carignan, this extremely versatile rosé has a floral perfume, yet refreshing acidity backed by fresh red berries and a smooth, round finish.
