# Timeless Elegance

Since the 18th Century, the Brocket Hall Estate has been one of the most fashionable and romantic locations for weddings and grand celebrations. Full of exciting incident, glamour and intrigue, it possesses a sense of drama and anticipation that is felt immediately upon arrival at the gates, which then builds as the journey to the illustrious ancestral home is travelled. Few other venues can offer such far reaching, magical amenities and private entertainment only 22 miles from central London.

The earliest evidence of a house on the Brocket Hall Estate dates back to 1239. Since then, the house has been rebuilt twice, most recently in 1760 for Sir Matthew Lamb.

Previously the home of two Prime Ministers – Lord Melbourne and Lord Palmerston,

Brocket Hall was designed by architect James Paine and is set in 543 acres of parkland, landscaped by Richard Woods.
