The Rooms & Facilities

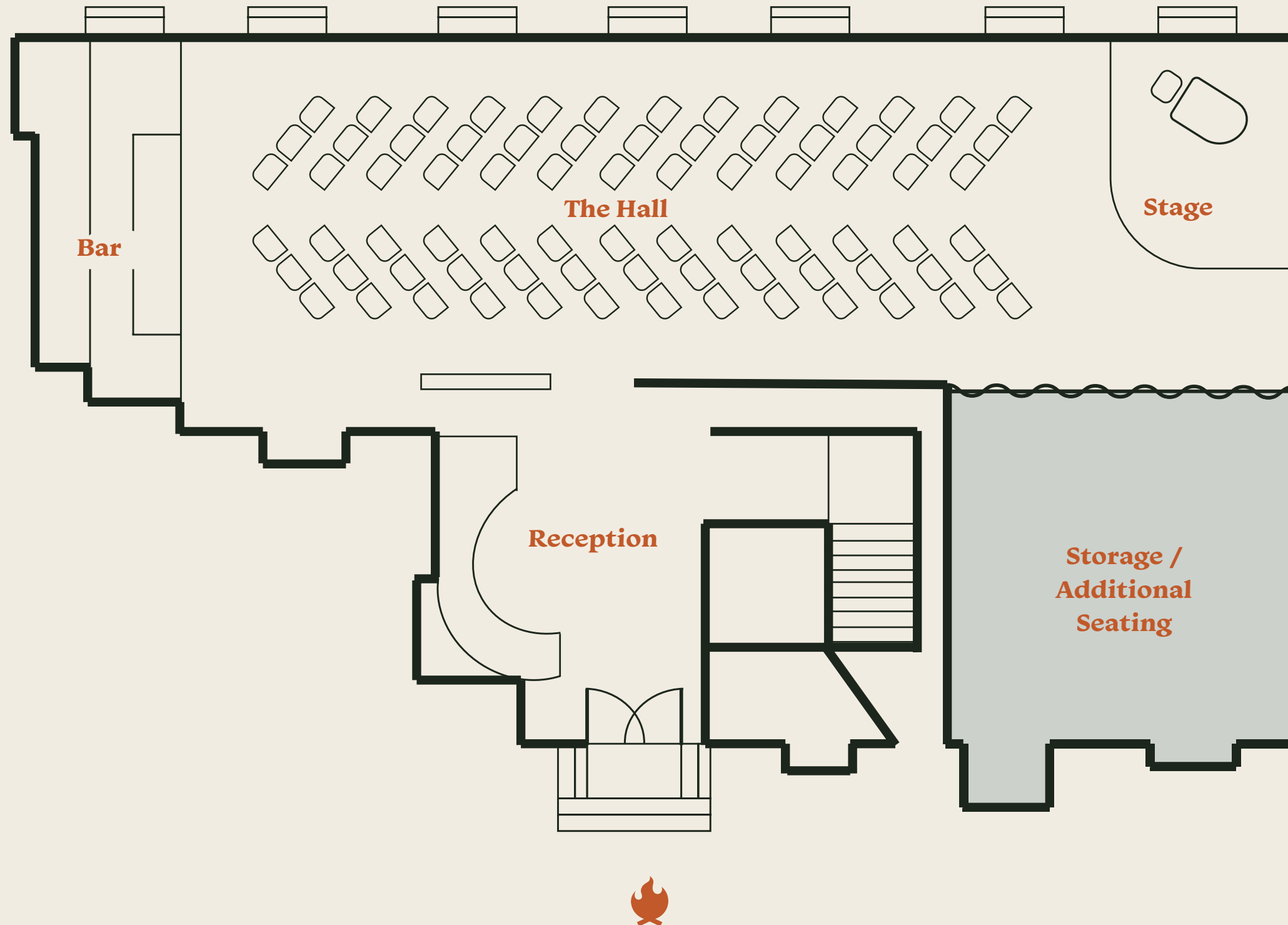
Five event spaces across three floors, each with its own distinct character.

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First Floor



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The Hall

Our largest and most impressive space, The Hall sits at the heart of Bradmore House and sets the tone for conferences, presentations and large-scale events that need to make an impact.

Flooded with natural light from high arched windows, the room features a fully equipped stage, a stocked bar, communal tables and lounge areas — giving you the flexibility to move between presentation, breakout and reception formats within a single day. Candlelight, brass and marble accents, reclaimed wooden floorboards and an open fireplace make the scale of the room feel surprisingly intimate. It's a combination that has attracted everyone from Chanel to Adobe to Disney.

Up to 120 seated

This room is equipped with an Epson 4K projector, 4K HDMI connectivity and Apple TV for wireless sharing, a DMX-controlled lighting rig, a Yamaha digital mixing console and a full range of microphones.

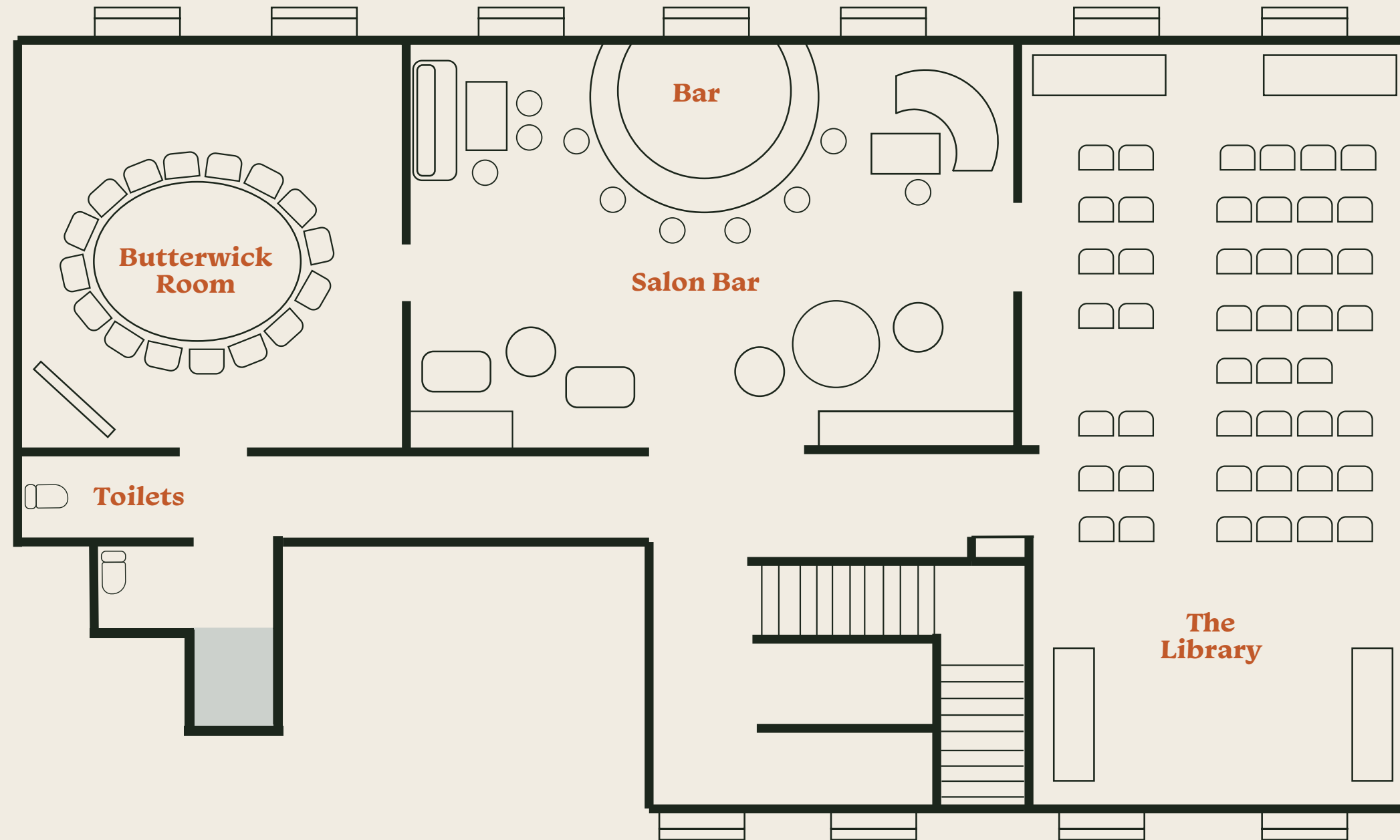

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Second Floor



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The Library & Salon Bar

Located on Kindred's top floor, The Library and Salon Bar work beautifully together as a self-contained space for corporate lunches, team away days and client meetings that deserve a more considered setting.

The Library is a peaceful, green-walled room with an entire wall of books, high arched windows and can seat up to 45. Full of character and genuinely unlike any conventional meeting or dining room, it's a space people tend to remember. The adjoining Salon Bar makes a natural breakout space during the day — and a relaxed setting for drinks and conversation once the working part of the agenda is done. It's a combination that has drawn clients including HarperCollins and Lululemon.

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Butterwick Room

The most intimate space in Bradmore House, the Butterwick Room is a remarkable setting for smaller gatherings that deserve something special. Original features from the 1700s, soaring ceilings and rich blue walls create an atmosphere no modern meeting room can replicate.

With a centrepiece oval table seating up to 16, it works particularly well for board meetings, client lunches and senior leadership offsites where focus and discretion matter. Set apart from the rest of the building, it offers a genuine sense of privacy — without ever feeling removed.

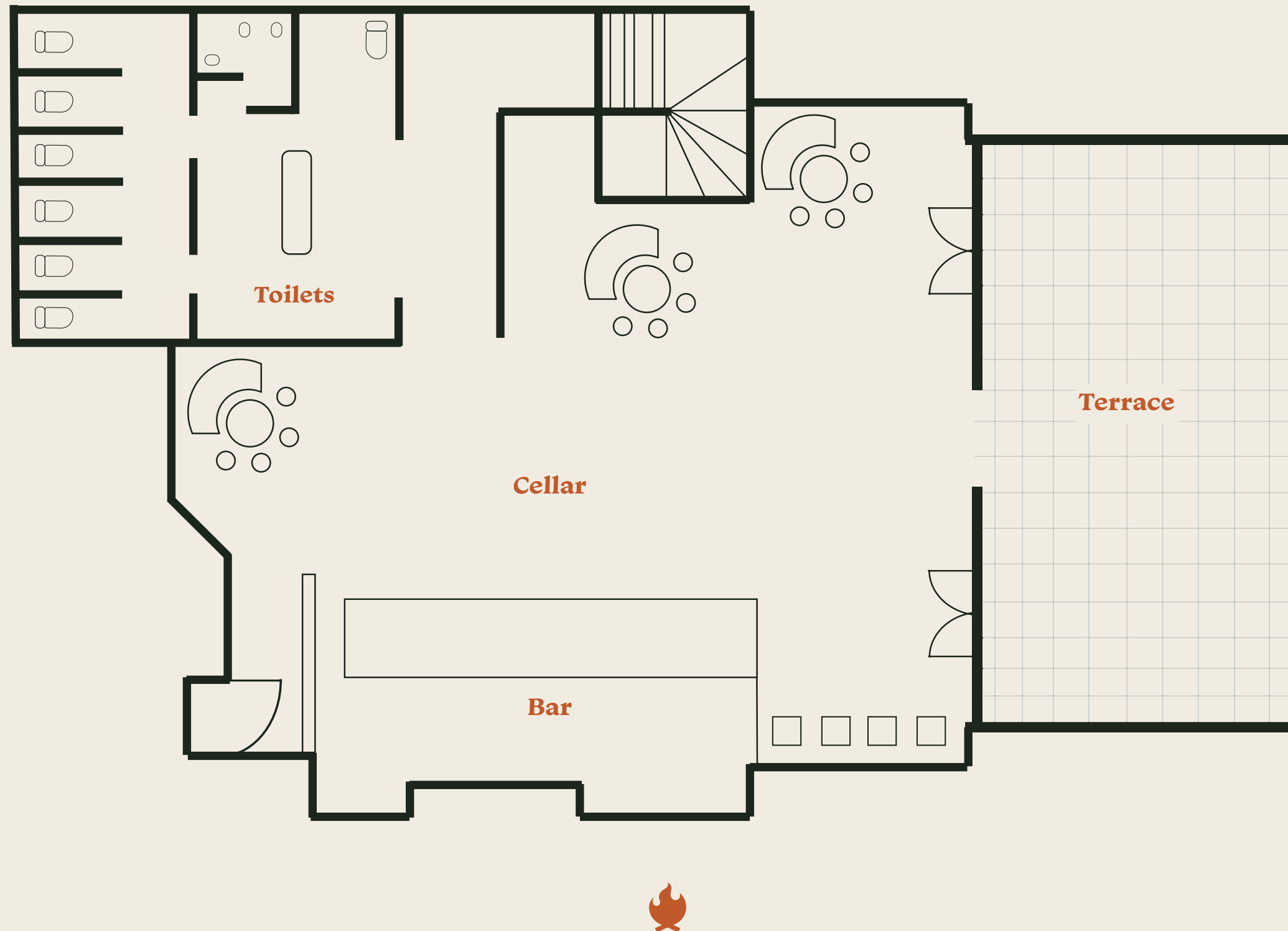
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Butterwick Room

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Cellar & Terrace

Open French windows connect the interior to the terrace, creating a natural indoor-outdoor flow that works beautifully for parties, socials and post-event drinks.

Whether it's the golden hours of a London summer or cosying under blankets with the heated parasols in the colder months, the terrace extends your capacity and adds a welcome change of pace.

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Meetings

There are *two ways to book*:

Day Delegate Rate (DDR)

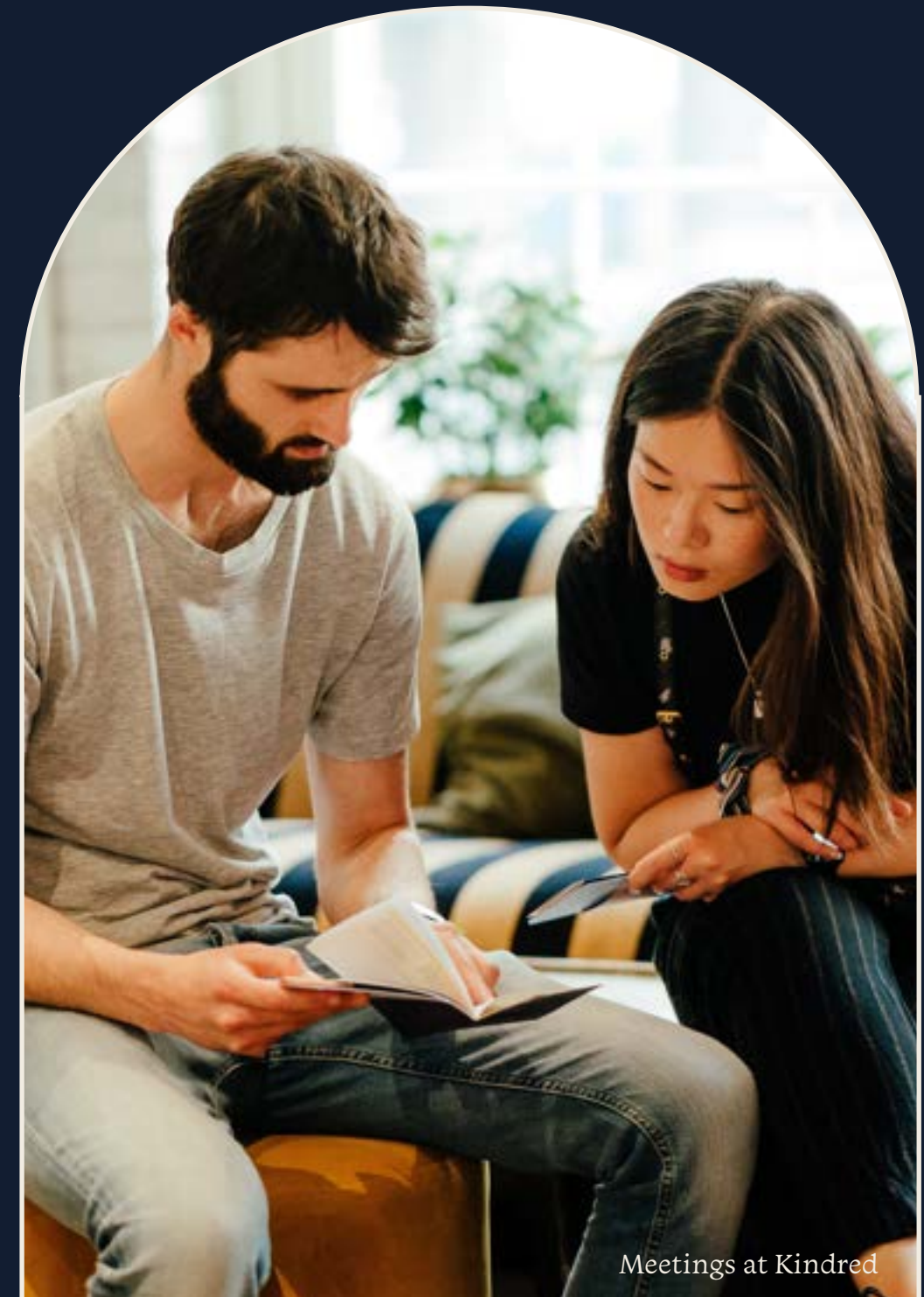
A per-person rate on either a half-day or full-day basis, covering the room, equipment and catering throughout. A minimum number of delegates applies.

Dry Hire

Hire the room at a fixed rate, with complimentary still and sparkling water and full use of all AV equipment included. A flexible option that works well for smaller groups, film crews and content creators.

Post-Meeting Reception

When the working day is done, let us help you wind down. Whether it's a round of cocktails in the Salon Bar, canapés in The Hall or a more informal drinks reception for your whole group, we'll take care of the details. Speak to our team about what would work best for your event.

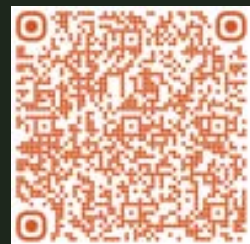
Networking Events & Receptions

FAQs

Booking & Payment

What is the process to secure a date?

We'll work with you to establish the details, including estimated food and drink quantities, and build a tailored quote that can be updated as plans develop. We ask for 50% upfront to secure the date, with the remaining 50% due at least two weeks before the event, along with your final food and drink choices. If your event is less than two weeks away, full payment is required to confirm.

What is the cancellation policy?

You can cancel your event at any time in writing. Depending on when you cancel, some or all of the payment may be non-refundable. Where possible, we'll do our best to resell your date and, if successful, may be able to offer a partial or full refund. The same applies if you need to reschedule. Please read the full terms and conditions before booking and speak to your event manager if you have any questions.

Why is a service charge added, and is it optional?

100% of our service charge goes directly to the team working your event — those in the kitchen, on the bar and on the floor. We apply a non-discretionary charge of 10% to your food and drink bill, which means it isn't optional. We do this because we believe our team should always be rewarded for the work they put in, and we want to be transparent about that from the outset. If anything doesn't meet your expectations on the day, please let your event manager know as soon as possible so we can put it right.

Why is an admin fee charged?

A 3% admin fee is applied to the overall total of your event. This covers the administrative cost of planning, coordinating and managing your booking from enquiry through to the day itself. As with our service charge, we'd rather be upfront about this from the start than have any surprises appear on your final invoice.



Booking & Payment Continued

How do damage deposits work?

For larger bookings we'll usually charge a damage deposit of 20% of the booking value, up to a maximum of £2,000. Any damage attributed to you, your guests or your suppliers will be assessed and a repair or replacement quote obtained. That sum will be deducted from your deposit before it is returned. If no damage is reported, your deposit will be refunded in full within five working days.

AV & Logistics

Will someone be available to help with AV on the day?

Yes. It's worth discussing your requirements with your event manager in advance so we can confirm whether our standard setup covers everything you need, or whether specialist support is required. We can accommodate most requirements — it's all in the planning.

Do you have a space for guest speakers or presenters to prepare?

Yes. We have rooms available for this purpose at an additional charge. Please speak to your event manager for details.

Food & Drink

Can we bring our own wine or drinks?

Yes, subject to corkage. Current rates: still wine £25 per bottle,

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sparkling wine £35 per bottle, spirits £70 per bottle, beer, cider or soft drinks £4 per bottle or can. Please discuss with your event manager in advance.

Can we bring in external catering?

We ask that you don't bring food or drinks in from outside without prior agreement. If you'd like to discuss bringing an external caterer, please speak to your event manager. Forkage fees start at £15 per person.

Can you accommodate bespoke menus or specific dietary requirements?

Yes. Our chef team can work with you to design a bespoke menu for your event. This service starts from £500 depending on the brief and includes tastings.

On the Day

What time can delegates arrive?

Arrival times are confirmed with your event manager as part of your event planning. We'll make sure the space is ready and the team is briefed ahead of your guests arriving.

Is there a cloakroom?

Yes. Coat check is included as standard with all bookings.



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Can I bring a guest speaker or presenter?

Yes. We have rooms available for this purpose at an additional charge. Please speak to your event manager for details.

Is the venue accessible?

Yes. A lift serves all three floors and there are no steps within the floors themselves. Our accessible toilet is on the ground floor. We're also located directly outside Hammersmith tube and bus station, which is fully accessible.

Can I bring my dog?

We're a dog-friendly venue and well-behaved dogs are always welcome. Please keep them on a lead, off the furniture — and bring a towel if the weather calls for it.

Getting Here & Parking

Is the venue well connected by public transport?

Hammersmith Underground Station is a two-minute walk away, served by the District, Piccadilly, Circle and Hammersmith & City lines — making it easy to leave the car at home.

Is parking available near the venue?

Yes. There are several car parks within easy walking distance of Bradmore House. We strongly recommend pre-booking, as Hammersmith is a busy area and spaces fill quickly.

What are the best parking options?

We recommend the following:

- **St Augustine Car Park**, 55 Fulham Palace Road — approximately 7 minutes' walk. Open 24 hours (closed Sunday mornings). Pre-booking via the ParkBee app is advised.
- **Livat Car Park (Kings Mall)**, Glenthorne Road — approximately 5 minutes' walk. Open 6am–midnight daily.
- **Novotel Car Park**, Chalk Hill Road — approximately 6 minutes' walk. Open 24 hours. Pre-book via JustPark or ParkBee. Please note spaces are narrow and may not suit larger vehicles.

Do I need to book parking in advance?

Yes — we strongly recommend it. You can reserve a spot via JustPark, YourParkingSpace or the ParkBee app.

Is there on-street parking nearby?

On-street parking in the area is heavily restricted. Most streets operate permit holder or pay-and-display rules until 6:30pm, after which some bays may become available free of charge. Where pay-and-display bays are in use, payment can be made via the RingGo app. On-street availability cannot be guaranteed, so we'd recommend pre-booking a nearby car park for peace of mind.
