



A garden and courtyard, a barn for ceremony and dancing, another for drinks and sit-down meal: you choose how your day unfolds.



SPECIAL PRIVATE SPACES




A suite for you with its own secret garden, hidden away until your big reveal. Mirrors, natural light and room to spread out, giving you the space you need to prepare for the day.


Seven rooms for your guests look out on a beautifully maintained courtyard. Where they can get ready, then relax and wind down from the excitement of the day.

Farbridge bread and salted butter

STARTERS

Butternut and coconut soup, fried peanuts, crispy onions, spring onion oil

Warm scotch egg, white coleslaw, brown sauce, house chutney

Roast salmon, watercress sauce, puffed rice, crispy leeks

Loaded potato skins with smoked pulled pork, pickled red onions, roasted salsa verde

Your starter, can be swapped for 4 canapes from the following selection

CANAPES

Salt and pepper chicken, fermented chilli yoghurt dip	Panko squid, siracha mayonnaise



BAR	 We provide a fully stocked, licensed pay bar which can be opened at any time after your ceremony There is a minimum spend of £850 Our licence to serve alcohol is until 11.30pm

DAY GUESTS	Our package price includes food for 80 peopleAdditional day guests are priced at £82.50 per person
EVENING GUESTS	 Our package price allows for up to 100 people in the evening Additional evening guests are priced at £13.50 per person

SUPPLIER MEALS	• If your suppliers, such as photographer, videographer, band, require a meal, we can supply hot meals for £30 per meal

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PLANNING TIMELINE

6-9 MONTHS BEFORE

- Agree your wedding budget
- Book the date and time of your ceremony with minister or registrar (ceremonies from 2pm at Farbridge)
- Draft guest list and send 'Save the Date' messages
- Research and take out wedding insurance
- Research and book wedding suppliers including:
 - florist
 - photographer/videographer
 - cake maker
 - band/DI/musician
 - hairdresser and make up
 - wedding transport
- Meet your Farbridge event manager to discuss initial ideas and plans

- Choose your bridesmaids/groomsmen
- Create a wedding theme including colour, scheme, centrepieces and other decoration
- Choose and order your bridal wedding attire
- Plan your honeymoon:
 - book annual leave
 - check passports are valid
 - arrange vaccinations and visas, if needed
- take our travel insurance
- Give notice of your intent to marry at your local registry office
- 6 months to go: pay 2nd instalment to Farbridge

3-6 MONTHS BEFORE

- Shop for wedding accessories: ties, veil, jewellery and shoes
- Send invitations to your guests
- Book local accommodation for the night before your wedding, if needed
- Order favours, table decorations, place cards and other venue decorations
- Arrange suit and dress fittings for the wedding party
- Choose and buy your wedding rings

- Discuss personalised vows and readings for your ceremony, if you'd like to have these
- Create playlists for your ceremony, drinks reception, wedding breakfast and first dance
- Agree and finalise the flowers for your wedding day
- Confirm honeymoon booking, timings and other details
- 3 months to go: pay 3rd instalment to Farbridge

2 MONTHS BEFORE

- Confirm details of your ceremony with minister or registrar, including order of service, vows, readings and witnesses
- Review guest RSVPs and finalise your seating plan
- Arrange a trial run with hairdresser and/or make up artist, if needed
- Purchase alcohol and soft drinks, if you haven't chosen a Farbridge drinks package

MONTH BEFORE

- Arrange your final wedding dress and suit fittings as well as your bridal party
- Finalise details with your wedding suppliers, including itinerary
- Complete your Final Details form for Farbridge and return to your event manager
- along with your floor plan
- Collect your wedding rings (and marriage licence if you're getting married in a church)
- Think about gifts for the wedding party

2 WEEKS BEFORE

- Pay remaining balance to Farbridge
- Organise table decorations into individual boxes for each table for an efficient set up on your wedding day
- Provide the photographer with list of essential shots

THE WEEK/ DAY BEFORE


- Write thank you cards for your helpers and wrap any thank you gifts
- Pack your honeymoon luggage with tickets and passports if you're travelling within 1-2 days of your wedding
- Deliver decorations and alcohol for your wedding day to Farbridge
- Meet your event manager to run through your day and cover any final questions
- Make sure all wedding outfits and accessories are packed, along with any overnight bags if needed
- Take care of all final beauty and grooming appointments
- Finalise all details with your wedding party
- Make time to relax
