## The Original Cocktail

*Our house cocktails go back to the origin of the recipe, to the very first expression of the drink.*

### Martinez

Gin, sweet vermouth, maraschino liqueur, angostura bitter

*The grandfather to the Martini.*

### Gimlet

Navy strength gin, lime

*Dr. Sir Thomas Gimlette prescribed this cocktail to officer's to help with disease in 1879.*

### Boulevardier

Whisky, sweet vermouth, Campari

*Dating back to 1927: a Negroni, but made with whisky.*

### Last Word

Gin, maraschino liqueur, lime, chartreuse

*Fresh and zesty, this was a very popular drink in the 1920's.*

### Clover Club

Gin, fresh raspberries, lemon, egg white

*A favourite in the 1880's, born amidst the leather arm chairs and cigars of a gentlemen's club in Philadelphia.*

### Daiquiri

Rum, lime, sugar

*Some things never go out of fashion; popular in the late 1890's, popular today - a classic.*

### Manhattan

Whisky, sweet vermouth, angostura bitter

*Named after the Manhattan Club, where Winston Churchill's mother hosted a party in the 1880's.*

### Sazerac

Whisky, cognac, absinthe, bitters

*Quite possibly the world's first cocktail, dating back to the early 19th century.*

### Sidecar

Cognac, lemon, cointreau

*Created in a small bistro in Paris, where a captain was regularly driven to and from in this 'Sidecar'.*

### Tom Collins

Gin, lemon, sugar, soda

*Powered by the sweetness of simplicity, this cocktail hasn't changed since the 1860's.*

### Picador

Tequila, lime, cointreau

*Before the Margarita came the Picador. It's very similar, just without the salted rim...*

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## Single Malt Scottish Whisky

### Speyside

Balvenie Doublewood 12 year-old

*Smooth and mellow, sweet fruit and oloroso Sherry notes, vanilla, nuts and spices.*

Aberlour A'Bunadh Batch 77

*Intense and full with black cherries, ginger, oak spice and dark chocolate.*

Benromach 15 year-old

*Aged in bourbon and Sherry casks: big spice, plum and clementine, a touch of charred oak.*

Craigellachie 13 year-old

*Punchy and full-flavoured with balanced tropical fruit and meaty smoke.*

Mortlach 16 year-old Distiller's Dram

*Robust and full, apricot, honey, leathery spice, powerful oak and underlying savoury tones.*

Macallan 18 year-old

*Matured in Sherry-seasoned oak casks from Jerez: Deliciously fruity, hints of citrus, vanilla and cinnamon, alongside ginger and wood smoke.*

### Highlands & Isles

Dalwhinnie Distillers Edition '22

*Double matured, smooth and slightly creamy with warm nutmeg, oak spice and sweet exotic fruit.*

Balblair 15 year-old

*Matured in ex-bourbon casks & Spanish oak butts: Complex and bold, sweet honey apple, fresh citrus, dried fruit, dark chocolate, orange and ginger.*

Blair Athol 12 year-old

*Finished in ex-syrah wine cask: sweet summer berries, chocolate raisins, caramel, leather and oak.*

Glengoyne 21 year-old

*Rich dried fruit and sweet spices, reminiscent of Christmas cake. Powerful Sherry-cask influence.*

Glenmorangie 10 year-old

*Mellow and delicate; fruity, hints of floral, citrus, orange, honey and creamy vanilla.*

### Islay

Caol Ila 12 year-old

*Fresh and herbal with sweet and fragrant smoke, spicy warmth and subtle citrus.*

Laphroaig 10 year-old

*Powerful peatiness, bold smoke, salty seaweed and a lingering sweetness.*

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## Single Malt Scottish Whisky

Bunnahabhain 18 year-old

*Intensely warming; dried fruit, Sherry toffee and spices, honeyed nuttiness and a hint of sea salt.*

Lagavulin 16 year-old Distiller's Edition

*Smokey with sweet spices and fruit, mature Sherry and powerful peat and oak.*

Bowmore 15 year-old

*Elegantly balanced with tropical fruit, rich treacle toffee, cedar spice, Sherry and barley.*

## Campbeltown

Springbank 15 year-old

*Full and rich with exotic fruit, sherry notes, spice, dried fruit and nuts, and oak.*

## Lowlands

Bladnoch 14 year-old 2022 release

*Spicy and rich with raisins, sultanas and hints of orange peel and chocolate.*

## England & Wales

The English 8 year-old small batch

*Dried fruits, chocolate, bitter orange and sticky toffee pudding.*

Penderyn

*Sweet and fruity, with citrus, honey, oak, and hints of spice. Finished in Madeira wine casks.*

## Japan

Yoichi 10 year-old

*Oily and sweet, subtly floral with peach fruit, vanilla custard, peat smoke and nutmeg.*

Miyagikyo

*Malt-focused, with slight floral notes, cinnamon, ginger, chocolate and tobacco. Light yet full of flavour - a great introduction to Japanese whisky.*

## Blended

Chivas Regal 12 year-old

*Round and creamy with rich honey, ripe pears, vanilla, hazelnut and butterscotch.*

Johnnie Walker Red

*Gentle and smooth. Raisin-like fruitiness, spice, oak and hints of smoke.*

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## **Bourbons**

Maker's Mark 101

*Bright orange and caramelised fruit, a crack of pepper, vanilla and hint of molasses.*

Eagle Rage Kentucky 10 year-old

*Nutty caramel, flamed orange peel, walnuts, oak spice, vanilla and a hint of red fruit.*

EH Taylor Small Batch

*Soft and approachable with sweet butterscotch, caramel, liquorice, and subtle pepper and tobacco.*

Reservoir Holland's Ghost

*Maturation in an old stout barrel brings cream, malt and spice, alongside herbs, dried fruit and toasty oak.*

## **Cognac, Armagnac & Brandy**

Courvoisier VS

*A blend of younger and older Cognacs up to 7 years brings notes of delicate spring flowers, fruit and oak.*

H by Hine VSOP

*Fruity and floral with jasmine and acacia - surprisingly mellow. A blend of more than 25 Grande and Petite Champagne Cognacs.*

Hennessy XO

*Rich and fruity with prunes, raisins, dark chocolate, vanilla, sticky toffee pudding and subtle spice.*

Baron de Sigognac

*A 20 year-old Armagnac boasting floral and berry notes alongside tangy oak, mulled spices and a hint of vanilla.*

Aba Pisco

*Crystal clear with flavours of jasmine, sweet honey and tangerine. Soft and syrupy on the palate.*

Marolo Grappa di Barolo

*Made using Nebbiolo grapes and aged for 12 years; elegant and deep with toasty vanilla and red fruit.*

Grappa barrique greco di tufo gold

*Soft and round with hints of tropical fruit, banana and hazelnut.*

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## Apéritifs, Digestifs & Bitters

Byrrh Grand Quinquina

*A muscat wine-based aperitif boasting notes of bitter orange, cocoa, quinine and coffee.*

Cocchi Americano

*Juicy orange, bitter quinine, cherry-menthol and roasted almonds - a delicious aperitif.*

Pastis 51

*A fresh, anise-flavoured spirit, first made in Marseille in 1951.*

Green Chartreuse

*A French classic, strong and sweet, with herbal and spice notes.*

Yellow Chartreuse

*Milder and sweeter than its green partner, with mellowed honey, anise and herbs.*

Cynar

*A favourite in Italy, this bitter artichoke flavoured liquor is great in a Negroni.*

Poire Williams

*Brandy-based digestif, with notes of lush ripe pears, cardamom and cinnamon.*

Amaro Averna

*Bittersweet with orange, juniper, rosemary and sage that will take you straight to Sicily.*

Carpano Antica Formula

*Vanilla, spice, citrus, dried fruit and almond. Delicious in a Martinez - the grandfather to a martini.*

Genepi liqueur des alpes

*Sweet yet balanced by a strong herbal essence - an excellent digestif*

Luxardo Limoncello

*A classic - zesty lemon, fresh acidity and balanced sweetness.*

Amaro Montenegro

*Bittersweet with big floral notes of rose petal and hints of orange.*

Bailey's

*Irish cream liqueur with notes of vanilla and chocolate*

Caffe Borghetti

*A classic Italian liqueur with notes of sweet espresso coffee and warm gentle alcohol.*

Amaretto Disaronno

*An Italian favourite, with an amber hue and strong almond flavour.*

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## **Port**

Quinta da Gaivosa LBV 2018 Port

*Deep aroma, with notes of dried black plums, macerated sour cherries, dried figs, eucalyptus leaf, dark chocolate. Great depth and complexity with a very long finish.*

Quinta da Gaivosa Tawny Port 10

*Complex and charming with notes of caramel, macerated raspberries, roasted nuts and spices like ginger. Smooth and round with a long finish.*

Quinta da Gaivosa White Port 10

*Bold and refined with notes of dry orange peel, maple syrup and almonds, alongside hints of spice and herbs. Aged for 10 years in French oak barrels. Delicious with blue cheese or as a post dinner drink.*
