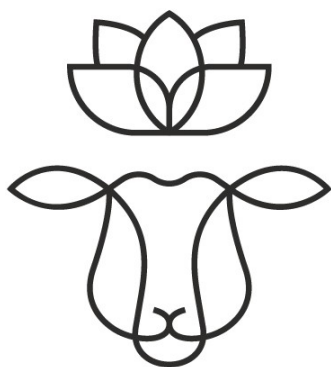

The Billiard Bar

The Billiard Room was built in 1883, with the rest of the original house. The windows overhead once lit the Billiard table which was used and enjoyed by the Godman family. They now illuminate our beautiful Murano glass chandeliers which were designed to represent our Italian heritage.

When the house became a hotel in 1985, The Billiard Room became a private dining suite. It was used for weddings and meetings right up until 2008 when it was then redesigned as a bar. The former Library Bar then became an extension of The Camellia Restaurant.

Our current bar and menu blends the heritage of this beautiful room with the trends and styles of bar-goers of today. The cocktail menu offers a journey through South Lodge History whilst the remainder of the drinks selection aims to show off our array of spirits, liquors and other drinks.

The team are always on hand to offer recommendations on food and drink. But their main purpose is to make your stay as comfortable and as enjoyable as possible.

Champagne and English Sparkling Wine

Champagne can be made from one grape, or as a blend of up to three varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. Wines made from these grapes are subjected to a process known as “méthode champenoise” which is essentially a second fermentation inside the bottle in which they are then sold.

Also known as Special or Deluxe Cuvées, Vintage Champagnes are of the highest quality. These select bottles are widely considered to be the best wine that France has to offer, regardless of the price. A typical Prestige Cuvée must be made entirely from the same year and the blend is often restricted to the exclusive “Grand Crus,” a classification indicating the vineyard’s quality.

Rosé Champagne

Champagne rosé is predominantly produced one of two ways: by blending a little red wine with the white champagne, or by allowing the macerated skins of black grapes to come into contact with the wine, which gives it a “pinkish” colour. Rosés tend to be less acidic than traditional champagnes, and are noted for their delicate, floral, fruity style.

Single Malt Scotch

Playing host to over half the distilleries in Scotland, Speyside has the greatest concentration of malt whisky producers compared to every other whisky-producing region. Most people would recognize the Speyside style as being light, sweet and honeyed single malts such as the Glenfiddich and Balvenie Distilleries.

Islay

Islay is usually associated with peaty single malt whiskies, and it is unsurprising for the three powerhouse distilleries, Ardbeg, Laphroaig and Lagavulin, they have become world famous, and produce some exceptional peaty single malt whiskies.

There are also some less peaty drams such as Bunnahabhain. The distillery sits to the north of the isle and produces fruitier single malts.

The Highlands

Single Malt from the Highlands takes on many shapes and forms.

To the north there are big bodied single malts, with cereal sweetness and richness. Towards the south there are lighter, fruitier whiskies with a definite dryness. To the east there are some full-bodied, dry whiskies with lots of fruit and pungency.

The Western Highlands offer full body and real power with peaty, smoky overtones.

Whiskey

America

American Whiskey can be divided in to various categories, such as: Bourbon - which requires a mash of at least 51% corn and aged in new charred barrels, they tend to be the sweeter style of whiskey. Rye - which requires a mash of at least 51% rye and aged in new charred barrels, they are spicier and fuller-bodied than bourbons. Tennessee - the same process as bourbon but differs in two ways, must be made in Tennessee, and generally use the Lincoln County Process, where the whiskey is filtered through maple charcoal. Each American Whiskey has its own style set out in US Federal Law, which governs the production methods and aging process.
