



The handsome red brick and sandstone house that is home to the University Women's Club was designed by TH Wyatt and built for Lord Arthur Russell in 1876. The Club finally found its permanent home here in 1921, when the Members bought the freehold of 2 Audley Square from the Russell family. During its time as a family home, the Russell ladies hosted many a party welcoming guests such as Henry James, John Singer Sargeant, Virginia Woolf and Gertrude Bell to provide 'the best talk and pleasantest evenings'. That legacy remains today and the Club continues to provide a welcoming environment for graduate, professional and business women of all ages to relax, entertain and meet other likeminded people.

Situated in a superb central location, the Clubhouse is in close proximity to the exclusive shopping districts of Bond Street, Knightsbridge and Sloane Street, with great transport links, including Green Park and Hyde Park Corner, very near-by.
