From winemakers who pay thought to the environment. All our wines are grown with biodiversity in mind – most are organic, and many are natural or made with minimal intervention. Enjoy classic (and some newer) grape varieties, and the smartest blends from winemakers apiece.

WHITE

175ml / 750ml

IL FOLLE: GRILLO (V) **£8.40 / £32.20**
‘Folle’ means ‘mad’. Fresh and citrusy in your glass – the Grillo grapes are handpicked from the hills around the town of Marsala. Word from the loon: Drink it. 2024, SICILY

H-HERO BIANCO (Ve) **£9.10 / £37.40**
Easy-drinking Chardonnay that’s seen no oak. Ripe with soft stone fruit, and melon for balanced acidity. Settimo Pizzolato swears by organic farming as he brings us this wine of the hour. NV, TREVISO

RUMBLEFISH VINHO VERDE (Ve) **£11.80 / £50.30**
Very nice no-brainer to please all palates. Zippy fizz, green apple and lime sherbet tickle cheeks. Pale lemon pour with a 10.5% ABV (if you’re keeping score). NV, VINHO VERDE

HERÈNCIA ALTÉS: BENUFET (Ve) **£59.60**
Old vine White Grenache that’s all flowery and peachy with ripe fruit and heaps of freshness. Organic and so bloomin’ wonderful. 2024, TERRA ALTA

RED

IL FOLLE: NERO D’AVOLA (V) **£8.40 / £32.20**
Otherwise, the crazy lady in red. Wild, gregarious and packed with Sicilian personality. Blackberry liqueur and vanilla do the work – tastes a bit like fruity marshmallow. 2024, SICILY

DOMINIO DE PUNCTUM: SYRAH (Ve) **£11.00 / £40.10**
First, the blackcurrant, blackberry and cherry lull you to take rest. Then, the velvety finish quilts your tongue. From three siblings in Las Pedroñeras. 2024, CASTILLA LA MANCHA

CHAPEAU MELON ROUGE (Ve) **£11.30 / £47.10**
From a fourth-generation winemaker, making his mark in Muscadet. Brilliant cherry-red, actually looks purple. Smooth and fruity when it slips down your hatch. 2024, LOIRE VALLEY

BODEGA MUSTIGUILLO: MESTIZAJE (Ve) **£56.80**
Organic, red-black beauty with Bobal, Garnacha and Syrah. Prune on the nose, plum on the tongue – and a touch of oak. This Valencia mountain wine is grown 800 metres above sea level. 2022, EL TERRERAZO

ROSÉ

LES JARDINS FLEURIS (Ve) **£9.20 / £36.80**
Luscious bursts of cranberry and pink grapefruit – produced by the Vic family in their French vineyards. The juice soaks the skin before pressing. Flush in colour. 2024, LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON

H-HERO ROSATO (Ve) **£11.00 / £42.80**
Five generations of one family stand behind this happy-going rosé. Cherry, berry, delightful and pink. NV, VENETO

TROUPIS WINERY: EKATO ROSÉ (Ve) **£60.60**
A touch of rose on the nose, elegant acidity, slight spice and a hint of quince jam. Plus, it’s a gorgeous ruby-rose colour. 2024, PELOPONNESE

ORANGE

NEW THEORY: WHITE LIES (Ve) **£11.00 / £52.00**
Bursts of ripe peach and grapefruit, as Thom and Charles Bradley work with South African winemakers to pick the best produce. A light, easy-going, low-intervention wine. This time, let the flowers sing. 2024, STELLENBOSCH

DOMINIO DE PUNCTUM: POMELADO (V) **£12.70 / £53.10**
Bruised apple, dried orange and maybe an almond. A lovely Sauvignon Blanc – even better for the skin-contact. For those who love it dry. 2024, CASTILLA LA MANCHA

SPARKLING

BELLA STORIA: SPUMANTE (Ve) **£9.20 / £45.50**
Toast to having a beautiful history (*bella storia*)! Old-school co-op grows organic Garganega grapes to make this refreshing Prosecco-like fizz. Extra dry. NV, VENETO

INTEGRALE: FRIZZANTE BIANCO (Ve) **£9.80 / £48.80**
Dry grapefruit bite with white flowers – and lively sparkles will make you happy. The grapes come from South Padua in Italy. NV, VENETO

INTEGRALE: FRIZZANTE ROSÉ (Ve) **£53.10**
Cloudy, candy-floss pink. The colour alone will turn your head – and then you catch the aromas of rose and cherry. Produced in Asolo and Valdobbiadene, so you know it’ll be fruity. NV, VENETO

821 BLANC DE BLANCS DE CHARDONNAY BRUT (Ve) . . . **£92.10**
Chablis minerality, but with fizz. This bottle saunters out of Le Domaine D’Henri. Apple, lemon and brioche cling onto it like a satin gown. Seduction takes time. 821 days to be exact. 2022, CHABLIS

PERMIT ROOM X KINGFISHER BEER TOWER (Ve) . . . **£36.50**
Three tall litres of India’s top golden goodness. On tap, chilled, at your table. Pour a few crisp ones and get your party’s party started. 4.5% (3L)

KINGFISHER (Ve) **£7.70**
Staple of Indian drinking holes. Mild, malty and easy to drink. Neck it from a cold glass and pretend you’re respectable. 4.5% (PINT)

DISHOOM IPA (Ve) **£6.90**
Seriously good IPA with citrus notes, specially crafted for Dishoom by Mondo Brewing Company. Good egg makes good beer. 5.0% (TWO-THIRDS PINT)

UMBRELLA RHUBARB CIDER (Ve) **£6.00**
Slips down easy and makes life rosy. Dry and refreshing, with dessert apples and sharp-tart rhubarb from a Herefordshire farm. 3.4% (TWO-THIRDS PINT)

TWISTED CLASSICS

IN A PONY GLASS

ORANGE WINE MARGARITA (Ve) £13.20

A risky drink, as it's obscenely good for your health. Orange wine and its syrup, almond bitters for nutty depth, a touch of citrus and Altos Reposado tequila. The classic margarita can retire.

MANGOSTEEN DAIQUIRI (Ve) £13.20

White rum, mangosteen, fruit syrup and chamomile get mixed up. Let the nice person spray your pony with lime oil.

PERMIT ROOM CLOVER CLUB (V) £13.20

Don't be fooled by the pretty pink, or the coconut-cardamom foam – there's strength inside this velvet glove. House raspberry-and-lychee liqueur, Beefeater dry gin and a dash of lemon oil. You will feel historical.

CHAI CAFFÈ MARTINI (Ve) £13.20

No sleeping on this pillow. Sip rich coffee, chai spices and banana-infused La Hechicera rum through a silky cushion of crema. Nibble on the bit of banana.

BLUSHING DAWN PALOMA (Ve) £13.20

Kumquat super-juice, chilli-infused Altos Plata tequila, spice, pink salt, lime-oil sugar and a hint of Del Maguey mezcal. Smoky but no coughing.

BEYOND THE PALE DAYLIGHT (Ve) £13.20

Worth getting out of bed at any time for this tropical custard-apple sherry and Indian tonic. Low alcohol (3.8%), if you care.

GOLDEN GLOAMING FIZZER (Ve) £13.20

Soda of orange bitters with cordial from pressed mandarin juice and a fresh segment to eat. Not to mention the lingering Redbreast 12-Year-Old Irish whiskey.

ON THE ROCKS

MANGO LASSI PUNCH (V) £13.50

Old Monk rum (a Bombay favourite) with yoghurt and spicy mango syrup. In some legend there's a handsome monk in the forest...

SUMMERHOUSE NEGRONI (V) £13.90

A boozy break to Northern India's hilltop apples. Beefeater dry gin, Campari, sweet vermouth with dashes of Manzanilla dry sherry, apricot liqueur and Calvados.

NEW PERMIT ROOM OLD-FASHIONED (V) £13.90

A newly-fashioned old hat. Coconut-washed Woodford Reserve bourbon, Pedro Ximénez sherry and Medjool-date liqueur. "High-class Bombay in a glass" – so they say.

SHORT & BOOZY

PONY GLASS or TWO SIPS

FENI MARTINI (V) £13.50 / £5.50

A nod to old, dangerous Indian moonshine. A green olive rests in a cloudy-cold mix of Monkey 47 dry gin, Axia Extra Dry Mastiha spirit and cashew eau de vie. Is it love? It is strong, balanced, pure.

THUMS UP SAZERAC (Ve) £13.50 / £5.50

Ice-cold, old-school classic of Sazerac rye whiskey, Seignette VS cognac, Peychaud's bitters and absinthe, sweetened with a reduction of Thums Up (Indian big-name cola rebel).

AUNTY'S ANJEER MANHATTAN (V) £13.50 / £5.50

Fig liqueur, bourbon, sweet vermouth and bitters. Medicinal aroma (for your health).

FROZEN LIPSTERS

SPICY GUAVA FROSÉ (Ve) £11.90

A tumbler of rosé ice-crush with guava fruit, and candied red chilli to play hot-and-cold.

KIWI COLADA SHIMMY (Ve) £11.90

Let this icy pineapple-coconut classic – laced with rum, kiwi, lemongrass and ginger – shimmy down your drainpipe.

MORNING GLORIES

MARMALADE MIMOSA (Ve) £11.90

Home-made marmalade liqueur, fresh red grapefruit juice and Integrale organic sparkling wine. Calm, cloudy, comforting, possibly the cure.

CRYSTAL MARY (V) £11.90

Pale clear concoction of tomato and jalapeño-infused vodka with aromas of green. Close your eyes: it tastes red.

BLOODY MARY (V) £11.90

This one tastes red because it is red, business as usual. No illusions, just the imaginary hair of the imaginary dog, and the spicy comfort of tough love.

VIRGIN MARY (V) £8.50

Feistiness abounds, but there is no swearing.

(NO HAFTA)

SOBER SUMMER NEGRONI (Ve) £9.80

Green apple and apricot, no-alcohol gin, no-alcohol vermouth, no-alcohol bitter. Dishoom hand-made them all, singing no, no, no.

PINK PEPPER PINEAPPLE SODA (Ve) £9.20

Foam-capped sparkling green Darjeeling with gentle pineapple cordial and pink peppercorn tincture. Tingles on your tongue. Abstemious and glorious.

NO-HAFTA KIWI COLADA (Ve) £9.20

Frozen pineapple-coconut classic – with kiwi, lemongrass and ginger. Plenty of shimmy, but no rummy.

LYCHEE FRENCH '75 (Ve) £9.20

Juices of lemon and cabernet grape, with no-alcohol gin and lychee sparkling wine – all 100% prohibition-friendly. (No permit required.)
