
The area of Smithfield is steeped in history. The story started back when fields cascaded the area in the 12th century. Originally it was called Smoothfield because of the grassy plains. However, it later came to be known as 'Smith' due to the tweaking of the Saxon word Smeth, meaning smooth.

There were several facades which encompassed Smithfield, starting from a recreational area where jousts and tournaments were held, to a stage set for the most notorious criminals to be executed, to finally, the most famous livestock market around. 'SMITHS' was the go to place for a steak as meat provenance featured highly on Smiths' menu long before it became common currency elsewhere. Located opposite Smithfield market, delivering good steaks was an obvious direction in which to take the food offering. Indeed, Smithfield has been a chartered cattle market since 1638 and local road names like Cowcross Street point to the stampeding cattle routes of the past, more often than not seeing the beasts entering shops en route and thought to be the origin of the phrase 'a bull in a china shop'. As you can see this area that you are now dining in, has an abundance of history, so much so that it's made the building of our fabulous 'SMITHS' a Grade II listed building.

Originally the 'SMITHS' building was used as a warehouse to store meats from the market. There were huge freezers built in the basement that now house our neighbour Fabric (the night club). The current building of 'SMITHS' was erected in 1887 and it wasn't until 2000 when the 'SMITHS' team along with architects Wells Mackereth turned it into what it is today. It is an iconic destination bar, café, 2 restaurants and private dining venue across 4 floors. The space still keeps its warehouse, industrial feel. Yet each floor embodies different personalities that somehow mesh well together. The vibe is almost reminiscent of a New York-esque buzz. With its open space, steel framings intertwining the first three floors, blasted brickwork throughout and plentiful windows that let the light of London filter in, our guests are guaranteed a unique and tailored experience.

Here in The Dining Room we pride ourselves on not only our food but also our extensive drinks offering. Our wines have been researched and selected by our food and beverage manager along with 'SMITHS' own sommelier and our wine suppliers, Liberty Wines. The team have extensive knowledge of our wines so do discuss your choices with them.

"The food at 'Smith's is about taste, quality and provenance, and we've used the same philosophy when compiling the wine list. In most cases, we've gone directly to the source – the grower – to ensure that the wines are sustainably produced, and that they are true to type. By this we mean that they express the character of the grape variety from which they are made and the site on which the grapes are grown. The same principles have been applied to the selection of our steaks and our wines. We have also put a lot of focus on the value offered by the wines on this list. The higher the cost price of the wine to us, the lower the margin we take. So you're getting much more wine for your money at the lower end of the list. We hope you enjoy drinking the wines as much as we enjoyed compiling the list."
