85% Tempranillo, 10% Mazuelo, 5% Graciano – Rioja – Bodegas Amezola <i>Intense reddish colour which reflects a touch of ageing. Typical fresh Tempranillo aroma with slight oaky and spicy traits. Complex wine with an excellent structure and aftertaste..</i>			
07	Boca 12.5%	2001	£ 45.00
65% Nebbiolo, 20% Vespolina d 15% Bonarda – Piemonte– Valland <i>Boca is regarded as a firm-bodied and well-structured red, displaying a garnet red color, aromas of violets and sweet spices and notes of pomegranates on the finish. The high levels of acidity are deemed its 'secret ingredient', contributing to the ageing potential of the wine and its easy-drinking nature, making it one of Italy's longest-lived reds.</i>			
08	Vino Nobile di Montepulciano 13.5%	2006	£ 52.00
Sangiovese Mammolo Canaiolo, Colorino Merlot – Toscana – Villa S. Anna <i>Deep black and almandine rim. The bouquet is powerful, with brandied cherries and plums mingled with some greenish accents and supported by fairly intense sweetness that has slight brown sugar overtones. It gives an impression of considerable ripeness. On the palate it's ample, and fairly sweet, with cherry plum fruit that gains additional sweetness from overripe yellow peaches, and is supported by a combination of slight acidity and smooth bitter tannins that flow into a clean finish. Corvina, Rondinella, Teroldega – Veneto – Stefano Campedelli <i>Valpolicella Superiore is produced by blending juice from late harvested grapes with that from grapes that have been dried for up to 40 days. This gives the wines an extra layer of flavours and a rich, velvety texture.</i>

Sangiovese – Tuscany – Banfi <i>Complex with sweet but delicate notes of jam, well integrated plum and dark cherry, as well as some attractive liquorice, tobacco and leather notes. Powerful and persistent structure, with a nice mixture of soft and sweet tannins.</i>

Nebbiolo – Piemonte – Sorí Paolin, Cascina Luisin <i>Ripe, sweet strawberry nose with a hint of eucalyptus. It is very elegant, with a fruit-driven, ripe palate, and refreshing minerality.</i>
