WINE MENU

- SPARKLING AND CHAMPAGNE

La Vita Sociale Processo Spumante , Italy £43.00
It is a prosecco that has the DOC status and of the highest quality. prosecco is an aromatic and fruity Prosecco with a bouquet of peach and melon.

Moët & Chandon Imperial Brut Champagne, France £87.00
It has unique Moët & Chandon style: bright fruitiness, seductive palate and it's elegant maturity. The delicious sumptuousness of white-fleshed fruits - pear, peach and apple

Moët & Chandon Rose Imperial Champagne, France £96.00
A lively, intense bouquet of red fruits - wild strawberry, raspberry, cherry. Floral nuances of rose and a slight hint of pepper.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut Champagne, France £140.00
Champagne is full of yellow and white fruits, vanilla and toasty aromas. It holds perfectly the strength and silkiness with aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness.

Veuve Clicquot Rose Champagne, France £160.00
In 1818, Madame Clicquot invented first known blended Rose champagne ever. Expressive aromas of strawberry and a very ripe wild strawberries. A full bodied and structured champagne.

2018 All Angels, Sparkling Rosé, Enborne, West Berkshire, England £125.00
A deep rosé, reflecting the summer berry flavours of this delicious and slightly feminine of sparkling wines, delicately balanced with subtle, long lasting bubbles.

2018 All Angels, Classic Cuvée, Enborne, West Berkshire, England £115.00
Light straw gold in colour, beautifully textured, dry, fresh citrus flavoured, with consistent, long lasting bubbles.

2018 Perelada, Stars Brut Reserva, DO Cava, Spain £45.00
Pale yellow colour with greenish hints. Bright and clean. Its generous stream of fine bubbles forms a perfect crown.

2020 Perelada, Stars Touch of Rosé, DO Cava, Spain £48.00
Delicate pink in colour. Bright and limpid. Its fine bubbles detach, forming a crown on the surface. Its aroma is clean, floral and fruity, long lasting and elegant.

DRY & CRISP

2022 Pinot Grigio, IGT , Biscardo, Mabis, Veneto, Italy £33.00
Floral aroma and an abundance of tropical fruit, melon, guava and peach with zippy acidity on the palate.

2022 Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de Montredon, Languedoc & South West, France £38.00
Crisp and mineral, with a delicate exotic fruit aroma and a fresh, salty finish. Just perfect with simple seafood.

2022 Albariño, Pazo de Señorans, Galicia, Spain £68.00
Intense and very expressive. Immense volume and great body.

2022 Produttori del Gavi Il Forte, Gavi DOCG, Piedmont, Italy, £47.00
This is fresh, sapid, easy to drink with a mildly almond finish. Harmonious and balanced.

2022 Sancerre Blanc, Domain Picard, Loire, France £62.00
Pure, crisp, grassy, lean and racy with complex flavours of citrus and mineral.

2021 Pouilly Fumé, Les Loges, Domaine Pierre Marchand, Loire, France £82.00
A complex, concentrated example of Pouilly Fumé with well balanced, crisp gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf fruit overlaid with hints of citrus and mineral.

- AROMATIC VARIETALS

- 2022 Mayfly, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** £38.00
No tricks here, just a youthful and exquisite Sauvignon Blanc with prominent asparagus, mature peach and exotic fruit notes on the nose.
- 2022 Produttori Di Manduria, Alice, IGT, Puglia Italy** £46.00
The nose shows aromatic white flowers mixed with citrus notes as well as pear and pineapple.
- 2019 Riesling, Mount Edward, Central Otago, New Zealand** £65.00
A vibrant aroma of apple blossom and orange zest with a hint of ginger, leads to a bracingly fresh palate of apple and lime.

- FULL & RICH, CHARDONNAY

- 2021 Condrieu, Domaine de Bonserine, Rhône, France** £130.00
A beautiful example of this small but very distinctive appellation. The acidity is zippy & the finish incredibly long.
- 2022 Original Chenin Blanc, Raats Family Wines, Stellenbosch, South Africa** £50.00
100% Chenin Blanc, this has a distinctive yellow apple and pineapple core, alongside notes of green melon and limes.
- 2022 Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, Thistledown, South Australia, Australia** £55.00
Citrusy, subtle oak influence and a bright yet creamy palate.
- 2021 Chablis 1er Cru Vau-ligneau, Domaine Michaut Freres, Burgundy, France** £86.00
A vivid yellow with a hint of green. A mineral and fruity wine with a remarkable length in the mouth.
- 2019 Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, Crossbarn, Paul Hobbs, California, USA** £87.00
A refreshing chardonnay which is fragrant with white flowers, pear and citrus.
- 2021 Chassagne-Montrachet Blanc, Domaine Pillot, Burgundy, France** £150.00
The palate is warming, yet pure, concentrated and balanced with white fruit and peach with discreet oak notes.

- ROSÉ

- 2021 Mas Donis Rosat, Celler de Capçanes, Montsant, Spain** £30.00
Think strawberry and raspberry fruits with a hint of herb and spice combined with a lovely sweetness of fruit.
- 2022 Château L'Escarelle, Les deux Anges Rosé, AOP Côteaux Varois en Provence, Spain** £55.00
Subtle and elegant with wild strawberry and citrus fruit on the nose. The palate is clean and fresh with beautiful smoothness and notes of mango and pomelo.

- RED

RUSTIC, HERBAL & SPICY

- 2021 Cunning Plan Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Thistledown, South Australia, Australia** £49.00
Great depth of ripe plum and blackberry flavours. Full bodied with lively spices and velvety tannins.
- 2020 Produttori Di Manduria, Lirica, DOC, Puglia, Italy** £48.00
A pure nose of ripe dark fruits, cherry, plum and sweet spices like ginger and aniseed supported with discreet oak.
- 2020 Chianti Classico, Riecine, Tuscany, Italy** £68.00
Succulent, red fruit with fine, powerful tannins. This Sangiovese has taken on a Pinot Noir like guise.
- 2017 Brunello Di Montalcino, DOCG, San Polino, Tuscany, Italy** £149.00
This is an elegant, well-structured wine with an aroma of dark fruit, plums, blackcurrent, tobacco, spices, a hint of black pepper, liquorice, then violet and orange zest.
- 2020 Stone Soil Select Malbec, Paraje Altamira, Uco Valley, Argentina** £49.00
Silky texture with a racy flash of acidity on the finish. Excellent plum fruit, herbal hints and wonderful structure with fig flavours on the long finish.
- 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, Paul Hobbs, California, USA** £280.00
The generous and savoury palate excites with black fig, dark chocolate, tobacco leaf and graphite.
- 2019 Viña Cobos, Bramare Appellation Malbec, Valle de Uco, Argentina** £98.00
Red fruit, cassis and smoke on the nose. Luscious plum, blackberry and mocha on the palate with hints of oak and leather. A must-try wine!

PINOT NOIR & GAMAY

- 2021 Pinot Noir, Cartlidge and Browne, California, USA** £55.00
Bright flavours of cherries, raspberries and ripe tomatoes are balanced by a layer of vanilla meringue.
- 2018 Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, Crossbarn, Paul Hobbs, California, USA** £125.00
Fresh blueberry and red clay combine with invigorating acidity as it evolves across the palate, ending with the power and grace that's in character with its coastal influences.

BURGUNDY AND BORDEAUX

- 2021 Bourgogne, Pinot Noir, Domaine Fichet, Burgundy, France** £60.00
A very good starting point for those unfamiliar with Burgundy.
- 2021 Pommard, Tavannes, Domaine Pillot, Burgundy, France** £145.00
It offers substantial body and a round mouthfeel, with cherry, blackberry and spice aromas which echo on the palate, supported by fine, slightly dry tannins.
- 2014 Château de Ferrand Grand Cru Classé, Château de Ferrand Bordeaux, France** £142.00
It is powerful on the nose, boasting controlled ageing aromas and intense black fruit.
- 2012 Château Pontet-Canet Bio 5ème Cru Classé, Château Pontet-Canet, Bordeaux, France** £285.00
Red fruits dominate the nose with a rather fragrant edge to the fruit almost masking the notes of violets. Redcurrant and violet character.
- 2015 Château de Garraud, Château de Garraud, Bordeaux, France** £86.00
Aromas of ripe dark fruit and oak followed by a rich, intensely ripe, plummy fruit on the palate.

- 2014 Chanzy, Charmes-Chambertin, Grand Cru, Côte de Nuits, Burgundy, France** £450.00
The nose suggests a rich aromatic palette of small red fruits, spices and flowers, and the powerful mouth ends with a very elegant and long finish.
- 2016 Chanzy, Échezeaux, Grand Cru, Côte de Nuits, Burgundy, France** £490.00
Round and fruity on the palate with silky smooth tannins and a beautiful persistence on the finish. This Grand Cru presents a full and balanced structure which suggests an excellent aging potential.
- 2016 Château Talbot 4ème Cru Classé, St-Julien, Bordeaux, France** £380.00
Perfumed nose of violet and cassis with mineral tones. Fresh and energetic on the palate, with suave flavors of dark berries, minerals and dry herbs. This captivating Talbot has lovely length and balance.
- Château Léoville-Barton 2ème Cru Classé, Bordeaux, France** £340.00
Intense colour, the nose is full of aromas of black fruit, spice and cedar. The palate is fresh and balanced, the juice is intense and delicate.

FULL & POWERFUL

- 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon, Majella, Coonawarra, Australia** £70.00
Aubergine purple colour with a ruby hue, blackcurrants and vanilla on the nose. Complex, with rich plum fruits.
- 2018 Barolo, DOCG, Cascina Adelaide, Piedmont, Italy** £95.00
A superb Barolo, with aromas of orange skin, plums and tobacco leaves.
- 2020 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, Bel Ami, Guillaume Gonnet, Rhône, France** £120.00
A red and black fruit bouquet of cherries and blackberries, a hint of garrigue, liquorice and spice. A fine wine.
- 2017 Amarone della Valpolicella, Campo León, DOCG, Ilatium Morini, Castilla y León, Spain** £130.00
Ripe black fruit, sour cherries, herby and earthy, rich and prune, intense, lovely balance.

SOFT & JUICY

- 2019 Montepulciano d' Abruzzo Dop, Italy** £33.00
*Small red berries, wild cherry, violets.
 Delicate and spicy full bodied with lively spices and velvet tannis.*
