The bar was designed by Steve Seary Architects. Salt mixes Austere Wengi and warm Black Walnut Hardwoods with dark natural slate cladding. The modern theme is enhanced by the bespoke wood & Leather furniture, which in turn complements the frosted Glass lit bar with an illuminated display case housing our 200 Whiskies from all around the World.

### **Salt Bar's Guide to the Whisky Regions**

Like wines, the single malts of Scotland are grouped by region although these regions offer a guideline rather than a rule. The regions of Scotland – the Lowlands, the Highlands, Campbeltown and the island of Islay – have their origins in the regulation of licences and duties, but they do also embrace certain characteristics.

#### **ISLAY**

Islay is the greatest of the whisky Islands, Deep in Peat, Lashed by Rain, Wind and Sea. Distillation has been taking place here for 1500 Years and the varied, Complex flavours are challenging to the Palate, Giving you a true taste of Hebridean History.

#### **LOWLANDS**

The Lowlands Region is Located South of Greenock in the West & Dundee in the East, and is often overlooked by whisky drinkers. The Distillers there produce lighter style Malts making them good as an Aperitif or for mixing in a Classic Cocktail like Rob Roy.

#### **ISLANDS**

The Islands off the North and West Coast of Scotland produce such a diversity of styles with each Distillery having a Unique taste of their own . With its Maritime Climate (Different to the Mainland) the Terrior plays its Part in the makeup of these Whiskies.

#### **CAMPBELTOWN**

Back in the prohibition Years (1919-1933) Campbeltown had 34 Distilleries selling Bootleg Liquor to America. Now sadly there is only one working full time. Located on the Mull of Kintyre, the small town of Campbeltown is both remote and picturesque.

#### **SPEYSIDE**

Technically, a Sub-Region of the Highlands. Many Bartenders consider Speyside Whiskies as the very essence of the Malt whisky and with over 50 Distilleries ploughing their Furrow, Who can blame them? They have great Elegance and Finesse and deserve their Accolades.

## **HIGHLANDS**

The region, defined since 1784, Encompasses all main land distilleries north of the Highland line (Greenock to Dundee) scattered across Scotland, There are some stunning expressions to be had from this dramatic area.

## **BLENDED WHISKY**

Made from a mixture of Malt Whisky and Grain Whisky to a style of the Distiller. Deluxe Whisky is when a higher proportion of Malt Whisky is used in the blend.

## **IRISH WHISKEY**

Revered by many, Irish Whiskies tend to be more restrained than others. Their soft enticing Blends as well as their chewy malts reach out to coat your palate.

## **AMERICAN WHISKEY**

Spirits were distilled in America from the word go and now have become extremely Fashionable with whisky drinkers across the world. Kentucky is the cradle of Bourbon production.

## **CANADIAN WHISKEY**

When the Emigrants arrived in Canada, from Ireland & Scotland, It was natural they would bring with them their secrets of how to turn grain into spirit, primarily around the great lakes area.

The Tomatin 18 Year Old is a truly world class malt. Matured in traditional oak casks and first fill Oloroso Sherry butts, honey and soft oak flavours develop into a hint of dark chocolate with a citrus bite before a sustained sweet and slightly dry finish.

From Tomintoul's Vintage Single Cask range, this 1994 expression was aged in a single Oloroso sherry butt, bottled at cask strength (57.4% ABV). Rich sherry notes mingle with clove, dried raspberries, and Jaffa Cakes on the nose. The palate unveils tart fruits, chocolate, and spicy ginger, underpinned by mellow oak and leather, leading to a medium-long finish with butterscotch, chocolate, and lingering citrus oil.

**BLENDED MALT****Collectivum XXVIII****£20.00****57.0%**

Collectivum XXVIII, a tribute to Diageo's 28 single malt distilleries, offers a rich and complex whisky. On the nose, it combines chocolate, red berries, and citrus zest. The palate is initially spicy with orchard fruit and hints of smoke, while the finish reveals chocolate and spice. With water, it unfolds its full potential, presenting a delightful balance of sweetness, acidity, and tannic dryness. A versatile and rewarding dram.

**JAPANESE****Suntory Yamazaki 12yrs****£15.00****43.0%**

Sweet vanilla and fruity notes derived from white oak casks are accented with fine aromas of spirits aged in sherry and Japanese oak casks.

**TAIWANESE****KAVALAN Solist (ex-Bourbon Cask)****£26.00****59.4%**

A perfect showcase for the quality of Kavalan's Taiwanese made and matured spirit - a single cask bottling from a first-fill bourbon cask. The vanilla-y elements from the bourbon casks work very well with the fruity spirit from King Car, resulting in a well-balanced expression.
