201. Chardonnay/Colombard , Duc de Chapelle (Languedoc/France) This is a dry, refreshing combination of aromatic, lemony Colombard, which has been carefully balanced with Chardonnay to add depth and roundness. It is selected from the cool Atlantic influenced vineyards of Gascogne.	4.60	17.50
202. Sauvignon Blanc , La Playa (Curico Valley/Chile) Lemon in colour with hints of green, the nose is highly aromatic with strong notes of citrus fruits and flowers together with subtle yet pleasant touches of fresh grass and ripe pineapples.	5.20	19.00
203. Albarino Rias Baixas , Condes de Albarei (Galicia/Spain) The Albariño grape variety thrives on its cool coastal location and produces fresh elegant wines with a captivating floral bouquet and peach flavours. It is believed that Albariño is a distant relative to the Riesling grape.	6.90	26.50

204. Pinot Grigio `Portenova` Fabiano (Veneto/France) A brilliant straw yellow colour, elegant perfume of acacia flowers, almonds and dried fruit. A soft, well-balanced palate combines citrus, exotic fruit and fresh apples. Elegant and dry.	22.00	211. Riesling 'Reserve' , Jean Baptiste Adam (Alsace/France) An evocative bouquet, floral with lime zest and white flowers, gives way to a refined palate which is both lively with grapefruit and mineral nuances that linger and balanced by a refreshing acidity.	29.50

Sancerre `les Longues Fins`, Domaine Andre Neveu (Loire/France) The Sauvignon blanc grape excels in this rich, flinty soil. This single vineyard Sancerre has the added complexity of mineral and herbaceous flavours on the palate. The immense long flavour of gooseberries and blackcurrant leaves lingers on the finish.	34.50
206. Rioja Blanco , 'Monte Llano', Ramon Bilbao (Rioja/Spain) Fresh, bright unoaked white Rioja which is lively and clean with a youthful acidity. A bouquet of acacia and white flowers is backed by peach and melon fruit character and citrus notes.	23.50	213. Chablis 1er Cru `Mont de Milieu`, Domaine Alain Gautheron (Burgundy/France) Floral aromas and fresh apple and mineral character abound in this traditional Chablis from an exceptional family estate in Fleys.	39.50

Africa) This is a fresh and expressive unwooded Chardonnay, matured on its lees to produce a vibrant, lemony dry wine with a yeasty and delicate nutty finish.	25.00	214. Meursault 1er Cru `Blagny`, Domaine Michel Bouzereau 2011 (Burgundy/France) This distinguished grower creates rich and voluptuous Meursaults, exotic with the bouquet of toasted hazelnut, almond and butterscotch yet elegant and supple with a hint of toasted oak.	65.00
208. Sauvignon Blanc , Durvillea (Marlborough/New Zealand) Gooseberry flavours abound balanced with a light acidity and strong mineral finish.	26.50	215. Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru 'Les Perrieres', Dom. Lucien Boillot 2009 (Burgundy/France) Warmer weather than usual in the 2009 vintage resulted in ripe, healthy grapes which produced very good quality wines. This wine has a crisp minerality to balance the ripe fruit flavours creating a graceful and elegant wine.	80.00
209. Gruner Veltliner/Pinot Blanc Dollini, Dolle (Niederosterreich/Austria) Immensely fresh aromas of herbs and peach blossom are permeated with fine mineral and peppery undertones, finishing with vibrant acidity.	28.00		
210. Pinot Gris `Family Vineyard`, Wairau River (Marlborough/New Zealand) This trendy mineral influenced Marlborough white, captures the very essence of the regions clean and pure climate. Shiraz 'Polish Hill River', Paulett Winery (Clare Valley/Australia) Wonderful and seductive Shiraz with aromas of blackberry, plum and chocolate, richly flavoured with candied fruits, game and mineral nuances.</p>
<p>221. Sangiovese 'Organic' Boira 2013 (Marche/Italy) Rich ruby colour, the aroma is laden with stone fruit and brambles. The palate is smooth and balanced with plum overtones. Pinot Noir 'Province' Astrolabe (Marlborough/New Zealand) Full to medium bodied with round, mouth filling flavours of plum and cherry, pleasing weight and a long fresh elegant finish. Top notch Pinot with integrated smooth silky tannins.</p>
<p>222. Malbec 'ES Vino' Finca Sopenia (Mendoza/Argentina) Aromas of intense ripe fruit, cherries, blackberries, blueberries, and fresh plums, combined with spicy and floral hints. A wine of good intensity, concentration and long after taste.</p>	25.50	<p>228. Moulin d'Angludet 2009 2nd wine of Ch. Angludet', Margaux (Bordeaux/France) The incredible 2009 vintage resulted in perfect ripeness and a perfumed bouquet of red fruits with earthy undertones. Supple dark fruits, licorice and spice notes are held by assertive but ripe tannins that ensure Moulin d' Angludet can be enjoyed when young but will also allow further maturation.</p>

Corbieres 'Futs de Chene' Chateau Vaugelas (Languedoc/France) Aromas of red fruits and cherries are backed by hints of vanilla and mellow liquorice balanced with fine tannins leaving the finish luxuriant and long.</p>	26.50	<p>229. Nuits St Georges 1er Cru 2009 'La Richemone' Domaine A. Michelot (Burgundy/France) This Nuits 1er Cru 'la Richemone' comes from old Pinot Noir vines of 30 years old or more, planted in limestone and red marl soil beside the appellation Vosne Romanee. The wine produced here has big fruit aromas of raspberries and cherry followed by good depth and richness on the palate.</p>
<p>224. Carmenere 'Single Vineyard', Chono (Maipo/Chile) An intense ruby colour with aromas of juicy black fruits and spicy notes on the nose. The palate it is full bodied and well structured with flavours of plums, blackberries and white pepper.</p>	27.50	<p>230. Cote Rotie 'Ampodium' Domaine Rene Rostaing 2009 (Rhône/France) Made from 100% Syrah which is sourced from thirteen different lieux-dits, this is an attractive wine with a floral bouquet of black fruits, violets and lavender. The palate is smooth and silky with fine grained tannins and a perfect balance between the dark fruit and spicy notes.</p>
