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SPARKLING

Prosecco Loggia Extra Dry, Carmina, Conegliano-Italy NV

Made exclusively from the Glera grape, it impresses with its intense scent of peach & pear, accompanied by floral notes of acacia. On the palate, it is harmonious, soft and enveloping.

Bottle £49 / glass £12 / carafe £26

Alice Spumanti Rosé, Carmina, Conegliano-Italy NV

It is a blend of 85% Glera, 13% Pinot-Noir, 2% Merlot. Soft pink colour. Clear aromas of wild strawberries, raspberries, gooseberries, peach blossoms. Body is fresh, with a soft acidity and creamy foam.

Champagne Ployez-Jacquemart Extra Qualité Brut, France NV

£118

A blend of premier and grand crus, with a majority of Pinot Noir and Meunier and a smaller percentage of white grapes. The Champagne is balanced, with great freshness and displays a distinct nose and palate.

Champagne Ployez-Jacquemart Extra Brut Rosé, France NV

£150

A fairly equal blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, which is expressive, delicately combining the expression of red fruit aromas, richness and length on the palate, while maintaining a great vivacity

WHITE WINES

FRANCE

Jean Didier Grande Réserve Blanc, Comté Tolosan 2025

A blend of 80% Colombard 20% Ugni Blanc, it is crisp and zesty with tropical aromas and a soft finish. Refreshing and thirst-quenching. It just sings almost like a Sauvignon-Blanc style intensity

Vermentino Coquille de Mer, Languedoc 2025

Pale lemon in appearance with citrus, apricot and gentle floral aromas. Ripe peach, and tropical notes on the palate. A fruity easy drinking style with good, balanced freshness.

Bottle £40 / glass £9.5 / Carafe £28.5

Sauvignon Château Laborde, Bordeaux Blanc 2022

It's a pure Sauvignon Blanc, made in the best, classic Bordelais style. Very round and fruity with floral notes and a successful balance between softness and acidity.

Grenache Blanc & Colombard SOL & RIVE, Coteaux du Pont du Gard 2023/25

£42

An equal blend of Grenache Blanc & Colombard. Floral with notes of citrus, pear, apple and kiwi. Fresh and light bodied.

Picpoul de Pinet Terrasses de la Mer, C. de l'Ormarine, Languedoc 2024/25

£46

A crisp and refreshing dry white wine with citrus and green notes on the nose and the palate. Picpoul has been around for over 400 years. Terrasses de la Mer is made in the L'Etang de Thau area.

Chardonnay Domaine Le Grand Castelet, Alpilles-Provence 2025

£51

A pleasant nose of white flesh fruits: peach and winter pear. Refreshing wine, slightly tense, with a nice aromatic long finish, good structure and energy. Alpilles PGI is a recent Provence designation.

Viognier Bourdic, Pays d'Oc 2024

£54

This delightful wine displays aromas of honeysuckle and peach with a plump mid-palate leading to a fresh finish with hints of orange blossom and citrus.

ITALY

Pinot Grigio Pure, Venetie-Italy 2025

The nose has hints of lime zest, waxed lemon and baked apple. The palate is everything you would expect, light, clean, refreshing and well balanced. On the finish its dry and very easy drinking.

Bottle £37 / glass £9 / £27

Inzolia-Catarratto Sette Aje, Cantina Grasso 2022 (Bio.) £46

An equal blend of Inzolia & Catarratto with pleasant hints of fresh peach, melon and pineapple, hazelnut and almond. Calibrated persistence and very pleasant freshness.

Grillo Altavilla della Corte, Firriato-Borgo Guarini, Sicilia 2022 £60

The nose shows nuances of gooseberries, apples and pink grapefruit, followed by black tea, gingerbread spice and forest floor. On the palate, starts wonderfully aromatic, fruit-driven and balanced.

LUXEMBOURG

Auxerrois 1er Cru Côtes de Remich, Domaines Vinsmoselle 2021 £58

A wine with a nose of yellow fruits, orange peel and very creamy. On the palate it is soft and broad with a beautiful harmony. Recent research suggests that Auxerrois share the same ancestry as Chardonnay.

Riesling Vieilles Vignes, Grand 1er Cru, Domaines Vinsmoselle 2020 £75

On the nose this wine shows intense flint-stone and apricots aromas. On the palate, the wine opens the scent of spices. It is complex & elegant.

Pinot Gris Vieilles Vignes, Grand 1er Cru, Domaines Vinsmoselle 2020 £75

Intense aromas of vanilla and white fruits characterize this fine wine. On the one hand it is opulent and dense, on the other hand it has a crisp and refined character.

SOUTH AFRICA

Chenin Blanc Long Beach, South Africa 2025

Full bodied with distinct varietal flavours, tropical fruits, fresh figs. Dry, soft, slightly creamy with a crisp clean after taste. The Robertson Winery was established in 1941

Bottle £40 / glass £9,5 / carafe £28.5

ROSÉ WINES

Cinsault Jean Didier Grande Réserve Rosé, Comté Tolosan 2024

An exquisite blush wine from France with strawberry flavours, this shows captivating soft summer berries, a crisp steely finish yet rounded out by a touch, a virtual kiss, of residual sweetness.

Grenache Gris & Marselan SOL & RIVE, Coteaux du Pont du Gard 2024/25

Aromatic with notes of Gala melon, Granny Smith apple, touches of cherry and redcurrants plus a hint of sage. Mouth-wateringly fresh with good acidity, a saline kick, a savoury edge, and a touch of spice.

Bottle £42 / glass £10 / carafe £30

Rosé Blend Domaine Le Grand Castelet, Alpilles- Provence 2024 £51

Pleasant nose with hints of berries: blackberries and strawberry jam. Round and well-balanced wine, with a blackcurrant finish. Alpilles PGI is a recent Provence designation.

Côtes de Provence Rosé Horizon, Domaine La Navicelle 2024 (Bio.) £54

This cuvée composed mainly of Cinsault and Grenache, with a touch of Syrah, represents the pleasure wine par excellence. The nose opens with notes of grapefruit and fresh fruit, and a dynamic finish.

RED WINES

FRANCE

Jean Didier Grande Réserve Rouge, Comté Tolosan 2025

A blend of mostly Carignan, Grenache and a touch of Merlot. On the nose there are aromas of plum jam, raspberry, spice and a touch of pepper, not dissimilar to a good Cotes-du-Rhône.

Bottle £34 / glass £8.5 / carafe £25.5

Pinot-Noir Les Argelières, Languedoc 2024

Glossy garnet red in the glass, on the nose there are aromas of raspberry and cherry with subtle smoky and peppery hints, Fruity, elegant and well-balanced on the palate with a silky long finish.

Bottle £42 / glass £10 / carafe £30

Cahors-Malbec Prestige, Château de Cenac 2020

A deep and smoky full-bodied red wine from the Cahors appellation where the Malbec grapes originally come from. Sweet spice and dark chocolate aromas mingle with boysenberry and blackberry fruits.

Bottle £44 / glass £11 / carafe £33

Rouge Blend Domaine Le Grand Castelet, Alpilles-Provence 2023 £51

An elegant and unique blend of Merlot, Syrah & Marselan grapes. Deep nose with sweet spices. Smooth but present tannins, with a well-balanced long finish. Alpilles PGI is a recent Provence designation.

Le Prestige Bordeaux Blend Oak Aged, Bourdic, Pays d'Oc 2020 £54

A blend of 60% Merlot & 40% Cabernet-Sauvignon, finely aged in oak barrels, it can compete with many Bordeaux. Intense aromas of ripe fruit and spices with woody hints, finishing on a smooth structure.

Chateau Mossé, Côtes du Roussillon 2022 £56

Blend of 60% Syrah, 20% Carignan & 20% Mourvèdre. Intense with ripe red berry fruit aromas melted with sweet spices. The palate is full-bodied with soft tannins.

Chateau Penin Cabernet Franc "Massale" Bordeaux 2019 £58

A perfumed, smoky wine with soft tannins and juicy black fruits. Unlike vine clones, massale vines are genetic children of vines first planted in Pomerol vineyards 80 years ago.

Merlot "Natur", Chateau Penin, Bordeaux 2021. £60

This estate's first virtually sulphur-free wine! A 'naked' wine, which is better able to reveal the true nature of its soil, vines and flavours.

Chateau l'Argentier, Languedoc 2017 £70

A blend of old vines Grenache, Syrah, Carignan & Cinsault. Intensely aromatic, combining fine spices and garrigue herbs, with notes of forest floor & leather. The palate is quite powerful and mouth-filling.

Julienas "Vaux", Domaine Benjamin Passot, Beaujolais 2023 (Bio.) £78

Gamay from 80-year-old vines. This wine combines power and elegance with dense red fruit flavours, meaty/umami undertones, freshness and length, a serious Beaujolais Cru wine.

Bourgogne Rouge "Côte d'Or", Domaine Vaudoisey Creusefond, Burgundy 2023 £78

An elegant bouquet of fresh cherry and raspberry, intertwined with floral notes. Aging in oak gives delicate touches of vanilla and toast which complement the aromatic profile without dominating.

Bleu Toulouze, AOC Graves de Vayres, Bordeaux 2018 £78

It is a perfect blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. Bright purple colour, giving you a delicious bouquet of red berries, followed by silky tannins and a long, round and smooth character.

Poulsard, Dom. Victor Richard, Cotes du Jura 2023 (Bio.) £80

Poulsard is perhaps the iconic red grape variety of the Jura. Very pale in colour and light in body, it sits somewhere between a rosé and a red. The nose is simply beautiful, redolent of strawberries and cream.

ITALY

Nero d'Avola Sette Aje, Cantina Grasso, Sicily 2021 £46

Ruby-Red with intense aromas of red fruits (cherry and strawberry) and delicate flowery notes. In the mouth it is fresh and persistent with soft tannins. A rich and extraordinary wine.

Primitivo Preciso Appassimento, Cantine Paolo Leo, Puglia 2023/24 £48

The nose is complex with aromas of cherries, plums, dried fruit & garrigue. The oak ageing adds a pleasant toasty, spicy character. The palate is full bodied & the finish is rich with an excellent balance.

Barbera d'Asti Temperanza, Guasti & Co 2023 £56

Complex and intense wine, starting with fresh flower notes of violet and red roses, ample and intense notes of dark plums, cherry, raspberries and blackberries.

Le 4 Vigne, Giampiero Borghetti, IGT Rosso Verona, Veneto 2019 £60

A blend of Corvina, Corvinone & Rondinella. Intense bouquet of Morello cherries. Velvety, delicate taste, with a rich and persistent body.

Valpolicella Classico Superiore DOC, Giampiero Borghetti, Veneto 2022 £66

Giampiero Borghetti winery is located in Castelrotto, municipality of San Pietro.

It is the same blend as the 4 Vigne, spicy, delicate, fruity bouquet. Dry & balanced, delicate texture.

Le Sabbie dell'Etna Rosso, Firriato-Cavanera Etna, Sicily 2020 £75

Made from the native varieties Nerello Mascalese & Nerello Cappuccio. A delicious and complex bouquet with notes of cinnamon, black pepper, blackcurrant and cherries. Great personality.

SPAIN

Tempranillo Perdido, Bodegas Agronavarra, Vino de las 3 Riberas 2024

Medium intensity, ruby red colour. Aromas of red and black fruit. Round with great body - persistent and balanced.

Bottle £ 39 / glass £9.5 / carafe £28.5

Rioja Zinio Crianza 2021 £60

On the nose aromas of berries, ripe and well-integrated with the toasted aromas typical of an American barrel, vanilla and coconut. Attractive with ripe flavours, a long and round wine.

Tinto Artifice, Borja Perez Viticultor, Canary Islands 2017 £70

Listan Negro, is the main grape. It presents notes of strawberry, exotic spices, and a hint of smokiness. The palate is surprisingly delicate, with gentle tannins.

GERMANY

Pinot-Noir, Villa Wolf, Pfalz 2023 £54

From an estate rescued by the great Ernst Loosen, one of Germany's leading modern winemakers. Dark cherry notes and gentle spice from part ageing in seasoned oak. A silky, pretty red.

CHILEAN

Merlot Tonada, Viña Luis Felipe Edwards, Central Valley-Chile 2025

Produced by Chile's number one wine producer, Viña Luis Felipe Edwards, this Merlot comes from Chile's Central Valley region. Known for its fresh, ripe fruit flavours, plum notes and an enticing hint of smoke.

Bottle £36 / glass £9 / carafe £27

DESSERT WINE

Riesling Late Harvest, Casa del Bosque, Chile 2018 (37.5cl)

100% Botrytis. This complex wine reveals a seductive nose of mandarin & apricot. Lush notes of walnut, toasted almond and honey combine effortlessly with a zesty acidity to give excellent structure.

JAPANESE SAKE

Honjozo Oniwaka, Bunraku Kitanishi, Saitama (15%)

Made from Akebono rice. A karakuchi (dry) sake that is rich and crisp, with a long finish.

(This can be served either chilled or warmed)

Bottle £80 / glass £20 / carafe £60

Junmai Muroka Umakuchi, Kawatsuru, Kagawa (15.5%)

Yamadanishiki rice. This sake is perfectly balance between sweet & dry. Juicy notes of grapefruit and freshly cut grass, with a hint of anis. Crisp, but mellow finish with a vibrant energy behind it.

Bottle £91/ glass £22 / carafe £66

Junmai Ginjo Tenbu, Nishi Shuzo, Kagoshima (15%)

Yamadanishiki rice milled to 50%. A rich bouquet of ripe banana, apricot, orange, and fig.

Spicy white pepper and earthy minerality provide a solid foundation, finishing smooth and round.

Bottle £100 / glass £25/ carafe £75

Yuzu Shu, Umenoyado, Kinki-Nara (8%)

The juice of eight fruits is infused in sake. Yuzu is a citrus fruit indigenous to Japan that's close to a cross between a mandarin and a lime. Best enjoyed on the rocks or with soda.
