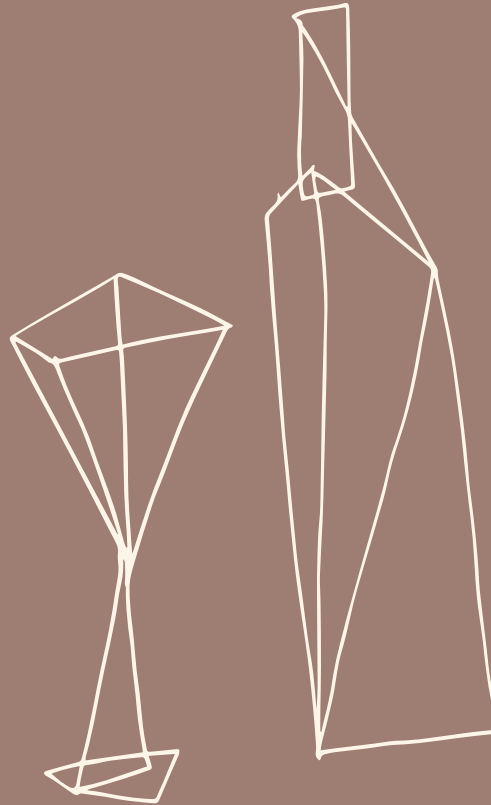

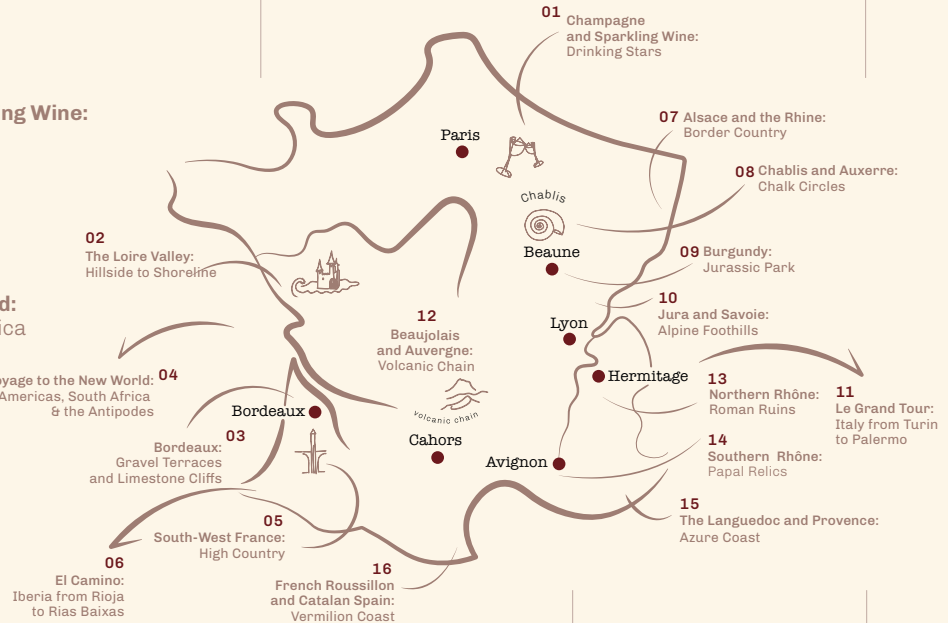

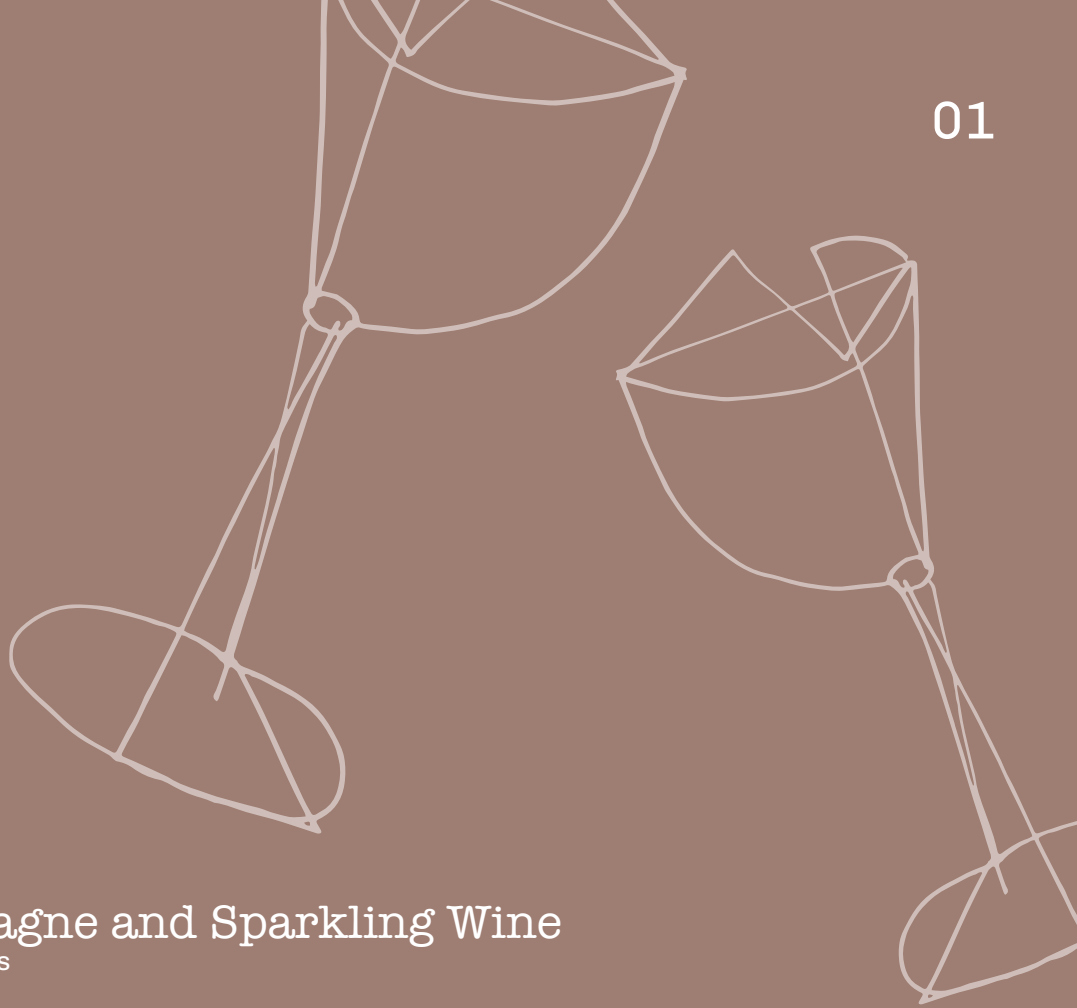

### Champagne Philipponnat

The Philipponnat family have been cultivating vines around the town of Mareuil-Sur-Aÿ since 1522, and six centuries later the house is presided over by Charles Philipponnat.

### Clos des Goisses

Philipponnat has owned an exceptional walled vineyard, the Clos des Goisses, for nearly a century. In the old Champagne dialect the name of this 5.5 hectare plot means a very steep slope. It is also the warmest terroir of the region: facing due south, this pure chalk slope receives no shade from sunrise to sunset. It is considered the most consistently great single vineyard wine in all of Champagne.

### Valley of the Loire Hillside to Shoreline

White chalk soils are the signature of central France and the vineyards of Sancerre are some of the most famous planted on these calcified fossil remains. As France's longest river turns west at Orléans the Loire continues its lazy 629 mile journey to the Atlantic, passing the tuffeau chalk caves of Vouvray, until granite soils take over at the sea swept coast of Muscadet.

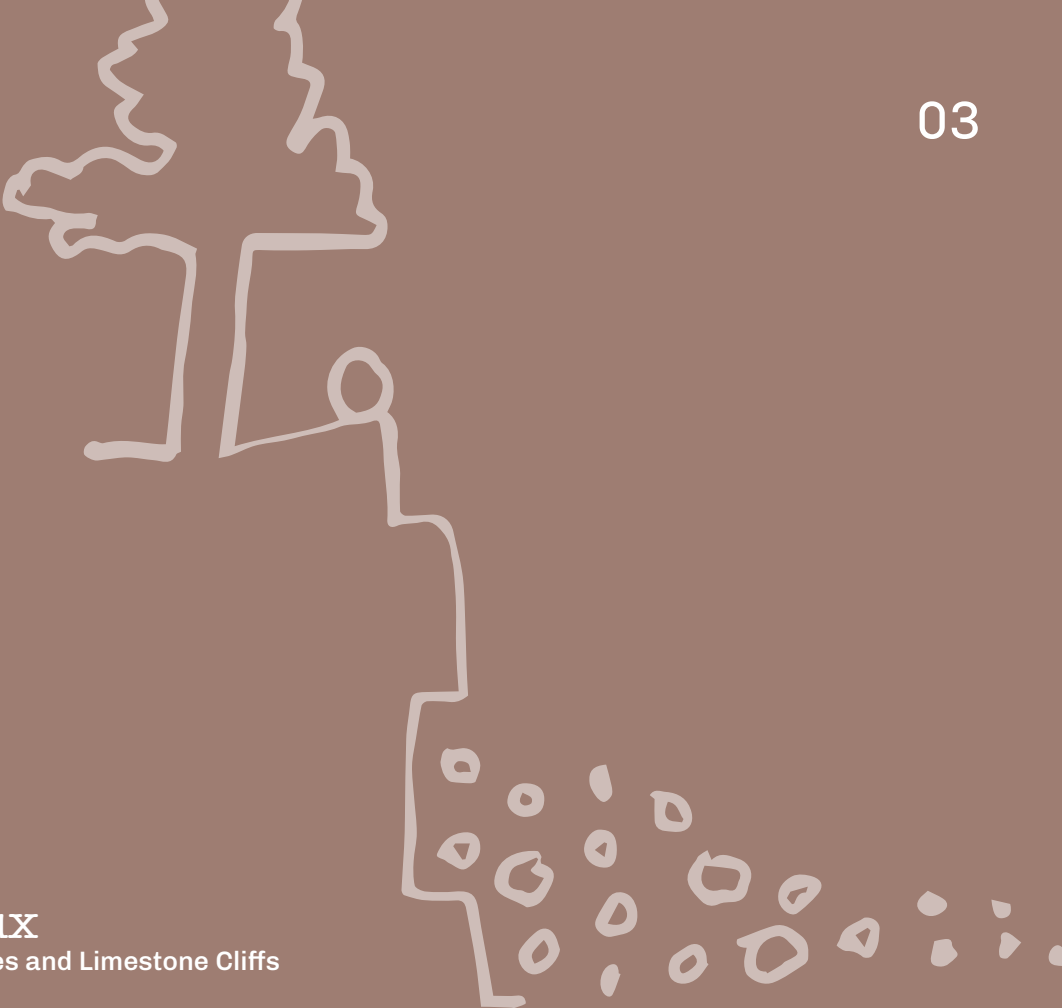

### Voyage to the New World

The Americas,

Around the middle of the nineteenth century French winemakers started to notice that their vineyards were dying. The cause was soon identified as the phylloxera aphid which had been imported by accident along with a consignment of American vine cuttings. The destroyer, as it became known, had a devastating impact that was felt all over Europe, forcing bankrupt families to flee to other parts of the world. Although vines may be grafted to allow them to continue producing grapes, phylloxera remains a global problem with no cure, and this section of the list pays homage to those who pioneered winemaking in the new world.

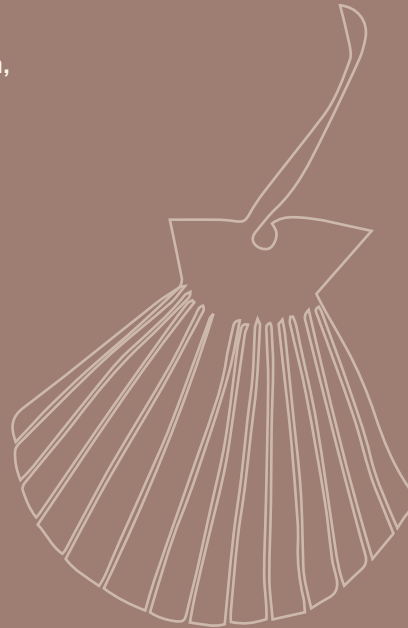

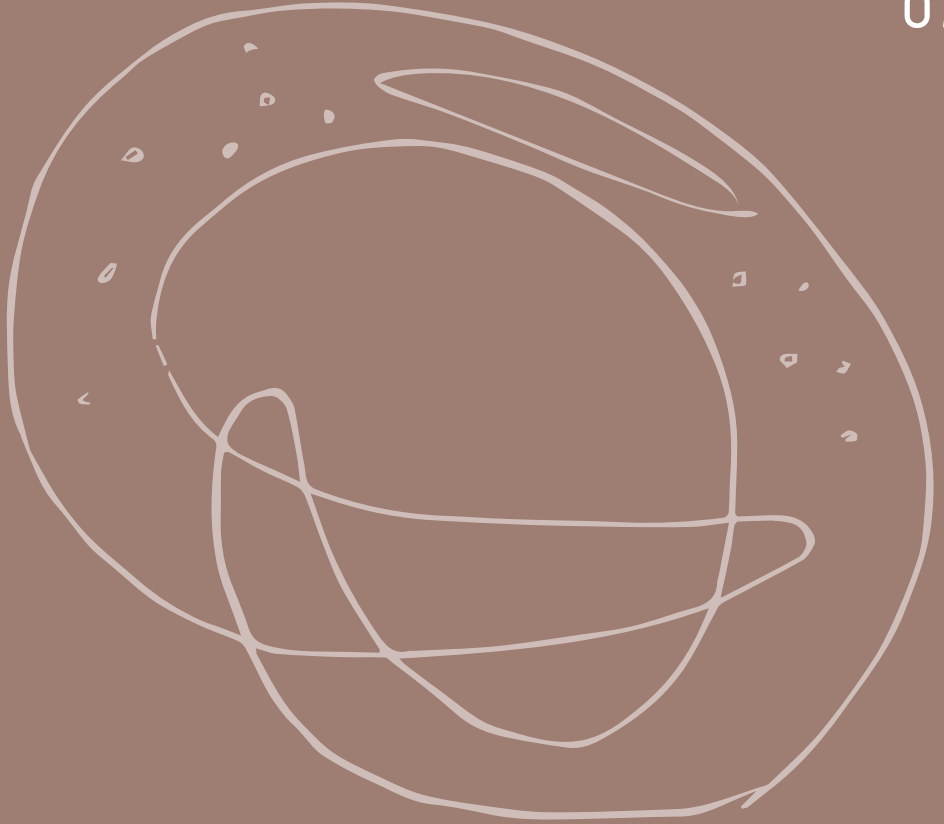

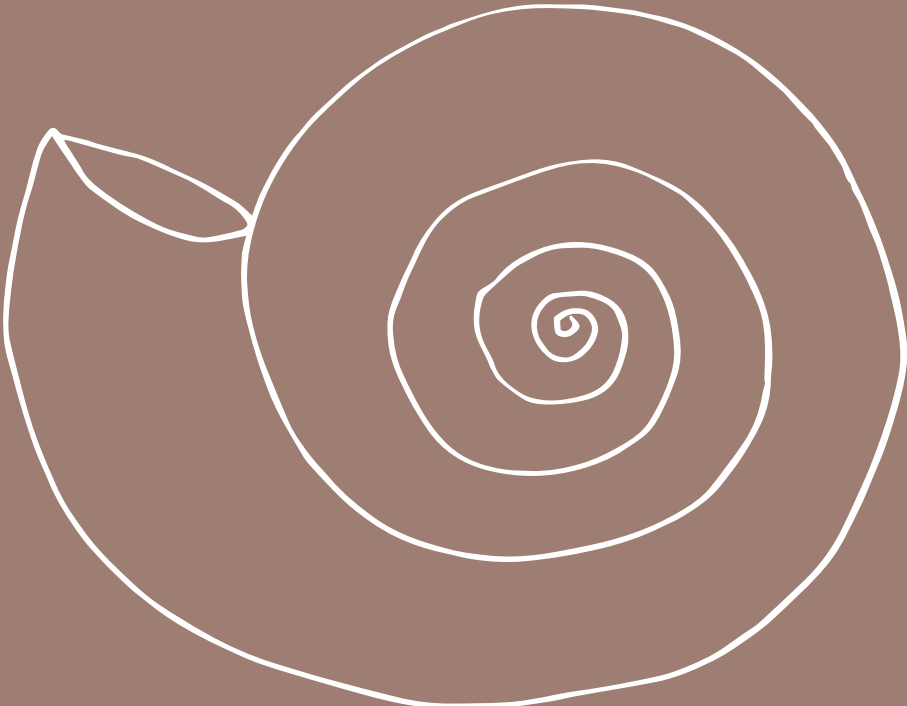

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The sherry-like vin jaune is by law aged for six and a half years under a protective veil or voile of native yeasts, and develops a complex, nutty character, reminiscent of walnut. It is bone dry and lightly oxidative. The combination with the local Comté cheese is one of the world's greatest food and wine matches.

Leaving Burgundy heading eastwards towards the Alps, limestone starts to mix with glacial deposits, especially in the higher altitude vineyards of Savoie and its ski resorts. To the north, Franche-Comté is a mirror of Burgundy with its clay limestone soils and celebrated Comté cheese which pairs so well with the local vin jaune. Nestled between the two, the Jura offers a thrilling mix of tradition and discovery with its incense-like reds and nutty, mineral whites.

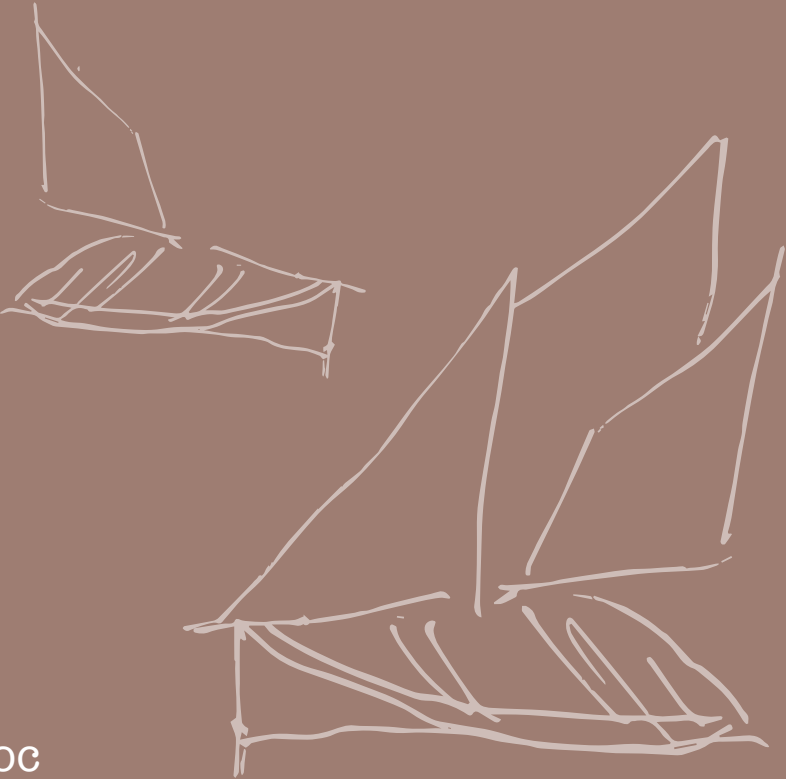

### Southern Rhône Papal Relics

Plunging south from Montélimar, the Rhône enters a different terrain: a broad flood plain composed of mixed soils of sand, clay and limestone that supports a wealth of grape varieties. Nearly 95% of the wines are red and based on the Grenache grape, which conveys the heady wild herb scents and ripe fruit flavours of the south so easily. These are generous, gourmand wines.

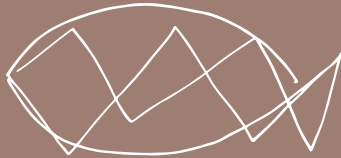
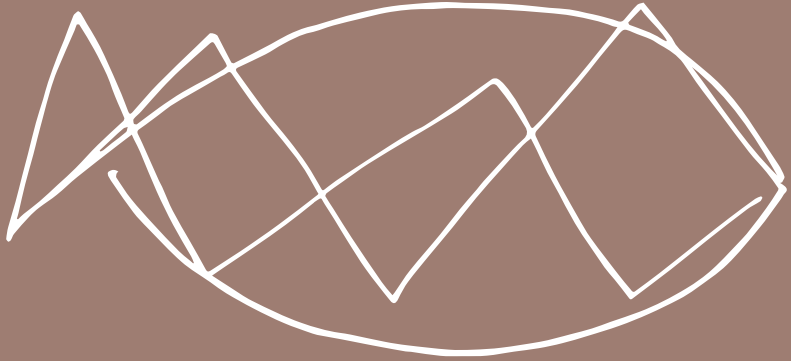

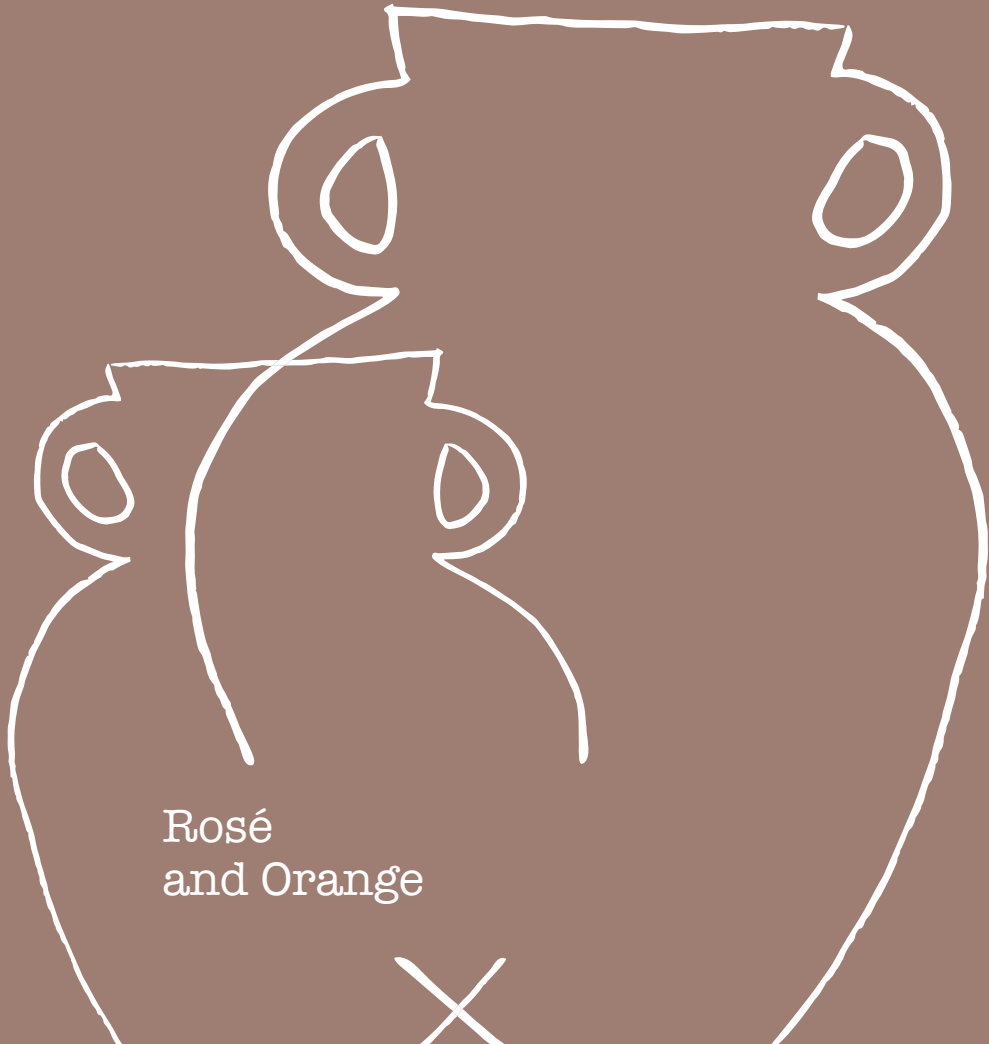

### French Roussillon and Catalan Spain Vermilion Coast

Where the Pyrenees sweep down to the Mediterranean the charming port towns of Collioure and Banyuls-sur-Mer are the jewels of a rugged coastline dotted with vineyards of old vines eking out meagre yields in dry schist soils. This tiny, little explored region of France was for centuries part of Catalan Spain and its identity remains strongly rooted in that language and culture. Across the border exciting wines are made from Empordà down to the dramatic hillsides of Priorat near Barcelona. On both sides of the border the wines are rich yet crammed with a thrilling mineral freshness.

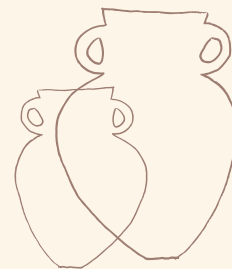

## 18 Sweet and Fortified
