BREAKFAST

Served until 11.45am every day

COOKED BREAKFASTS

THE FULL PERMIT £15.90

A fry-up. Nicely-spiced akuri with smoky-streaky Ramsay's bacon, Shropshire pork sausages, masala beans, grilled field mushrooms and home-made buttered buns for mopping.

CHICKEN KEEMA PAU £12.20

Spiced minced chicken topped with a fried egg for yolky-richness. Mop it up with freshly baked plump pau.

AKURI PAU (V) £11.50

Three eggs, scrambled creamy-slowly with tomato, onion and peppery green chilli. Served with buttered pau. All the Bombay breakfast feels.

PERMIT ROOM FRENCH TOAST (+V option) . . £15.20

Gold medal of breakfasts. Cinnamon spiced eggy brioche with a little soft pillowy cheese. Hot-chilli honey for heat. Fresh berries for tang. Crisp-smoky rashers of Ramsay of Carluke's streaky bacon for all (or vegetarian without £12.20).

FRUITS, GRAINS & BREADS

HOUSE GRANOLA (+Ve option) £9.90

Handmade with toasted oats, seeds, cashews, almonds, pistachios and cinnamon. Served with fresh seasonal fruits and dairy vanilla yoghurt with starflower honey, or creamy coconut yoghurt.

FRUITS & YOGHURT (+Ve option) £9.20

Fresh seasonal fruits topped with creamy yoghurt infused with fresh vanilla pod. Choose from dairy yoghurt drizzled with starflower honey, or coconut yoghurt.

DATE & BANANA PORRIDGE (Ve) £8.70

Organic porridge oats cooked with oat milk, banana and sweet Medjool dates. If you want more, ask. This is a bottomless portion.

BUN MASKA CHAI (V) £5.70

The Irani café classic. Soft bun with butter inside, to be dunked in the hot chai. The simplest thing, eaten everywhere in Bombay.

Our bacon is supplied by Ramsay of Carluke. Our pork sausages are from Maynard's Farm and our vegan sausages are from Symplicity. All egg dishes are made with St Ewe Free Range Eggs. If you have any food allergies or dietary requirements, please let us know.

NAAN ROLLS

Each naan is freshly baked – by hand, and to order – in the tandoor. It is then spread with cream cheese, tomato-chilli jam and fresh coriander leaves, and wrapped around a first-rate filling. (Request a little chopped green chilli on the side for more zing.)

BACON NAAN ROLL £11.20

Ramsay of Carluke's smoked streaky bacon is matured in the traditional Ayrshire way and then smoked over applewood and beechwood chips. Dishoom's cult dish is deserving of all its accolades.

DOUBLE BACON NAAN ROLL £13.20

Twice the bacon. More power to you.

BACON & EGG NAAN ROLL £12.90

SAUSAGE NAAN ROLL £11.70

Shropshire pork sausages, warmly spiced with cracked black pepper. Each sausage is finished by hand.

SAUSAGE & EGG NAAN ROLL £13.20

NEW VEG. SAUSAGE & EGG NAAN ROLL (+Ve option*) £12.90

Cleverly fermented, crispy-smashed veggie sausage with runny-yolked fried eggs. Umami loaded. A real piece of work with Neil Rankin. Go vegan – ask your server.

EGG NAAN ROLL (V) £10.20

Two fried Cornish free-range eggs with saffron-orange, runny yolks. Warm and most gratifying.

WRESTLER'S NAAN ROLL £14.70

Named for Koolar & Co.'s wrestler-sized portions. Smoked streaky bacon, peppery pork sausages and runny-yolked egg. Grapple with it.
