# H OYO DE MONTERREY

LIGHT FLAVOUR

Hoyo De Monterrey owes its origin to the town of san Juan Martinez, which lies at the heart of the Vuelta Abajo region, pinar del rio. Here the Hoyo de Monterrey plantation, one of the great Vegas Finas de primera, can be reached through a gate on the town's main square inscribed "hoyo de Monterrey, jose gener 1860". Jose gener, a catalan, first used the name of his "vega" on a brand of habanos in 1865. The flavour of the blend found in hoyo makes it an attractive choice for those who seek a delicate yet aromatic Habana that is lighter to the taste, a great choice after lunch for the connoisseur and less regular smoker alike.

# QUAI DORSAY

LIGHT FLAVOUR

This brand owes its origin to the refined taste of the French market. Created in the 1970's, the name is taken from a well-known street in Paris beside the River Seine. Although the current range is small, all Quai d'Orsay sizes are made with a distinctive light tasting blend of filler and binder leaves from the Vuelta Abajo zone and its wrappers are mainly distinguished by their Claro (light brown) and Colorado Claro (mid brown) colours

# SAN CRISTOBAL DE LA HABANA

LIGHT TO MEDIUM  
FLAVOUR

San Cristobal de la Habana was the original name of Havana, Cuba's capital city, when it was founded in 1519; San Cristobal (St Christopher) in honour of Columbus and La Habana after Indian name for the site. All San Cristobal's vitolas are 'Tripa larga, totalmente a mano' – long filler, totally hand made to a light to medium flavoured blend of filler and binder leaves from Vuelta Abajo tobacco zone.

H. Upmann was a banker from Germany who so loved Cuban cigars that he moved to Havana in 1844 and set up as both banker and cigar maker. His bank closed in the early 1920s but his cigars live on as a fine example of an elegant light to medium flavoured Habano. Gold medals in no less than eleven international exhibitions during the 19th century adorn the boxes – as does Herr Upmann's personal signature. The brand today comprises a wide range of sizes which are a firm favourite amongst cigar enthusiasts around the world.

# T RINIDAD

MEDIUM FLAVOUR

Trinidad is named after the beautiful, 16th Century city of La Santísima Trinidad, which lies on Cuba's south coast and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Trinidad cigars were first released to the public at the beginning of 1998 in one size only, the Fundadores, However, long before that Trinidad had earned a worldwide reputation amongst aficionados as Havana's mystery cigar. Production started in 1969 at El Laguito, the Cohiba factory, but only very small quantities were made exclusively for the Cuban Council of State, which gave them as gifts to foreign diplomats and visiting dignitaries. Medium flavoured and a modern classic.

# JUAN LOPEZ

A Spanish businessman named Juan Lopez Diaz founded his brand in the 1870's. Although little known around the world today, Juan Lopez has always attracted a following amongst aficionados of Havanas particularly for the Seleccion No. 1 and, most notably, for the Seleccion No. 2 sizes.

The range offers a consistent medium to full flavour based on a rich blend of filler and binder leaves from the Vuelta Abajo zone and all the sizes are 'tripa larga, totalmente a mano' – long filler, totally hand made.

# ROMEO Y JULIETA

MEDIUM TO FULL  
FLAVOUR

Romeo y Julieta is named after William Shakespeare's tragic lovers and the origins of Romeo y Julieta as a Habano date back to 1875. The brand rose to international fame during the early years of the 20th century under the direction of Don "Pepin" Fernandez, a talented promoter, who was amongst the first to recognise the power of the cigar band. During his heyday no less than 20,000 different bands were used in production. Winston Churchill famously became a devotee of Romeo y Julieta after his visit to Havana in 1946. Since then his name has been commemorated on a band and used to describe the marque's most famous size measuring 7 inches x 47 – the Churchill. Romeo y Julieta's balanced and aromatic blend of selected leaves from the Vuelta Abajo region makes it the classic medium bodied Habano.

# MONTECRISTO

Montecristo is the best known and probably the most loved brand of Habanos throughout the world. It forms the benchmark for many Habanos smokers against which other brands are judged. The name comes from the hero of Alexandre dumas' famous novel "the count of Montecristo", which was a firm favourite when read to the cigar rollers at the factory where it was founded in 1935. Montecristo's perfectly balanced blend of filler is created exclusively with selected leaves from the vuelta abajo region. Its distinctive medium to full flavour and distinguished aroma are unmistakable.

Cohiba is the flagship brand of Habanos and is named after an ancient Taino Indian word for the bunches of tobacco leaves that Columbus first saw being smoked by the original inhabitants of Cuba - the earliest known form of the cigar. Today it is one of the bestselling brands in the world and considered by many to be the most prestigious hand-made cigars money can buy, the reason for which may be partly explained by looking back at the brand's illustrious origins. It was created in 1966 for President Fidel Castro himself and was made at the then top secret but now world famous El Laguito factory. At first, it was only seen outside Cuba as gifts for heads of state and visiting diplomats. The leaves then, as they still are today, were the "selection of the selection" from the five finest tobacco plantations in the Vuelta Abajo region in Cuba. The finest leaves deserve the finest treatment and so the best torcedors (cigar rollers) Cuba had to offer were recruited to work their magic and produce the exquisite Cohiba range. La Linea 1492 range, launched in 1992, offer a medium flavour and are the lightest cigars within the brand.

# PARTAGAS

FULL FLAVOUR

If there is one particularly famous cigar factory in Havana, it is Partagas, which lies in the heart of Havana city. The factory was opened in 1845 by Don Jaime Partagas and it has been making the cigars that bear his name ever since. Now the oldest cigar factory in the world, a Partagas is immediately recognisable by its deep earthy flavour. Sadly Don Jaime would not live to see the success as he was shot dead in his own plantation in 1868. History has failed to record who pulled the trigger, some say it was down to an affair of the heart, other suggest a rival cigar manufacturer was to blame, however his cigars live on.

# RAMON ALLONES

Ramon Allones is one of the big names in the history of Havanas. Founded in 1837, it is also one of the oldest brands still in production. A Galician by birth, Ramon Allones, was the first cigar manufacturer to pack his cigars in boxes decorated with labels and stamped with his brand's emblem. He was the pioneer of the packaging tradition that we know today. All the cigars are filled with a blend of filler and binder tobaccos from Vuelta Abajo zone, characterised by their intense and complex taste.

# MY FATHERS CIGARS

It all began from a very humble beginning when Jose Pepin Garcia and his family established a very small cigar factory in Little Havana in 2003. Garcia could not have imagined at that moment that his love and passion for cigars would help him to build one of the most recognized companies in the cigar industry. The Flor De Las Antillas brand was released by my Father Cigars in May 2012 and were awarded Cigar of the year later that year. Meaning 'Flower of the Antilles', the Flor de las Antillas cigar represents Cuba, the largest island in the Greater Antilles islands, which is home to the Garcia family's rich cigar creating heritage.

# J OYA DE NICARAGUA

Joya De Nicaragua was established in 1968, making it the very first and oldest premium handmade cigar manufacturer in Nicaragua. Numero Uno was originally blended for world leaders, they were only handed out by Nicaraguan ambassadors on official missions around the world. In 2018, to commemorate their 50th Anniversary, Joya gifted some to media and special audiences and got their highest rating in 50 years! They are now officially releasing it as part of Obras Maestras, the designation of their ultra-premium family of cigars

At the age of 21, Winston Churchill visited the Caribbean to observe the Cuban Revolutionary War against Spain. This is when he first decided to give up the cigarette in favour of the cigar. Inspired by Winston Churchill's philosophy of life, Mr. Davidoff hit on the idea of creating an exceptional cigar. The Winston Churchill series is highly complex in terms of taste and aroma, the blends are unlike anything previously available from the Dominican Republic. The result is a spicy, highly aromatic cigar with rich hints of pepper nuts and roasted coffee which will give inspiration to lovers of full-bodied cigars. Only the very best, richly aromatic tobaccos and an exclusive wrapper leaf are used to make these cigars – they are, after all, named after perhaps the most famous cigar smoker of all times – Sir Winston Churchill

The Aging Room Quattro Nicaragua is the first Quattro cigar to be made outside of the Dominican Republic and uses only Nicaraguan tobacco to form the distinctive taste of this cigar. The story of Aging Room revolves around a central character who had no idea he was headed for the cigar business: Rafael Nodal. It's a timeline of transitions, partnerships and collaborations that ultimately lead to the creation of the Aging Room Quattro Nicaragua Maestro. Nodal's foray into the cigar world was slow. In 1998, he and his partners began selling cigars online, and in 2002 they took over the Cuba Cigar Co., a struggling company with a mediocre portfolio of forgettable cigars. For a while, the business situation was looking quite grim. In musical terms, the word for this box-pressed torpedo would be dynamic. Nodal is still an artist at heart and cigars continue to be his creative outlet. If the birth of Aging Room was his breakthrough, consider the Aging Room Quattro Nicaragua Maestro to be his masterpiece.

Prensado means a lot to me and the Alec Bradley story. Rolled at Raices Cubanas ('Cuban Roots') factory, the Prensado was first created to pay homage to the Cuban traditions of cigar making rolling the filler 'entuba-do,' triple capping the head and box pressing the finished cigar. Blended with proprietary estate grown corajo from the Trojes region of Honduras, Prensado would eventually be named Cigar Aficionado "Cigar of the Year," propelling Alec Bradley's trajectory into cigar culture much quicker than I anticipated.

Melanio Oliva cultivated his first tobacco crop in Pinar Del Rio, Cuba in 1886. His growing operations were suspended while he fought in the Cuban War of Independence. After returning from the war, Melanio resumed his tobacco growing operations. In the early 1920's Melanio's son Facundo Oliva took over the growing operations. Facundo cultivated the Oliva family tobacco fields for several decades. In the early 60's the pressure became too great and Gilberto traveled from country to country in search of the conditions to recreate that distinctive Cuban taste. His travels took him to Honduras, Panama, Mexico and even the Philippines. Gilberto finally found fertile ground in Nicaragua. Today Gilberto along with his family are Nicaragua's second largest grower of Cuban-seed tobacco. Using these same time tested methods of curing, blending, and rolling that built an empire, the Oliva cigar lineup has garnered tons of top- ratings from industry experts and consumers alike.
