In contrast, the Argentine version tends to be bolder and fruitier, with bright notes of tropical fruits like pineapple and mango, often rounded out by a refreshing acidity. French Malbec, primarily grown in the Cahors region, is often characterized by its earthy and rustic qualities, while Argentinian Malbec has gained international acclaim for its plush, fruit-forward profile, featuring notes of blackberry, plum, and chocolate, often softened by a velvety mouthfeel.
