N.V. Borgoluce Prosecco Valdobbiadene Superiore, Extra Dry, Veneto

44

Crisp, clean and linear, this elegant sparkler has delicate, enticing aromas of spring blossom, fleshy white stone fruit and wild herb. The dry, tangy palate delivers yellow pear, Rennet apple, lemon zest and white almond alongside a foaming mousse and bright acidity.

2022 Ca’ Morlin Prosecco Rose’, Veneto

Pale pink slightly orange in colour, the Prosecco Rose has aromas of green apple, blackberry and black currant and a delicate floral touch.

N.V. Bellavista Alma, Franciacorta, Lombardy

Anyone who thinks that Italian sparkling wines are always lighter and simpler than Champagne should try this substantial wine with pear, apple and berry nuances and a successful balance of yeast character and acidity. Long finish, where the berry notes dominate.

This is a very dry Champagne, with a dosage at 5 grams per liter but it feels nearly bone-dry, zingy and mineral. Yet, flavors are abundant on a crisp and opulent balance. This is a nutty sparkling, subtly buttery, with the freshness of zingy citrus fruit characters cutting through

Bright pink in colour with a lively, youthful perfume of ripe strawberries and a touch of fresh mint. On the palate, it is surprisingly full-bodied with good structure, perfectly balanced with a delicate fruit character and zesty, lightly spiced finish.

NORTHERN ITALY

Sauvignon delle Venezie, IGT Le Pianure (ORG) Friuli Venezia Giulia 2020 36

Intense aromas with notes of grapefruit, lime sage and green pepper, and a pleasant degree of acidity.

Pinot Bianco Tappo a Vite, Cantina Bolzano, Alto Adige 2021 45

The bouquet is aromatic with scents of stone fruits and herbs, on the palate the wine is sharp, light, easy drinking and a deep minerality through the mouth with a soft end.

Ribolla Gialla 'Botis' Stocco, Friuli 2019 45

Pale lemon in colour, on the nose elegant floral and spicy notes scents, on the palate it has a very good minerality and body with a balanced, dry finish.

Gavi di Gavi, Terre Antiche, Piemonte 2022 47

Quite rich in texture, but still soft and gentle. A lime overtone, and an almost Riesling-like focus on the nose. Medium-bodied and silky with plenty of juicy peach and pear fruit alongside stone minerality.

Soave Pieropan Classico, Veneto 2022 50

Generous, pleasingly fresh and versatile, it is made from the traditional varieties of Garganega and Trebbiano di Soave grown in family-owned vineyards situated in the Soave Classico zone.

Lugana `I Frati` Ca dei Frati, Lombardia 2022 60

Light yellow in colour with a concentrated but fresh perfume of white flowers, peaches and ripe lemons. On the palate it has excellent depth and balance, with lovely richness and a crisp, lively finish.

Chardonnay, Pinot Grigio & Pinot Bianco 'Olivar', Cesconi, Trentino 2019 70

A light gold wine that shows layered aromas of ripe stone fruit such as apricot and peach with notes of white flowers. A fresh, citrus character in the mouth is rounded out by the vanilla notes from the oak ageing and complemented by a touch of minerality. The long finish is floral and fragrant.

CENTRAL ITALY

Angela Hartnett IGT Bianco, Tuscany 2022 46

Sangiovese vinified in white gives the wine nice crunchy, mineral notes with a very balanced and fresh body.

Verdicchio di Matelica, Del Cerro, Belisario, Marche 2021 48

Pale with green highlights. Abundant aromas of vibrant grapefruit, white flowers and hints of honey dominate the nose. The palate shows refreshing acidity, interesting mineral characters, a light hint of ripe fruit and a final burst of zingy lemon to lift the finish. A beautifully balanced wine, with a soft mouthfeel that retains a wonderful lifted, fresh character.

Pecorino Alta Quota 'Gran Sasso', Abruzzo 2022 48

Dry, lively mineral style of Pecorino with very fresh citrusy notes with the best grapes from highest vineyards in Abruzzo.

CAFE MURANO

Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Montenidoli Tradizionale, *Tuscany* 2021

A great classic: floral bouquet of gorse, daisy, camomile, lavender. The taste is excellent both for its substance and its lovely balance, the result of an intense acidity that is always present but never interferes, allowing for a very impressive secondary flavour. The finish is of a rare complexity and persistence with an excellent aftertaste.

Sauvignon Blanc Meriggio Fontodi, *Tuscany* 2022

63

Silvery lemon yellow in the glass. Fresh and grassy perfumes lead to a lively, lifted palate with a mineral undertone. This Meriggio shows the characteristic high quality of all the Fontodi wines and finishes on a long, elegant note.

Chardonnay, I Sistri, *Tuscany*, 2021

66

Deep straw yellow, classic ripe-fruit Chardonnay nose, with a blend of tropical fruit and vanilla and appealing notes of spice. It displays elegant structure with a fresh acidity and a superb finish. Creamy, buttery can be compared to burgundy whites.

Viognier, Mandrarossa, *Sicily* 2022

Very fresh and easy drinking new world style Viognier with stone fruits and citrus note well balanced with a medium minerality.

Falanghina, Di Majo Norante, *Campania* 2021

Crisp and fruity, The Falanghina grape can be tasted in perfect purity, with notes of almond, blossom, lemon and fresh nectarine. Perfect for light meals, appetizers.

NORTHERN ITALY

Pinot Nero 'Bottis' Stocco, Friuli 2021

44

Ruby in colour, it has a fruity nose, with a peppery touch. Same on the palate it starts with flavours of cherries and red berries with a clear note of black pepper at the end.

Valpolicella Classico Meroni, Veneto 2021

48

An ethereal bouquet and a perfume of cherries, red current jam, liquorice, tamarind and spices, It is warm, fine and persistent to the palate with an Maraschino cherry after taste, a "velvet" texture of great body and roundness.

Valpolicella Ripasso, Corte Giara, Veneto 2021

56

Deep ruby red colour with good concentration. Bouquet of plums red fruit, sweet spices, delicate spiced herbs. Excellent structure and vibrant acidity.

Valtellina Superiore Valgella 'Costa Bassa', Sandro Fay, Lombardy 2020

60

Medium body, hints of red fruit, light tannins and light acidity. Real essence of classic style of Nebbiolo

Valpolicella Superiore 'Vigna Garzon', Veneto 2020

69

Brilliant ruby red in colour. The bouquet is full of typical cherry and strawberry fruit. The palate continues with complex layers of beautiful fruit notes and finishes with a spicy character. Ready to drink now but also has the potential to age well.

Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba DOCG, Principiano, Piedmont 2019

98

Ruby red with garnet shades. Bouquet of Herbs and oriental spices, cherry, mint and rhubarb. The taste is full and vigorous, juicy, with good tannins and long finish.

Amarone Classico 'Moropio', Antolini, Veneto 2019

110

Full body, intense, tobacco, chocolate, sweet spices, good structure, soft with a nice minerality.

Barolo Massolino, Piedmont 2019

127

Bright ruby-garnet in colour with intense perfumes of dark fruit and a touch of cloves with a savoury, herbal note. On the palate, it is full-bodied yet elegant, with plenty of robust but ripe tannins supporting the dark, dried plum. Long and fine, with perfumes of roses and violets on the finish

CENTRAL ITALY

Chianti 'Podere Gamba', San Ferdinando, Tuscany 2020

45

Elegant with red fruits and liquorice, good balance, soft tannins. Harmonious and persistent. Light, easy drinking sangiovese.

Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot (ORG), Ciacci Piccolomini D'Aragona, Toscana 2021

44

Intense ruby red in colour, bouquet is intense with vibrant herbal, spicy and fruit-forward notes. Very well structured, full bodied and balanced with pronounced tannins. A wine with a great personality and long aftertaste.

Angela Hartnett IGT Rosso, *Tuscany* 2019 46

Classic Tuscan blend, soft body and tannins and very easy drinking red with lively red fruits notes on the nose.

Chianti Classico Rocca di Montegrossi, *Tuscany* 2020 63

Medium body, soft and gentle tannins, short finish, hint of berries.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Tenuta Valdipiatta, *Tuscany* 2018 75.5

Elegant, notes of red fruits, liquorice and tobacco. Fresh, tannic texture, great persistence.

Brunello di Montalcino 'Poggio San Polo' *Tuscany* 2018 136

Full body, tobacco, liquorice, gentle in tannin.

SOUTHERN ITALY AND THE ISLANDS

Aglianico del vulture, Pipoli, *Basilicata* 2019 41.5

Notes of cherry are combined with spicy and vanilla notes, good structure, ripe tannins and persistent aftertaste.

Primitivo 'Fatalone', Gioia del Colle, *Puglia* 2021 58

Ruby red intense colour with violet glares. Scent and taste typically fruity of berries and slightly of black sour cherry and plum with some spicy and balsamic notes. A perfect balance of smoothness, freshness and minerality. Aftertaste of toasted almond, typical of a natural authentic Primitivo of Gioia del Colle.

Etna Rosso "Pistus" I Custodi *Sicily* 2020 67

Aromas of fruit in alcohol, and notes of wood, chocolate and vanilla. In the mouth it is full and round, with a long finish and an excellent balance.

Sweet & Fortified

Moscato d'Asti Contero, 37.5 cl *Piemonte*, 2022 29

Delicately sparkling, with a lovely perfume of freshly crushed grapes and sherbet. On the palate, it is off-dry, with a perfect balance of soft, sweet fruit, a hint of Turkish delight and lively, fresh acidity.

Brachetto d'Acqui, Contero, 37.5 cl *Piemonte*, 2022 30

The rich, persistent mousse accompanies bright aromas of roses and violets. The slightly sweet, aromatic palate has a typical bittersweet note on the finish.

Vin Santo, Buccia Nera, 50 cl *Toscana* 2018 54

In the mouth is very soft and dense, the sensations of sweetness and pseudo-heat are well balanced by acidity. Despite the important residual sugar, the mouth remains clean with a delicious aftertaste of dried fruit.

Recioto della Valpolicella, Antolini, 50cl *Veneto* 2020 59

A perfect balance of sweetness with enough acidity to stop it from becoming cloying. It has intense aromas of cherries, cranberry, violet and spice, and in the mouth it's voluptuously smooth, with intense flavours of chocolate, cherry jam and a lick of licorice.

Marsala Vigna La Miccia Marco de Bartoli 50 cl *Sicilia* 2018 72

Thanks to its slight sweetness you can drink Vigna La Miccia, an innovative and contemporary expression of Marsala wine, with all sorts of dishes: pumpkin-filled pasta, soft and blue cheeses, foie gras or dessert.
