<i>An incredibly rich Cognac created by the House of Tesseron, originally crafted for a European royal family (no hints as to which one in particular). It comes presented in a bottle that looks like the sort of thing you'd see held aloft majestically by a statue near the end of an Indiana Jones film, which is wonderful.</i>

<i>Intense with creamy, buttery notes, robust and lingering finish characterized by subtly spicy dark chocolate notes.</i>

<i>Notes of sweet almond, vanilla, white chocolate and orange essence.</i>	
Flor de Caña 7 years old, Nicaraguan	£8.00
<i>Aromas of toasted coconut, vanilla and fig are joined by flavours of honey and dark chocolate.</i>	
Sailor Jerry's Spiced, Barbados	£7.00
<i>Sailor Jerry's Spiced rum is crafted from a blend of Caribbean rums that are blended and infused with spices and other flavours including vanilla.</i>	
Don Papa Spiced, Philippines	£10.00
<i>Distilled in small batches from sugar cane, grown on the Philippines island of Negros and aged in American oak for 7 years. This is packed with vanilla flavours and a hint of spice.</i>	
Diplomático Reserva Exclusiva, Venezuela	£12.00
<i>A fabulous Venezuelan dark golden rum, distilled from molasses in a copper pot still before 12 years of ageing. Rich, sweet and fruity, just how we like 'em.</i>	
Flor De Caña 12 year old, Nicaraguan	£12.00
<i>Aromas of red fruit, honey and toasted nut are joined on the palate by oak, vanilla and baked apples.</i>	
Flor De Caña 18 year old, Nicaraguan	£13.50
<i>A luxurious golden rum from celebrated Nicaraguan distillers Flor de Cana, aged for 18 years in small white oak casks. Marvellously mellow stuff, with notes of nuts, caramel, vanilla and spice followed by a lingering finish.</i>	
Ron Zacapa 23, Guatemala	£15.00
<i>Ron Zacapa Solera 23 is adored for its raw honey, cinnamon, vanilla and caramel flavour notes.</i>	

- RUM

- Diamond Distillery 2000 16 Years Old, Guyana** 50 ml
£17.00
The Nectar of the Daily Drams is a brand originally created by 2 members of The Nectar in Belgium. Basically, whiskey enthusiasts, they have extended their passion to rum and seek the best rum for bottles under their label. The nose is discreetly woody with notes of dried fruit and exotic fruits. On the palate, alcohol is present but not aggressive. A very robust rum, well balanced, not aggressive. At the end of the mouth, there are notes of spices with pepper, clove and vanilla. Nice finish.
- Kill Devil, Guyana Enmore 1992 25 Years Old, Guyana** £23.50
This is a single-cask rum from Hunter Laing's Kill Devil series. Distilled in Enmore's unique wooden still in February 1992, this was aged for 25 years, with the cask yielding 347 bottles.
- Plantation Fiji 2009, Fiji** £12.50
A 2009 vintage Fijian rum from the plantation range, produced by the South Pacific distillery and bottled as part of the plantation range. It was initially matured in bourbon casks for 7 years before being shipped over to France for a finishing period in Cognac casks for further 2 years.

- Glenauchers 8 years old, Carn Mor 2010 46%** 50 ml

A mild, gentle, solely aged sherry speyside whisky.
- Glen Spey 2007 G&M Connoisseurs Choice 46%** £11.50
- Inchgower 2005 G&M Connoisseurs Choice 46%** £13.00
Dried fruits, sultana, stewed green apple, well balanced.
- Craugellachie 13 Years Old** £11.00
Often robust, this expression comes quite light, floral, packed with spices.
- Dailuaine 10 Years Old 46%** £11.50
This is from a sherry butt, very light, fresh, buttery.
- Strathisla 12 Years Old 40%** £9.00
It's the main malt that goes into chivas, fruity and peppery.
- Tomintoul 10 Years Old 40%** £8.95
Stated as "the gentle dram", it is light, fruity, barley sugar, toffee and lingering spicy in the back. Recommended to everyone as introduction to scotch whisky.
- Tomintoul 12 Years Old 40%** £12.00
Similar to the above, but spending a final part of the maturation in oloroso sherry cask. Very similar to balvenie 12 years old, more mild due to the lack of peat.
- Benromach 15 Years Old 43%** £14.50
This expression is elegant but robust whisky aged in selected bourbon and sherry casks, enclosed in a hint of smoke. classy and at the same time unusual speysider.
- Glen Elgin 12 Years Old 43%** £12.00
Marvellous every day whisky, nothing to envy to the other 12 year old out there in the market.
- Glenfarclas 10 Years Old 40%** £8.50
With notes of baked pastries, ovaltine (malty) and some chocolaty notes on the back, it's a complex whisky compared to many others of the same "age".
- Glenfarclas 105 60%** £13.75
The very first nas (no age statement) whisky ever released, 105 refers to the british proof, in this case 60% alcohol. for sherry bomb lovers.
- Crabbie 30 Years Old 48.6%** £170.00
By an undisclosed speyside distillery, really uncommon to experience such a dram, kept secretly for over 30 years in a sherry, an astonishing dram and really rare. 330 bottles produced.
- Singleton Of Dufftown 12 Year Old 40%** £10.00
Straightforward, nutty and malty single malt from speyside.
- Aberlour 10 Years Old 40%** £9.50
A great entry-level malt, ideal for beginners, with a fine sherried spiciness.

Balvenie 12 Years Old Double Wood 40%	£11.00
Balvenie 14 Years Old Double Wood 40%	£12.50
<i>First aged in refill bourbon cask then finished in a first filled sherry, lots of toffee and vanilla notes from the youngest dram of the distillery.</i>	
Balvenie 21 Years Old Portwood 40%	£32.00
<i>The extra maturation in old port pipes gives extra fruity and smoky notes to this whisky, perfect as after dinner, un-chill filtered.</i>	
Balvenie 30 Years Old 47.3%	£110.00
<i>A perfect combination of american and european oak, this is a smooth but also very complex dram from balvenie, honey in a bottle.</i>	
Glenfiddich 12 Years Old 40%	£8.50
<i>Aged in bourbon and sherry cask, it's one of the world's bestselling malts.</i>	
Glenfiddich Project Xx 47%	£11.75
Glenfiddich Ipa Cask 40%	£11.50
<i>Are you a beer and whisky lover? then this is for you. very suitable for a paring with an ipa and cheese.</i>	
Glenfiddich 18 Years Old 40%	£16.50
<i>Mature for at least 18 years in a combination of ex bourbon and oloroso sherry casks, expect a well balance, never boring malty and gentle whisky.</i>	
Glenfiddich 26 Years Old 40%	£87.00
<i>26 Years in refill cask.</i>	
Glenkinchie 12 Year Old 43%	£9.50
<i>A classic, green apple and barley sugar.</i>	
Auchentoshan 12 Year Old 40%	£9.50
<i>Elegant and refined, with classic auchentoshan notes of vanilla and almonds.</i>	
Dalmore 15 Years Old 40%	£16.00
<i>Here's our entry level dalmore, a combination of matusalem, apostoles and amoroso sherry casks for a rounded and well balanced whisky.</i>	
Dalmore Cigar Malt 44%	£19.75
<i>American oak, 30 years old oloroso and premier cru cabernet sauvignon cask join forces and provide a whisky that is best followed up by a cigar, partagas serie d no. 4 to be exact.</i>	
Dalmore King Alexander lii 43%	£43.50
<i>Initially aged in bourbon cask, the whisky is then split into: madeira, marsala, port pipes, matusalem sherry and cabernet sauvignon wine. Juicy, heavy and tick, doesn't burn, doesn't arm, a must to try.</i>	
Dalmore Quintessence 45%	£153.00
<i>Matured in bourbon casks and finished in five different types of californian red wine cask: zinfandel, merlot, cabernet sauvignon, syrah and pinot noir. Dark forest berries and red wine tannins.</i>	
Dalmore 25 Years Old 42%	£126.00
<i>American white oak followed up by a combination of palomino fino sherry butt and first fill bourbon casks. These are then married together in bourbon barrels before a finishing period in tawny port pipes. Outstanding complexity of exotic fruit and deep aromas.</i>	
Dalmore 35 Years Old 40%	£555.00
<i>Another mind blowing combination of casks from dalmore: matusalem sherry, bourbon barrel and a colheita-port pipe. notes of coffee, banana and treacle predominates this 35 years old whisky.</i>	
Glendronach 12 Years Old 43%	£11.00
<i>The introduction to the core range of glendronach, a perfectly aged sherry whisky, the character is fuller and beefier than others, shows its best in sherry and on long term maturation.</i>	
Fettercairn 12 Years Old 40%	£12.00
<i>Packed with tropical fruits, oily and full of esters, this 12 years old has nothing to lose compared to older whiskies</i>	
Fettercairn 28 Years Old 42%	£78.00
<i>The distillate is very fruity, anyway, within longer again the "rancio" feels comes through mixing old musky oaky notes with tropical fruits. Not all distillates can be proud of such evolution during maturation</i>

Glenmorangie Nectar D'or 12 Years Old 46%	50ml £15.00
<i>This single malt spent couple of years in sauternes casks, hence the colour, and the taste. Nectarines and soft riped apricots in syrup.</i>	
Glenmorangie Signet 46%	£30.50
<i>Notes of coffee, vanilla and chocolate surround this delicate dram.</i>	
Ancnoc 12years Old 40%	£8.50
<i>12 Years aged in ex-bourbon cask, robust highland style, simple and efficient as palate warmer.</i>	
Oban 14 Years Old 43%	£12.00
<i>A coastal whisky rich of iodium, dried figs, spices and peppery notes, touch of smoke.</i>	
Wolfburn 46%	£11.50
<i>Wolfburn opened its doors in 2012, small stills and young whiskies plenty of flavour. this is their flagship, not much influenced by the oak and the wood notes, very spirit driven.</i>	
Aberfeldy 12 Years Old 40%	£10.50
<i>Aberfeldy, produces and aromatic style of single malt, unpeated, most of it ends up in deward's blended whisky.</i>	
Balblair 2005 (2018) 1st Release 46%	£10.50
<i>Quietly distilling since 1790, the owners don't believe that an age statement should represent the whisky, the whisky is good when it's ready, therefore all the releases follow up a vintage scheme (once the stock is finished they pass into the next year available).</i>	
Loch Lomond Original 40%	£7.50
John Crabbie 8 Year Old 46%	£8.00
<i>Sweet and delicate floral notes, with subtle hints of ripe apricots. delightfully balanced with honey, malty notes at first, followed by warming layers of vanilla and ripened summer fruits. Long and light, malty finish.</i>	
Kilkerran 12 Years Old 46%	£9.50
<i>Aged in 70% bourbon casks and 30% sherry, un-chill filtered and uncoloured, peated, but it is almost imperceptible. Old style and retro, a splendid 12 years old.</i>	
Laphroaig 10 Years Old 40%	£10.00
<i>Citrusy and salty peated whisky from islay, a classic.</i>	
Ardberg 10years Old 46%	£11.00
Ardberg Uigeadail 54.2%	£15.00
<i>The smokiness of the ardberg refined in sherry cask, at cask strength, a mighty meaty whisky.</i>	
Caol Ila 12 Years Old 43%	£12.50
<i>Another classic from the biggest producer of whisky in the entire island, oily, briny, a bit of tar and vanilla to complete a medium body peated whisky.</i>	
Lagavulin 16 Years Old	£12.50
<i>Seaweed, iodine and peat and gathered together in one bottle, a very punchy and medicinal whisky, some influence of sherry lingering in the back.</i>	
Kilchoman Machir Bay 46%	£11.50
<i>From the latest established distillery on the island, kilchoman express its best at young age, the style is new, definitely not austere. Quite similar to caol ila, more robust and peppery.</i>	
Bruichladdich The Classic Laddie 50%	£11.50
<i>Un-chill filtered, colouring-free, unpeated and with an abv of 50%, this whisky it's set to represent the expression of the terroir of islay and the barley from the hebrides.</i>	
Port Charlotte 50%	£12.50
<i>45 Ppm, very ardberry, more fruity, malty, you can still feel that on the bone is a bruichladdich but with plenty of firey smoke.</i>	
Octomore 9.1 5 Years Old 59.1%	£24.00
<i>No consistency here, just supramental cask usage, re-aging, and finishing (from port to virgin oak), every release as a different ppm content. Awarded most heavily peated whisky in the world!</i>	
The Cask Of Islay 46%	£8.50
<i>Independent bottling of a. d. rattray, the provenience of the whisky is undisclosed but it is certainly bourbon and hogshead sherry casks. A good introduction to islay whiskies.</i>

Crabbie 12 Years Old 43% <i>A bit briny and salty, sweet, oak spice and a hint of sherry.</i>	50ml £9.50
Talisker 10 Years Old 45.8% <i>Salty, with a more accentuated peppery and orangey flavour enclosed in smoke.</i>	£11.00
Arran Marsala Cask Finish 50% <i>Arran has decided to reuse cask that previously held marsala, a sweet wine produced in sicily, expect notes of orange peels toasted oak and baked apples, the higher abv packs everything in a thigh, vibrant whisky.</i>	£10.00
Arran Sauternes Cask Finish 50% <i>Part of the same range of the marsala, this arran has been finished in casks that previously held sauternes. the fortified wine influence here is more evident. very enjoyable, more soft than the marsala, more on the fresh apricots and ripe peaches.</i>	£10.00
Ledaig 10 Years Old 46.3% <i>Here the heavily peated version, peat lovers, you really need to try this.</i>	£10.50
Jura 10 Years Old "Origin" 40% <i>The island of jura faces islay, enough said the character is quite similar but the distillate comes out oilier and perhaps, with the help of peat, greasy.</i>	£9.50
Jura 12 Years Old 40% <i>Recently released from a new core range, this time the distillery is focusing in a softer sherry and slightly peated style.</i>	£11.50
Jura 18 Years Old 42% <i>Part of the liquid has been finished in premier gran cru barriques from bordeaux, dalmore gets some of the finest and as far as i know whyte & mackay owns both.</i>	£17.50
Jura 21 Years Old 44% <i>It is first fully matured in ex-bourbon casks then finished in vintage 1963 gonzales byass bodega sherry. spicy, smoky with some sweet wine finish and coastal aromas.</i>	£28.00
Compass Box - Great King Street 43% <i>A gentle and floral blend from compass box, non-chill filtered and no colourants added. 33% grain whisky and 67% malt.</i>	£10.00
Compass Box - Great King Street Glasgow Blend <i>Same style of the whisky above but slightly more peated and robust. Great with soda or in cocktails.</i>	£9.50
Compass Box – Spice Tree 46% <i>After the blending process, the whisky is rested in barrels where the heads have been replaced with toasted french oak.</i>	£12.00
Monkey Shoulder 40% <i>Glenfiddich, balvenie and kininvie in one bottle; smooth with a touch of spice.</i>	£9.50
Eagle Rare 46% <i>Aged between 8 to 10 years, part of the buffalo trace products, quite high in rye.</i>	£11.00
Baker's 7 Years Old 53.5% <i>Jim beam distillery is still using 60 years old yeast to ferment the wort of this bourbon.</i>	£11.00
Sazerac Rye 45% <i>An all-time favourite tribute to the sazerac cocktail.</i>	£10.50
