Antinori Bolgheri Vermentino 2022, Toscana, Italy	£11.00	£58.00
<i>Amongst the oldest and most well respected producers in Italy the Antinori family has been making wines in Tuscany since Giovanni di Piero Antinori joined the Florentine Winemakers' Guild in 1385. This Vermentino comes from their Guado Al Tasso Estate directly overlooking the coastline. These fresh Ligurian sea breezes allow the grapes to maintain their tongue tantalisingly fresh acidity whilst developing elderflower, lemon and floral notes.</i>		
Lothian Vineyard Selection Chardonnay, 2020, Elgin, South Africa	£11.50	£64.00
<i>Previously a Protea farm, the picturesque house and vineyard of Lothian sits nestled in the mountainous region of Elgin. Working with the esteemed Richard Kershaw as their winemaker, Lothian utilises their relatively cool climate to focus of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir only. This hand harvested and lightly oaked wine has a clean, fresh feel to it with grapefruit being followed by yellow apple and nectarine all tied up with gentle oak spices and a touch of dried apricot.</i>		
Domaine De Beaufort Chateaufort du Pape, 2022 France	£18.50	£105.00
<i>An excellent example of white Châteaufort: gently aromatic, with notes of pears, apricots, hawthorn and fennel, then round and textured in the mouth, with a seam of minerality providing focus. The Coulon family at Domaine de Beaufort combine ambition and modesty to winning effect. The family has run this estate for seven generations (the history can be traced back even further, to 1695) and it currently consists of thirty-two hectares in Chateaufort and twenty-five in Rasteau.</i>

This wine also has some cabernet sauvignon blended in to add to the classic gaglioppo flavours of redcurrants and clay with some dried blackcurrant and slight green pepper notes. This blend is aged in new French oak for a full year as well so soften the tannin structure and add cloves and cinnamon to the beautifully rounded finish.</i>				
Thomas Morey Pommard les Chanlins 1er Cru 2021, Burgundy, France			£16.00	£90.00
<i>One of the many small boutique producers of burgundy, it speaks to the outstanding quality of Thomas Morey's wines that he has been able to garner the international renown that he has with just 9 hectares of vines. This Pommard is red fruited with cherry and strawberry dominating the palate and the classic Burgundian oaky earthy notes just starting to develop on the mellow, well constituted finish</i>				
Chateau La Lagune 3eme Grand Cru Classe 1981, Bordeaux, France			£17.00	
<i>A rare opportunity to sample a glass of a truly mature Bordeaux, this 3rd cru classe Bordeaux still displays rich stewed red cherry notes alongside the typical aged earthy and game notes. Despite the age this wine still has a reasonable freshness of acidity on the palate and although very ripe the tannin structure is still tangible.</i>
