

HAMBLEDON WINE ESTATE ENGLISH SPARKLING WINE

CURRENT RELEASES

HAMBLEDON CLASSIC CUVÉE 10/50

2019 vintage base (84%), 5.7 gm/l dosage, 35 months on lees

Chardonnay 51%, Pinot Noir 32%, Pinot Meunier 17%. Dry, medium-bodied.

The 2019 vintage provided a cool growing season and the accent in this year is on crisp Granny Smith freshness and bright citrus flavours.

HAMBLEDON CLASSIC CUVÉE ROSÉ 11/55

2018 vintage base (97%), 8 gm/l dosage, 45 months on lees

Chardonnay 82%, Pinot Noir 7%, Pinot Meunier 1%, 10% Pinot Noir as red wine. Dry, medium-bodied.

The glorious 2018 vintage gave richly ripe fruit and seductive creamy fruit notes of strawberry and raspberry

HAMBLEDON PREMIÈRE CUVÉE 15/75

2014 vintage base (100%), 2.5 gm/l dosage, 84 months on lees

Chardonnay 67%, Pinot Noir 22%, Pinot Meunier 11%. Dry, full-bodied.

Although all from the 2014 vintage, the reserve wines for dosage were aged separately in tank and barrel. An intense palate evolving into notes of tarte tatin, almond croissant, with a creamy texture and vibrant acidity.

HAMBLEDON PREMIÈRE CUVÉE ROSÉ 15/75

2016 vintage base (100%), 5 gm/l dosage, 60 months on lees

Pinot Meunier saignée 88%, Pinot Noir 7%, Chardonnay 7%. Dry, full-bodied.

The saignée method (removal the wine from skins of the red grapes before too much colour is extracted) produces a more vinous and gastronomic wine, with texture and depth enhanced by the extended ageing.

HAMBLEDON CLASSIC CUVÉE BLANC DE BLANCS 65

2018 vintage base (98%), 3.4 gm/l dosage, 48 months on lees

Chardonnay 100%. Dry medium/full bodied.

The quality of the Chardonnay in 2018 shines through, with lovely notes of creamy apple and quince, and enhanced by the delicious scents and textures of brioche and subtle vanilla.

HAMBLEDON ZERO DOSAGE ROSÉ 75

2015 vintage base (85%), 0gm/l dosage, 35 months on the lees

100% Pinot Meunier

This wine offers a gastronomic experience to be enjoyed as an aperitif or paired with food. The base wine was produced in the saignee method to concentrate flavours, as well as reduce yield. 15% of reserve wine aged in barrels (old French oak) brings depth and texture. The wine is a vibrant, deep, salmon pink colour. The nose gives cherry compote interlaced with smoke and tobacco. The wine was bottled at a lower pressure.

13%, DOURO, PORTUGAL

Viosinho, Arinto, Gouveio. Medium-bodied, subtle tropical fruit.

From high vineyards above the Douro river, aged for a little time in oak barrels.

AOTEA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2023, SEIFRIED FAMILY 40

12.5%, NELSON, SOUTH ISLAND, NEW ZEALAND

Sauvignon Blanc. Light-bodied, citrus and flower fruit.

The wine's Brightwater vineyard is only 15km from the sea, adding a marine freshness.

CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE 2022, DOMAINE LA CABOTTE, PLUMET FAMILY 45

13.5%, SOUTHERN RHÔNE, FRANCE

Grenache Blanc, Clairette, Viognier, Roussanne. Medium/full bodied, rich stone fruit.

The Plumet family's beautiful bio-dynamic estate is hidden in the wild hills of the Massif d'Uchaux.

CONTACTO ALVARINHO 2023, MENDES & SYMINGTON FAMILIES 45

13%, VINHO VERDE, PORTUGAL

Alvarinho (Albariño in Portuguese). Light/medium bodied, herbal, pear, zesty.

A new partnership between legendary Vinho Verde producer Anselmo Mendes and the Symington family.

CLASSIC RIESLING 2023, HUGEL FAMILY 50

12%, ALSACE, FRANCE

Riesling. Light/medium bodied, very floral and stoney.

The estate was founded in 1639, now run by the 12th generation. This is their signature wine.

GRÜNER VELTLINER TERRASSEN 2022 WILLI BRÜNDLMAYER 60

12.5%, KAMPTAL, AUSTRIA

Grüner Veltliner. Medium-bodied, rounded, spicy.

Willi Bründlmayer was the first to bring the Kamptal region to international prominence.

PLÁCET RIOJA BLANCO 2023, PALACIOS REMONDO 75

13%, RIOJA, SPAIN

Viura. Full-bodied, rich with a hint of oak

Part of the Alvaro Palacios portfolio, from the southern sector of Rioja (Baja).

SANCERRE LES CAILLOTES 2023, FRANÇOIS COTAT ▽ 85

12.5%, SANCERRE, FRANCE

Sauvignon Blanc. Medium/full bodied, stoney, intense, herbal.

Very traditional and in small quantities, aged in large old barrels. A serious and gastronomic wine.

CHABLIS 1ER CRU FOURCHAUMES 2020, WILLIAM FÈVRE 95

12.5%, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Chardonnay. Medium-bodied. Frsh, steely, mineral, intense.

Fourchaumes is one of the best 1er Cru sites and the Fèvre style is pure and expressive..

RED WINE

GAMAY NOIR 2023, TE MATA ESTATE 35

12%, HAWKE'S BAY, NEW ZEALAND

Gamay. Light/medium-bodied, juicy, crunchy red fruit.

The Gamay variety is best known for Beaujolais and is rare in New Zealand. Can be chilled.

CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE 2022, FRANCK BALTHAZAR 40

13.5%, SOUTHERN RHÔNE, FRANCE

Syrah, Grenache. Medium-bodied, dark, spicy and heady fruit.

Franck is renowned for his Cornas in the northern Rhône and his non-interventionist winemaking.

POST SCRIPTUM DE CHRYSEIA 2022, PRATS & SYMINGTON FAMILIES 45

14%, DOURO, PORTUGAL

Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz. Medium/full bodied, concentrated dark fruit.

Very clever interpretation of grapes used of Port but as a modern table wine.

BOURGEUIL 2021, JOUR DU SOIF, PIERRE GAUTHIER ▽ 50

13%, LOIRE, FRANCE

Cabernet Franc. Light/medium bodied, fragrant, cut grass/lead pencil notes.

The everyday wine from the best name in Bourgeuil, but still complex and full-flavoured.

TORBRECK THE JUVENILES, 2021 60

14.5%, BAROSSA, AUSTRALIA

Grenache, Mataro and others. Medium-bodied, juicy, bright red fruit, plush and rounded.

Torbeck specialises in using the Brossa's very old vineyards, some over 150 years old in this wine.

BOURGOGNE ROUGE PINOT NOIR 2022, BENJAMIN LEROUX 60

13%, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Pinot Noir. Medium-bodied, bright, crunchy red fruit, silky textures.

A blend from vineyards only in the Côte de Beaune, including Volnay and Pommard.

RIOJA RESERVA 2013, VIÑA BOSCONIA, LOPEZ DE HEREDIA 60

13% RIOJA, SPAIN

Tempranillo, Garnacha, Mazuelo, Graciano. Medium-bodied

Ultra-traditional family estate, aged for five years in large old oak barrels, bottled unfiltered.

POGGIO LAMENTANO 2022, DAVY ŻYW 75

14%, TUSCANY, ITALY

Cabernets, Merlot, Sangiovese. Medium-bodied, savoury, spice red fruit.

A brilliant vino da tavola from the Bolgheri region. £10 from each bottle to My Name Is Doddie MND charity.

LA BAUGE AU-DESSUS PINOT NOIR 2019, AU BON CLIMAT 100

13.5%, CALIFORNIA, USA

Pinot Noir. Medium-bodied, velvet, broad ripe fruit.

The young Jim Clendenen fell in love with Burgundy and planted Santa Barbara's first Pinot Noir in the early 1980s

TREINSPOOR 2022, SADIE FAMILY 100

13.5%, SWARTLAND, SOUTH AFRICA

Tinta Barocca. Medium/full-bodied, pure yet earthy, herbal and spicy notes.

Eben Sadie was the first to develop these old, unirrigated vines, once used for South African fortified wines.

ROSE WINE

CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE 2023, GUIGAL 35

14.5%, SOUTHERN RHÔNE, FRANCE

Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah. Medium/full-bodied, ripe plum and spice.

A southern French rosé made for food, from one of the great names of the Rhône

QUINTA DA FONTE SOUTO 2022, SYMINGTON FAMILY ESTATES 45

13%, ALENTEJO, PORTUGAL

Aragonez (Tempranillo). Light/medium-bodied, gentle red fruits.

From the first Symington estate outside their heartland of the Douro.

FORTIFIED & SWEET WINE

FINO SHERRY, BARBADILLO 36

15%, ANDALUCIA, SPAIN

Palomino Fino. Dry, medium-bodied, salty and tangy fruit.

Not just an apéritif. Works with shellfish, strong garlic or almond dishes, even soft cheeses.

PANTELLERIA PASSITO LIQUOROSA 2022, PELLEGRINO 50CL 45

15%, SICILY, ITALY

Zibibo (Muscat d'Alexandria). Medium sweet, light/medium-bodied, very floral notes of dried apricot.

From grapes harvested and then partially dried on a tiny island between Sicily and North Africa.

SIX GRAPES RESERVE PORT, GRAHAM 48

20%, DOURO, PORTUGAL

Touriga Franca, Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barocca. Medium sweet, medium/full-bodied.

Six grapes is a Port Trade shorthand to indicate a port barrel capable of becoming a vintage port.

MADEIRA 10 YEAR OLD MALMSEY, BLANDY 51

19%, MADEIRA, PORTUGAL

Malvasia. Sweet, full-bodied. Intense, concentrated notes of marmalade, prune and caramel.

By the traditional "canteiro" system which slowly heats and cools the wine in different levels in the cellar.

OTIMA COLHEITA 10 YEAR OLD TAWNY PORT, WARRE 50CL 110

20%, DOURO, PORTUGAL

Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Barocca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Cão. Medium dry, medium-bodied.

Extended ageing in wood creates a succulent, smooth wine, notes of golden raisin and butterscotch.

CHÂTEAU CLIMENS 2014, BARSAC 75CL 135

The greatest sweet wines of Bordeaux are not just dessert wines. They have savoury twist amongst the sweetness that makes them superb gastronomic partners. Bérénice Lurton's biodynamically run estate is in many ways equal to Ch. Yquem and partner wonderfully with any dish with Asian spice influence as well as shellfish and blue cheese.
