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LOMBARDIA

Lombardy's Franciacorta region is celebrated for its sparkling wine, produced using the traditional method used in Champagne. The region's wines are characterized by a rich and complex flavor profile, making them a must-try for any wine enthusiast.

VENETO

It is home to Prosecco, a sparkling wine made from Glera grapes, and that it is typically light, fruity, and refreshing.

EMILIA ROMAGNA

Lambrusco di Sorbara "Radice Paltrineri" is a very unique one. Made with the ancestral method, and a low maceration on the skin that makes it a Rosè, it is fresh, mineral and perfect with seafood.

A Pét-Nat sparkling rosé. Fruity aromas, with notes of grapefruit, strawberries, and roses. Fresh with pomegranate and green apple flavours.

- Col Fondo “Sottoriva” | Malibran | Veneto | 2020** **48**
A Pét-Nat made of Glera grapes. Light, with aromas of citrus, apples, and nuts. Fresh and crisp finish.
- Bianco Frizzante “Il Pestifero” | Tenuta di Tavignano | Marche | 2021** **54**
Our favorite sparkling! Il Pestifero, the naughty boy, Pét-Nat has fine gentle bubbles. It is dry with citrus fruits, subtle minerality, floral, and slight herbal tones.



Skin contact wine is essentially white wine that has turned orange because the grape juice has been allowed to stay in contact with the grape skins and macerate. This gives the wine a more full-bodied, tannic character, and depth of colour.

● **LE MARCHE**

Verdicchio, Italy's greatest native white grape variety is definitely one of our favourite. A lean, dry white wine with pear skin and preserved lemon flavors. A great wine for pairing with fish.

● **LAZIO**

Lazio has a relatively small wine production, but still remains one of the centers of ancient winemaking. Wines are usually relatively light alcohol with flavours of lemon and chalk-like notes due to the region's volcanic soils.

● **TRENTINO - ALTO ADIGE**

Possibly the most beautiful wine region in the world, Alto Adige (aka Südtirol), is where North meets South; in terms of climate, culture, and wine. Eventhough it is one of Italy's smallest winegrowing regions, thanks to its geographical position, it is also one of the most multifaceted. What emerges here are not trendy wines, but rather authentic wines with their own original character. The higher altitudes result in moderate vine growth, a longer maturation period and lower yields. This in turn leads to high levels of concentration in the grapes.

VENETO

In Veneto, the indigenous red grapes Corvina, Molinara, and Rondinella have a long tradition and are used to produce Valpolicella, Ripasso, and Amarone wines. Amarone is a dense, rich wine made from air-dried, resonated grapes. In addition to reds, you can find amazing, refreshing, aromatic whites and of course, Prosecco, one of the most beloved aperitivos.



FRIULI

Friuli is a unique wine region located between Veneto, Slovenia, and southern Austria. Its two main sub-regions, Collio and Colli orientali del Friuli, produce light, aromatic wines. Friuli is also known for being the birthplace of skin contact technique, producing darker and more complex wines.

TUSCANY

Tuscany is one of the most prestigious wine-growing regions in the world. Due its geological and climatic conditions, the wineries of the region produce high-quality Tuscan wines with a unique touch. The key grape in Tuscany is without doubt Sangiovese. Some Super Tuscans employ 'international varieties' such as Cabernet and Merlot while Chianti tends to include small amounts of Canaiolo or Colorino.

Shows ripe strawberry, rose petal and cedar with a hint of mint. It has a relaxed and round palate.

One grape for each musical note. Juicy and full-bodied red with notes of ripe red and black fruit. Hints of chocolate and tobacco on the finish.

The biggest expression of the “musical” vineyard. Ruby colour, with gentle garnet reflexes. Soft bouquet of fruits from wood, musk, and flower. It is juicy and ripe with sweet spices, making it a Brunello with a unique soft elegance of taste.

VALLE D'AOSTA

It's a unique region due to its small size and its proximity to France, which has influenced its grape mix. The rocky soil creates a challenging environment for vines, resulting in high-quality grapes with a lot of concentration.

LIGURIA

Pigato wine best expresses Ligurian terroir displaying minerality of the soil and sea salt aromas.

UMBRIA

The "Green Heart of Italy," of enchanting beauty with rolling hills, idyllic villages, and historic towns. Umbria's winemaking heritage is a hidden gem, with whites like Trebbiano Spoletino and Grechetto, and reds such as the prestigious Sagrantino di Montefalco, a bold and full-bodied wine with flavors of dark fruit and spice.

CAMPANIA

Campania wine region is a true reflection of its diverse landscape, offering a wide variety of wines ranging from fruity to powerful, mineral to opulent, with surprising white wines grown at high altitudes and given a long life by their acidity and minerality.

ABRUZZO

Montepulciano is the focus of winemaking, which is a versatile grape that can be vinified and aged in different ways to create simple, attractive wines or wines with greater depth, concentration, and complexity.

CALABRIA

Ciro wine, with its ancient Greek roots and unchanged production methods, bears testimony to the long-standing relationship between the Greeks and Calabria.

SARDINIA

As the Sardinian saying goes, "When the wind comes from the sea, you can hear voices of strangers, but they are voices that pass." This captures the spirit of the island, where the local culture has been shaped by a rich history of outside influences, including in wine-making. The Phoenicians were the first to bring wine to the island, and today, Sardinia is home to a variety of grape varieties and wine styles. From the crisp Vermentino of the north to the robust Cannonau of the south, each wine reflects the unique terroir and spirit of the island.

SICILY

The history of Sicilian wine runs deep, with evidence of winemaking dating back to Mycenaean traders in 1500 BC. Legend has it that Dionysus himself brought wine and joy to the island, but even without the myth, it's clear that winemaking is an integral part of Sicilian culture. When the Greeks settled in Sicily in the 8th century, they brought with them their love for "oinos" (wine), introducing different grape varieties to the island. Today, Sicilian wines are known for their bold flavors, unique grape varieties, and rich history that is sure to transport you back in time with every sip.

Light and juicy. Aromatic with flavour of ripe red fruit, sweet spice, and vanilla.
- Syrah “Coccinella” | Aldo Viola | Sicily | 2018** **68**
The Sicilian twist to the Rhône Syrah shine through, juicy black olive and ripe red and black fruit with a finish of bitter chocolate. A wine that can only be from Sicily.
- Etna Rosso | Calcagno | Sicily | 2018** **60**
Brilliant ruby red, fruity, intense, and rich red wine made of indigenous Etna Nerello Mascalese grapes of 90 years old vines. Smooth and well balanced, persistent, and pleasantly tannic.
- Monica di Sardegna “Karel” | Ferruccio Deiana | Sardinia | 2020** **44**
Ruby red colour with intense and round aroma. Ripe red and black fruit, peppery finish.
- Cannonau “Su’ Anima” | Su’ Entu | Sardinia | 2020** **58**
Ruby with orange tinges. This wine reveals enticing floral notes and red berry aromas joined by sweet resina on the finish.

Scents of blackberry, currant, and plum with notes of spice, and vanilla
- Isola dei Nuraghi "Oirad" | Ferruccio Deiana | 2017 | Sardegna** **15 | 70**
Intense floral aromas with notes of honey and almond, sweet taste, round, harmonic.

DIGESTIVE

- Grappa di Traminer | Distilleria Santa Massenza | Trentino** **7**
Aromatic with rich texture and notes of spice, citrus, and sweet flowers.
- Grappa Riserva | Distilleria Santa Massenza | Trentino** **8**
Blend of white and red grapes, fresh and fruity character with elegant herbal aromas, and dry fruit flavour
- Fernet | Distilleria Quaglia | Piemonte** **8**
Aromas of peppermint, citrus peels, Alpine herbs, a touch of forest floor.
- Amaro | Villa Zarri | Emilia Romagna** **8**
Aromas of orange peel, rhubarb, mint, liquorice, dried prunes, roasted coffee beans, and medicinal herbs.
