Sparkling

Prosecco 'Brina Organic', Veneto, Italy, Brut NV £32.50

Glera. Delicate aromas of peach, green apple alongside notes of acacia and lilac. Light and refreshing on the palate, this is perfect as an aperitif and matched with seafood.

Crémant de Bourgogne Caves de Lugny, Burgundy, France NV £38

Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Gamay. Aromas of citrus and apple with notes of biscuit. Generous and creamy on the palate with a crisp finish and fine bubbles.

H. Blin 'Charles Vercy', Champagne, France, Brut NV £55

Blend. Red fruit aromas and high acid levels brings a subtle freshness and fruitiness while on the palate, fresh white fruit, apple and hints of freshly baked bread.

Court Garden Classic Cuvee, East Sussex, England 2017 £57

Blend. A very delicate wine with fresh pineapple and greengage fruit and a touch of toasty aromas. The palate is slightly creamy with great freshness and a long finish.

Laurent-Perrier La Cuvée, Champagne, France, Brut NV £71

Blend. Tropical notes alongside gooseberry aromas, the palate is medium bodied with a good concentration of fruits and a crisp acidity.



White

Freedom Cross, Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa, 2023 £27

Chenin Blanc. Ripe pineapple, passionfruit and melon aromas with a mix of tropical fruit flavours that are well integrated with a zesty acidity and a perky fresh finish.

Sauvignon Blanc-Colombard Grandiose, Gascony, France 2022 £27

Blend. Aged on its lees for a short period to add smoothness, complexity and texture to the palate. Flavours of gooseberry with grassy, lemony overtones. Crisp and dry on the palate with mineral notes.

Chemin de la Serre Marsanne Viognier, Languedoc France 2022 £29

Blend. Flavours of white peach and apricot, orange rind and lemon with hints of white petal flowers and spice with a refreshing acidity.

Picpoul de Pinet Belardent, South-West France, France 2021 £32

Picpoul Blanc. Crisp and refreshing with zesty citrus notes, it's perfect for drinking in the garden on a sunny day or as an alternative to Sauvignon Blanc.

Wild River Sauvignon Blanc Waipara, New Zealand 2022 £34

Sauvignon Blanc. Tropical notes alongside gooseberry aromas, the palate is medium bodied with a good concentration of fruits and a crisp acidity.

Modeano Pinot Grigio, Friuli, Italy 2022 £35

Pinot Grigio. A rich aroma of tropical fruits, hints of flowers and wild honey. Beautifully balanced on the palate with a zesty and long finish.

Gavi 'Bio' La Zerba, Piedmont, Italy 2022 £38

Cortese. A traditional Gavi with aromas of white flower, peach, citrus fruit and pear. Fresh and soft with hints of minerals on the palate.

Riesling 'Solitar Trocken' SA Prüm, Mosel, Germany 2022 £39

Riesling. This is an aromatic still wine with stone and citrus fruits on the nose follow through to a dry but zesty fruit flavoured palate with a long finish.

Chardonnay, The Valley, La Brune, Cape South Coast, South Africa, 2022 £41

Picpoul Blanc. Crisp and refreshing with zesty citrus notes, it's perfect for drinking in the garden on a sunny day or as an alternative to Sauvignon Blanc.

Chablis Domaine d'Elise, Burgundy, France 2021 £47

Chardonnay. Fresh citrus and mineral notes, beautifully balanced by layers of warm, rich fruit. Slightly creamy on the palate, with apple and lime fruits and a refreshing acidity. A typical 'old style' Chablis.

Domaine Millet Roger Sancerre Millet Roger, Loire, France 2022 £50

Sauvignon Blanc. A seriously stunning Sancerre. Great complexity with the classic minerality so traditional of Sancerre and all the exhilarating fresh gooseberry flavours that you could ask for.

Chassagne Montrachet, Domaine Bachelot-Monnet, Burgundy, France, 2018 £76

Chardonnay. Rich and delicate with honey, pastry, lime and hazelnut flavours on a round frame. Beautifully balanced, this is nonetheless vibrant and snappy, ending with a mouth-watering finish.

Red

Chemin de la Serre Carignan Vieilles Vignes, Languedoc France 2022 £28

Carignan. This deep red offers delightful aromas of blackcurrant with a spicy twist and a hint of vanilla.

Pinot Noir, Lautarul, Banat, Romania, 2022 £28

Dark in colour, red plum, cherry and mulled spicy aromas. Notes of cherry, raspberry and cinnamon with a long lingering finish.

Merlot Grandiose, Languedoc, France 2021 £29

Merlot. Ripe plums and hints of violets and soft smooth tannins make it a real crowd pleaser.

La Ronciere Cantoalba Cabernet Sauvignon, Colchagua Valley, Chile 2021 £31

Cabernet Sauvignon. Aromas of mulberry, blackberry and blackcurrant with notes of violets and cinnamon. Complex and elegant on the palate, a long lasting finish with a touch of liquorice and cocoa.

Malbec, Domaine Bousquet, Mendoza, Argentina 2023 £32

100% Malbec. A typical Malbec with aromas of blackberry and cassis and hints of spice and black pepper. Medium bodied with silky tannins and ripe fruit flavours. Overall, smooth and elegant.

Domaine des Carabiniers, Cotes du Rhone Rouge, Lunar Apoge, Rhone, France, 2022 £36

Aromas of bright red fruits, with hints of spice and cloves. Medium to full bodied with a velvety texture.

Chianti Classico Nardi, Tuscany, Italy 2020 £41

Sangiovese. Nice complexity on the nose with aromas of raspberry and cherry alongside spicy and violet notes. Medium to full-bodied with soft tannins and a ripe and fresh finish. This is a traditional Chianti.

Rioja Reserva, Valserrano, Rioja Alavesa, Spain 2015 £43

Grenache, Tempranillo. Blackcurrant, cherry, cedarwood and toasted oak. On the palate, enticing notes of prunes, sweet spices and mocha.

Reserva Tinto' Quinta da Silveira, Douro, Portugal 2017 £45

60% Touriga Franca, 30% Touriga Nacional, 10% Tinta Roriz. Aged for 18 months in new French oak barrels. Intense aromas of violets, red cherry, mocha and cedar and an unctuous palate with soft tannins and a floral finish.

Barolo, Tenuta Agricola Pelassa, Piedmont, Italy, 2016 £56

Crushed berries, violet and herbs on the nose with a velvety and rich on the palate, with firm tannin and great length.

Domaine du Grand Tinel Chateauneuf du Pape, Rhone, France, 2017 £61

60% Grenache, 40% Syrah. Ripe wild berry and cherry fruits on the nose. Ample on the palate with very smooth tannins and a refreshing acidity. A classic Châteauneuf du Pape.

Domaine Joseph Voillot, Pommard, Burgundy, France, 2019 £76

Pinot Noir. Aromas of raspberry, clove and a touch of earthiness. Soft and round on the palate with notes of cherry, raspberry, redcurrant and baking spice.

Rosé

Méditerranée' Rosé d'Orange Les Coteaux du Rhône, Rhône, France 2021 £28

Blend. A light and delicate rosé with rose petal aromas and wild red berry flavours.

Côtes de Provence St. Victoire Henri Bonnaud, Provence, France 2022 £45

Blend. Elegant and complex on the nose with aromas of flowers, fresh red berry fruits and hints of mango. Soft on the palate with a refreshing acidity and a slightly salty finish.

Dessert

DV by Château Doisy-Védrières, Sauternes, Bordeaux, France 2017 37.5cl £31

Blend. Luscious with quince and marmalade aromas and notes of honey. Beautifully sweet with a refreshing acidity, it has some complexity and a great length.

Fortified

Malbec 'Dulce' Domaine Bousquet, Mendoza, Argentina 2018 50cl £37

100% Malbec. Like liquid chocolate cherries. Rich aromas of cassis, blackcurrant and chocolate alongside marmalade and coffee notes. Full-bodied and moderately sweet with silky tannins, high acidity and a long finish.

Quinta da Silveira Reserve Ruby, Portugal, Douro NV £45

Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz. Honeyed pineapples, poached quince, and candied bitter Seville orange rind. Beautifully sweet with fresh grapefruit peel flavours.
