SAKE

JUNMAI & HONJOZO

Junmai is a category of sake made purely from rice, water, yeast, and koji mould, with no added distilled alcohol, typically resulting in a fuller body and more pronounced rice flavour. In contrast, Honjozo includes a small amount of distilled alcohol added during brewing, a traditional technique used to lighten the body, enhance aroma, and create a smoother, more refined finish.

JUNMAI GINJO & GINJO

Junmai Ginjo is premium sake made from rice polished to 60% or less, using only rice, water, yeast, and koji, producing refined, aromatic flavours with delicate fruit and floral notes. Ginjo adds a small amount of distilled alcohol, enhancing aroma and creating a lighter, smoother, more fragrant style.

JUNMAI DAIGINJO & DAIGINJO

Junmai Daiginjo is ultra-premium sake made from rice polished to 50% or less, using only rice, water, yeast, and kōji, creating refined, complex sake with elegant fruity and floral aromas. Daiginjo adds a small amount of distilled alcohol to enhance aromatics and produce a lighter, exceptionally smooth, fragrant style.

SAKE

TOKO

Toko Brewery, founded in 1597 in Yonezawa, Yamagata, is one of Japan's oldest family-run sake breweries and once served the Uesugi clan. It produces pure rice sake reflecting local rice, water, and climate, ranging from Junmai to award-winning Junmai Daiginjo expressions.

DASSAI

Dassai Brewery is renowned for ultra-premium Junmai Daiginjo made with highly polished Yamada-nishiki rice, producing refined, aromatic, elegant sake. Under Hiroshi Sakurai's leadership in the late 20th century, the brewery shifted from a modest operation to focus exclusively on premium sake, becoming one of Japan's most recognised brands.

SAKE

TATENOKAWA

Tatenokawa Brewery is a historic sake producer in Sakata, Yamagata, founded in the 1830s and named after its pristine local water. Since 2010 it has focused exclusively on Junmai Daiginjo, using high-precision rice polishing and local rice to craft elegant, refined sake with a clean profile and pronounced umami.

DAISHICHI

Daishichi Sake Brewery, founded in 1752 in Fukushima, is renowned for its dedication to the traditional Kimoto brewing method, which cultivates natural lactic acid to create rich, complex sake. It also innovates with techniques such as super-flat rice polishing to enhance purity, smoothness, and depth of flavour.

SAKE

HEAVEN SAKE

Heavensake is a Japan–France premium sake project led by French cellar master Régis Camus, blending Junmai, Junmai Ginjo, and Junmai Daiginjo using Champagne-inspired techniques. It combines Japanese craftsmanship with French flair to create elegant, balanced sake appealing to both traditional and international audiences.

MASUMI

Masumi, founded in 1662 in Suwa, Nagano, is a historic sake brewery shaped by alpine climate, pure water, and local tradition. Named after “The Mirror of Truth” at Suwa Taisha Shrine, it is famed for creating the influential Yeast No. 7 strain, producing balanced, food-friendly sake enjoyed across Japan.

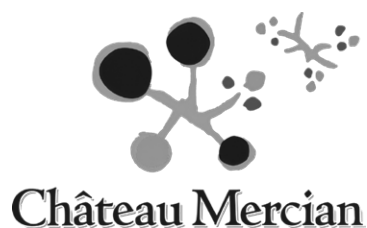

Gaja is one of Italy's most prestigious and influential family-owned wineries, founded in 1859 in the Barbaresco zone of Piedmont. It's best known for high-end Nebbiolo-based wines, especially Barbaresco and Barolo, which helped redefine modern Italian winemaking under the leadership of Angelo Gaja. His innovations, like bottling single-vineyard crus, using small oak barrels, and improving viticultural and cellar techniques, elevated quality and global reputation, often placing Gaja alongside elite European producers.

Tenuta San Guido is a renowned Tuscan estate in Bolgheri, owned by the Incisa della Rocchetta family and best known as the birthplace of Sassicaia, one of the original Super Tuscans. First released in 1968 and developed by Marchese Mario Incisa della Rocchetta, Sassicaia broke with tradition by using Bordeaux grape varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. Its success helped establish Bolgheri as a leading wine region and played a key role in elevating the global reputation of modern Italian wines.
