“Tony and Kaye Prichard built De La Terre winery entirely by hand (and paw, with the help of winery dog Gracie) picking their first vintage in 2009. This 2015 Reserve Viognier was produced in a tiny amount, with each bottle being individually hand numbered. It is a leaner, more focused style as opposed to the opulent, oily character typical of the variety. Fermented in old barrels, with an incredible amount of bottle age - which results in a medium bodied, mineral driven palate, with white stone fruit and subtle, well integrated oak influence. You can almost taste the limestone terrace on which the low yielding vines are planted.”

“Eyrie Vineyards was established in 1965 by David Lett – the first to realise the incredible potential of Willamette Valley for growing Pinot Noir. The vines were established without any use of chemicals, and that practice continues today. This is an elegant 'Old World' style of Pinot Noir made from hand picked grapes, without any heavy extraction, and fermented in old, large oak vessels. The result is beautifully balanced with layers of dried red fruits, spice and earthiness. The subtle tannins are well-integrated making it an ideal complement to seafood.”

“Situated within the heart of Tokaji, Chateau Dereszla have been producing wine for over 500 years. 'Puttonyos' refers to the level of sugar - traditionally measured by the number of baskets of sweet, botrytised grapes added to a barrel of wine. This Tokaji shows perfect balance between honey sweetness and high, refreshing acidity. It has layers of caramel, nutty flavours alongside quince and baked stone fruits.
