100% Macabeo, Hints of white peach, spring flowers. In the mouth it's creamy and fresh, in harmony with the acidity.

Palomino "El Pinto" Cadiz La Parrilla Nat 2024 £37
100% Palomino grapes, Crisp and bright, with vibrant notes of green apple and citrus fruit. Some delicate floral notes sit in the background. The finish is clean and slightly reductive.

Martinsancho Verdejo Rueda Rodriguez 2024 £46
This Verdejo smells like citrus fruits and wild field grass, with a hint of feline aroma. Crisp and fresh, it offers flavors of melon, nectarine and nettle, a long slightly salty finish is braced by bright acidity.

Albariño Abadia de San Campio Rias Baixas Terres Gauda 2024 £49
100% Albariño, has citrus, grapefruit, pineapple and mandarin with fresh acidity and supple mouth feel.

Listan Blanco Tenerife Tajinaste 2022 £47
90% Listan blanco 10% Albillo grapes, Light straw yellow colour with greenish reflections. The nose is slightly smoky, floral notes and aromas of pineapple, apple and fennel. The palate is fresh and smooth, with a well-balanced acidity.

Vina Muriel reserva Rioja Muriel's 2015 £49
100% Viura, hand selected Viura grapes are fermented in Oak barrels for 25 days then left to mature for a further 8 months in barrel. Nutty, creamy and decadent. Traditional white Rioja style with spades of enthusiasm and style.

Muscatel Silicorno Alicante Balaguer 2021 £52
100% Muscatel notes of stone fruit, ripe peaches, citrus element of orange peel and orange blossoms on the nose. A full volume and complex palate with a pronounced saline character very much driven by the salty soils. A white wine with great texture, medium bodied with well-integrated acidity, the finish is dry and long.

La Mar Rias Baixas Terras Gauda 2020 £64
90% Caino blanco, 5% Albariño, 5% Loureiro. Clean aromas of tropical fruit, dominated by very ripe pineapple, mango delicate aromas of lychee and ripe peach. Shows excellent structure also soft and appetizing. The Caino's excellent acidity brings freshness and gives the wine its excellent ability to age well.

- Moristel tinto joven** Somontano Barbadillo Nat 2023 £42
100% Moristel grapes, a crunchy red wine, at nose you can feel red cherry and rhubarb. Moristel is an indigenous to the Somontano region of Pyrenees. Fresh and vivacious on the palate with a pleasant earthiness and camberry acidity.
- Pittacum Mencia** Bierzo Mengoba 2020 £47
100% Mencia grapes, velvety texture with ripe red and dark fruit flavours lifted by Mencia's brisk acidity. Medium body, intense flavour and long finish.
- Monastrell** Jumilla P. Olivares Nat 2019 £47
100% Monastrell grapes. aromas of black cherry, smoke, violets and sweet American oak with a brown sugar note. It is soft on the attack with ripe dark fruit and a touch of butterscotch
- Rioja crianza** Rioja H. Alfano 2021 £49
70% Garnacha 30% Tempranillo, Graciano. Intense cherry-red in colour. Scents of jammy red fruits and cassis with white spice. On the palate concentrated, fresh with well integrated tannins and smooth acidity leading to a spicy finish.
- Vina el Pago tinto** Rioja Azp. Urarte Nat 2019 £49
Tempranillo, Garnacha tinta and Graciano grapes, A fruit forward Rioja with notes of vanilla, cherry compote, sun baked earth and blackberries. It's dry with easy tannins and a touch of spice on the palate.
- Vina Muriel Reserva** Rioja Bodegas Muriel 2016 £69
Tempranillo grapes, The grapes are grown in Elciego, Rioja Alavesa wine undergoes a 24-month aging process in oak barrels followed by 12 months in the bottle before release.
- Garnacha "Rambla del Peligres"** Alicante Vinessens Nat 2020 £52
100% Garnacha grapes, many red fruit nuances at nose and nice entry on the palate. Light and fruity has a good level of sweet tannin. A great expression of Garnacha in southeast of Spain, a very pleasant and easy to drink wine.
- Crianza Ribera del Duero** Ribera del Duero Fuentenarro 2021 £53
100% Tempranillo grapes. The nose is very powerful and complex, intense and clean aromas of black fruit, toasts, cocoa and coffee, Palate it is sweet and fruity, with a perfect structure and body, fine tannin and accompanied by aromatic woods, with a long and complex finish.
- Rioja Reserva Especial** Rioja Urbina 2004 £72
Made with 95% tempranillo from 20 year old vines, this crianza displays aromas of dried berries combined with vanilla and toasty notes. The palate evolves with silky tannins and a long finish.

Special bottles and Old Vintages

- Barbera d'Asti "Pomorosso"*** *Piemonte Coppo 1999 £180*
100% Barbera d'Asti, the brothers have set an ambitious goal to resurrect the traditional red varieties from the Asti region, to produce serious white wines with aging potential. This is a new generation of winegrowers with a new way of viewing agriculture. Bright ruby red in color with garnet reflections. The bouquet is full and fragrant with the scent of ripe cherries. Intense and persistent in character. Recommended with roasted and grilled meats.
- Barolo "Cerequio"*** *Piemonte Marengo 2010 £180*
100% Nebbiolo grapes. Very complex. Intense and earthy with the scent of berries, liquorice, vanilla, dried violet. Very well balanced, full-body, complex with very long persistence. Refined and pleasurable tannings.
- Merlot "Marchesante"*** *Friuli Maculan 1998 £180*
100% Merlot grapes, intense red color with orange nuances, ripe cherry's nose with a touch of vanilla. Complex on mouth with intense velvety palate, chocolate and tobacco on final of the rich taste.
- Brunello di Montalcino Magnum*** *Toscana S. Restituta (Gaja) 2016 £270*
100% Sangiovese Multy layered aromas of dark cherry and dried plums melding into more pronounced mineral essences plus suggestions of tobacco leaf.
- Barbaccarlo*** *Lombardia Maga 2019 £120*
Croatina, Barbera, Uva rara, aged in large Slavonian oak barrel. Ruby red color, a bit of carbonic residual. Nose very pleasant with delicate vinous note and red fruit notes. In the mouth is fresh, fruity and a bit tannic. Great balance
- Amarone riserva*** *Veneto Mazzi 1992 £180*
Blend of Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes, dried as tradition in Valpolicella area. Aged in large oak barrel. Ruby intense the color. Classic over riped and complex nose with hint of vanilla and leather. Complex and full body on the mouth
- Barbaresco*** *Piemonte Gaja 2019 £320*
100% Nebbiolo grapes. A wine of poise and grace, the 2016 has so much to offer. Expressive spice and floral notes open up first, but what really stands out is the wine's nuance and delineation. Sweet red cherry, mint, cinnamon and rose petal develop in the glass, adding further shades of nuance.
- Flor de Pingus*** *Ribera del Duero D. Pingus 2011 £320*

80% Sangiovese, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc. deeply intense ruby red colour. On the nose, it's remarkably complex with notes of ripe red fruit, black cherries, sour cherries that merge with sweet hints of vanilla, mint and delicate sensations of white pepper and myrtle. Its palate is rich and well-balanced: supple velvety tannins are sustained by exceptional freshness that give the wine length, elegance and persistence of flavours.
- Sassicaia*** *Toscana Tenuta S. Guido 2016 £435*
85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% of Cabernet Franc blend. The 2016 Sassicaia is a fabulous wine in the making. Powerful and concentrated, with huge tannic clout, the 2016 has so much to offer. Black cherry, plum, licorice, spice and violet all pulse with energy in an explosive, thrilling Sassicaia that will drink well for several decades.
