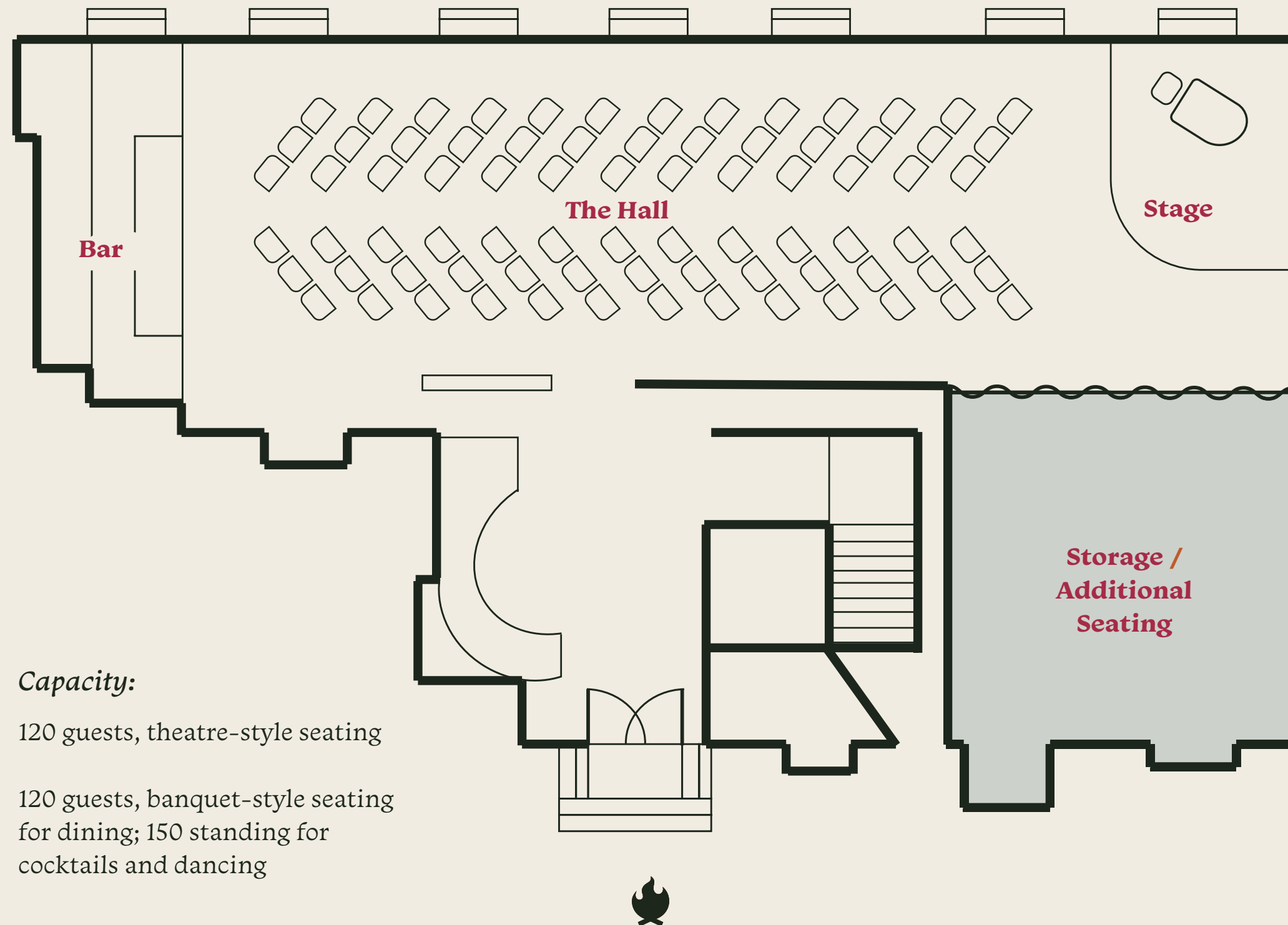

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The Hall

Our largest space, The Hall is at the heart of Bradmore House—where genuine warmth sits alongside modern grandeur.

High arched windows flood the space with natural light, perfect for daytime wedding ceremonies and celebrations. By night, candlelight catches brass and marble surfaces, while the fireplace casts its own amber glow.

A fully equipped stage, stocked bar, coat check, and flexible layout ensure your evening unfolds exactly as you've planned. Begin with your ceremony in The Hall, invite guests upstairs to The Library & Salon Bar for cocktails, then return for dinner and dancing in the main space.

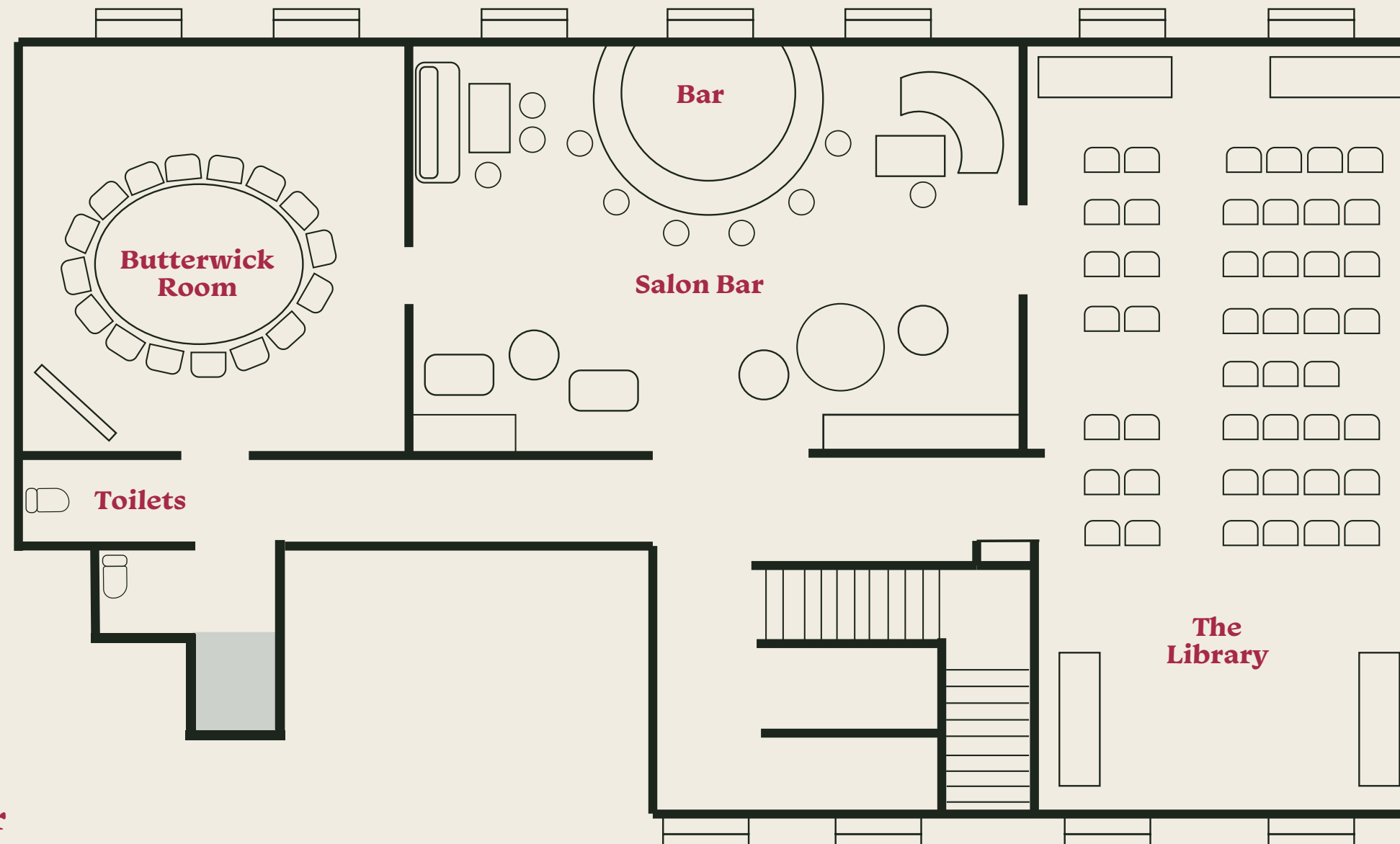

Perched on Kindred's second floor, The Library & Salon Bar form an elegant self-contained world for intimate celebrations.

The Library is a tranquil space defined by colour-coded bookshelves, deep green walls, high arched windows, soft lighting, and seating for up to 45. The hushed glamour of the adjoining Salon Bar with its timeless charm serves as a natural gathering point, and fuels the celebration throughout the day and evening.

The beauty lies in the flexibility: host your intimate ceremony in The Library, move to the Salon Bar for drinks and conversation, then invite your evening guests to The Hall for dancing and late-night dining.

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Butterwick Room

Set on the top floor, the Butterwick Room combines eighteenth-century details, soaring ceilings, and rich blue walls to create a sophisticated setting that feels both historically rooted and entirely contemporary.

Its centrepiece oval table seats 16—making it ideal for private wedding party gatherings, children's separate dining, or a quiet refuge during your celebration.

From I Do to Dancing: *Ceremony & Reception*

From 10am, the venue is entirely yours. Your vendors set up while we prepare The Hall for your ceremony, and The Library & Salon Bar for drinks and celebration. By 2pm, your guests begin to arrive.

What unfolds is exactly what you've envisioned: your ceremony flows into cocktails, then dinner, then dancing late into the evening.

Your photographer is free to move around the venue to capture every moment. Your DJ controls the room. Your florist transforms each space into something uniquely yours.

Important Notes for Hiring by the Room

Civil Ceremonies:

Only The Hall and The Library are licensed for civil wedding ceremonies. Your ceremony must take place in one of these spaces.

What's Included & What's Extra:

The hire fee covers the space, staffing, equipment, and furniture, plus cake storage and service. Food and drink are ordered separately.

Optional additions:

- Menu Tasting: £250 for two people
- AV Engineer: £275 + VAT for the first 5 hours (£50 + VAT per additional hour). Recommended for weddings with live music, DJs, or specific technical requirements.

Booking Times:

For single-space hire, we offer two time slots: 10am–5pm or 6pm–11pm. Select whichever suits your vision and your guests.

Your Package:

Choose from our four wedding packages: Brass & Marble, Rose Gold, Diamond, or Double Diamond. All packages apply to room hire exactly as they do to exclusive takeovers. Select your space, choose your package, and we'll tailor everything to fit. A non-discretionary service charge of 10% will be added to any packages and food and drink, plus a 3% admin fee onto your final bill.

Flexibility:

Just as with exclusive hire, you can mix and match menus, add canapés, include late-night food, or customize entirely. Discuss your vision with your event manager and we'll make it happen.

Choose Your Celebration Style

Our wedding packages are designed to be flexible—we encourage you to swap things in and out, add bits here and there, to make your day entirely your own. Everything is possible. These packages apply to both ceremony + reception and reception-only bookings at the same pricing.

Brass & Marble | £90 per person + VAT

An informal reception with Prosecco for toasts, a selection of three canapés, four bowls, and late-night food.

Rose Gold | £125 per person + VAT

A Prosecco reception with a selection of four canapés, followed by a three-course seated dinner (either feasting or individually plated), half a bottle of wine per guest, and late-night food.

Diamond | £168 per person + VAT

A Champagne reception with a selection of five canapés, a three-course seated dinner (either feasting or individually plated), half a bottle of fine wine per guest, and late-night food.

Double Diamond | £200 per person + VAT

Everything from the Diamond package—Champagne reception, five canapés, three-course seated dinner, and half a bottle of fine wine per guest—plus a cocktail hour, shot o'clock (your choice of premium shot), and a grazing table.

Additional Fees

A non-discretionary service charge of 10% will be added to any packages and food and drink, plus a 3% admin fee onto your final bill.

Extra Fees & What's Included

Transparency, Always

We believe in being upfront about every cost. Everything below is additional to your package price—nothing hidden.

Late Licence Fee & Security

Events finish at 11pm as standard. A midnight extension is available at £375 + VAT. A 2am licence is available at £750 + VAT, including two security personnel.

AV Engineer

Yes. Discuss your requirements with your event manager. If you're bringing a DJ or live band, our AV engineer is a recommended addition to ensure everything runs smoothly. DJs and bands can use our equipment with prior agreement. For two-floor takeovers, the first 5 hours of AV engineer support is included as standard. Additional hours are £50 + VAT per hour. For single-space hires, the AV engineer is £275 + VAT for the first five hours, then £50 + VAT per additional hour.

Service Charge

A non-discretionary service charge of 10% will be added to any packages and food and drink for your wedding. 100% of this goes directly to the team working your celebration—those in the kitchen, on the bar, and on the floor. We apply this charge because we believe our team should always be rewarded for the work they put in, and we want to be transparent about that from the outset.

Admin Fee

A 3% admin fee is applied to the overall wedding total. This covers the administrative cost of planning, coordinating, and managing your booking from enquiry through to the day itself. As with our service charge, we'd rather be upfront about this from the start than have any surprises appear on your final invoice.

Menu Tasting

A menu tasting is included with all two-floor takeovers (with event manager and head chef, wines included). For single-space hire, we charge £250 for two people.

Corkage (If Bringing Your Own Wine or Drinks):

You can bring your own wine or drinks, subject to corkage. Still wine: £25 per bottle. Sparkling wine: £35 per bottle. Spirits: £70 per bottle. Beer, cider, or soft drinks: £4 per bottle or can. Please discuss with your event manager in advance.

External Catering

We ask that you don't bring food or drinks in from outside without prior agreement. If you'd like to discuss bringing an external caterer (perhaps for a rehearsal dinner or post-wedding breakfast), corkage fees start at £15 per person. Please speak to your event manager.

Bespoke Menus

Our chef team can work with you to design a completely bespoke menu for your wedding. This service starts from £500 depending on the brief and includes tastings.

The Drinks

Because Drinks Matter Too

Drinks matter at Kindred. Whether you're a wine enthusiast, a cocktail connoisseur or a 'just a pint, please' kind of person, we don't judge. We're just as happy popping the champagne as we are pouring a pint, and our cocktails have built something of a reputation.

There's no single right way to handle drinks at your wedding.

Here are *two approaches others have found work well:*

Kindred FAQs

Booking & Payment

How do I secure a wedding date?

We'll work with you to understand your requirements and build a tailored quote—one that can be updated as your plans develop. We ask for 50% upfront to secure the date, with the remaining 50% due at least two weeks before your wedding, along with your final food and drink choices and headcount. If your wedding is less than two weeks away, full payment is required to confirm.

What is the cancellation policy?

You can cancel at any time in writing. Depending on when you cancel, some or all of the payment may be non-refundable. Where possible, we'll do our best to resell your date and, if successful, may be able to offer a partial or full refund. The same applies if you need to reschedule. Please read the full terms and conditions before booking, and speak to your event manager if you have any questions.

What does the hire fee cover for single-use spaces?

The hire fee covers the space, staffing, equipment, and furniture, plus cake storage and service. Food and drink is ordered separately—your event manager will help you find options that work for your budget and guest count.

Menu tastings (£250 for two people) and AV engineering (£275 + VAT for the first 5 hours) are available as optional extras. We recommend the AV engineer for weddings with live music, DJs, or specific technical requirements.

How do damage deposits work?

For weddings, we charge a damage deposit of 20% of the booking value, up to a maximum of £2,000. Any damage attributed to you, your guests, or your suppliers will be assessed and a repair or replacement quote obtained. That sum will be deducted before the deposit is returned. If no damage is reported, your deposit is refunded in full within five working days.

Food & Drink

Can we bring our own wine or drinks?

Yes, subject to corkage. Current rates: still wine £25 per bottle, sparkling wine £35 per bottle, spirits £70 per bottle, beer, cider, or soft drinks £4 per bottle or can. Please discuss with your event manager in advance.

Can we bring in external catering?

We ask that you don't bring food or drinks in from outside without prior agreement. If you'd like to discuss bringing an external caterer, please speak to your event manager. Forkage fees start at £15 per person.

Can you accommodate bespoke menus or specific dietary requirements?

Yes. Our chef team can work with you to design a bespoke menu for your wedding. This service starts from £500 depending on the brief and includes tastings. We also cater individually for all dietary requirements and allergies—please let your event manager know in advance. Halal available on request.

Is a menu tasting included?

Two-floor takeovers: Yes. A tasting is included in the hire fee. You'll taste menu options alongside your event manager and head chef, with your choice of still and sparkling wines.

Single-space hire: Menu tastings are available for £250 for two people.

Is cakeage included?

Yes. Storage and cutting of your wedding cake is included in the hire fee for all weddings. We'll keep it safe and serve it at exactly the right moment.

On the Day & Logistics

How late can our wedding run?

Events finish at 11pm as standard.

Extensions available:

Midnight (includes two security personnel): £375 + VAT

2am licence (includes two security personnel): £750 + VAT

Single-space hire:

Events finish at 5pm or 11pm as standard. If you choose an 11pm finish, midnight and 2am extensions are available at the same rates above.

Can we decorate the space?

Yes—and everything can be discussed with your event manager. We don't permit exposed flames or confetti cannons. Natural confetti (dried flowers, petals, etc.) is permitted outside on the steps only. No synthetic confetti anywhere in or around the building.

Can we use the outdoor balcony?

Absolutely. The use of our first-floor outdoor balcony is included as part of all two-floor takeovers and serves many purposes throughout

your celebration. It's stunning for photos and sparklers, perfect for outdoor drinks or canapés during cocktail hour, and provides a wonderful spot for guests to step outside for fresh air. It's also our designated smoking and vaping area.

Is there a cloakroom?

Yes. Coat check is included as standard with all bookings.

Can we book entertainment?

Yes. Discuss your requirements with your event manager. If you'd like us to help source and book entertainers on your behalf, we can support you with that.

Will there be AV support on the day?

Yes. AV equipment is set up and ready to go. For most weddings, this covers your needs—but it's worth discussing your requirements in advance.

If you have live music, a DJ, or specific technical needs, we recommend adding a dedicated AV Engineer: £275 + VAT for the first 5 hours (£50 + VAT per additional hour). Two-floor takeovers include the first 5 hours as standard.

Can DJs or bands use your equipment?

Yes, with prior agreement. Use of our equipment is included with the hire of our AV engineer.

Do you have a space for the ceremony, then a getting-ready room?

Yes. We have rooms available for getting ready, couple portraits, or

private moments before you walk down the aisle. Please speak to your event manager for details and additional charges.

Can children attend?

Yes, provided they are supervised by a parent or guardian at all times. No alcohol will be served to anyone under 18.

Is the venue accessible?

Yes. A lift serves all three floors and there are no steps within the floors themselves. Our accessible toilet is on the ground floor. We're also located directly outside Hammersmith tube and bus station (served by the Piccadilly, District, Circle, and Hammersmith & City lines), which is fully accessible.

Can we bring our dog?

We're a dog-friendly venue and well-behaved dogs are always welcome. Please keep them on a lead, off the furniture—and bring a towel if the weather calls for it. Many dogs find loud music stressful, which is worth bearing in mind before bringing a pet to a wedding.

Getting Here & Parking

How do I get to Bradmore House?

Hammersmith Underground Station is a two-minute walk away, served by the District, Piccadilly, Circle, and Hammersmith & City lines—making it easy for guests to leave the car at home.

Is parking available near the venue?

Yes. There are several car parks within easy walking distance

of Bradmore House. We strongly recommend pre-booking, as Hammersmith is a busy area and spaces fill quickly, particularly on evenings and weekends.

What are the best parking options?

We recommend the following:

- **St Augustine Car Park**, 55 Fulham Palace Road—approximately 7 minutes' walk. Open 24 hours (closed Sunday mornings). Pre-booking via the ParkBee app is advised.
- **Livat Car Park (Kings Mall)**, Glenthorne Road—approximately 5 minutes' walk. Open 6am—midnight daily.
- **Novotel Car Park**, Chalk Hill Road—approximately 6 minutes' walk. Open 24 hours. Pre-book via JustPark or ParkBee. Please note spaces are narrow and may not suit larger vehicles.

Do I need to book parking in advance?

Yes—we strongly recommend it. You can reserve a spot via JustPark, YourParkingSpace or the ParkBee app.

Is there on-street parking nearby?

On-street parking in the area is heavily restricted. Most streets operate permit holder or pay-and-display rules until 6:30pm, after which some bays may become available free of charge. Where pay-and-display bays are in use, payment can be made via the RingGo app. On-street availability cannot be guaranteed, so we'd recommend pre-booking a nearby car park for peace of mind.

Do you have a loading bay?

Yes. Our loading bay is located in Hammersmith Broadway's upper bus station on the Shepherds Bush Road side. Suppliers can drive up the ramp and veer right into the covered area to drop off.

If you need precise location pinpointing, use what3words:

///switch.sound.turns. Our team can provide full instructions to any supplier before their delivery.

For food and drink deliveries, use the ground floor entrance to Kindred. For all other deliveries, use the stone stairs to the first floor entrance.

Accommodation

Do you offer on-site accommodation?

We don't have overnight accommodation at Bradmore House, but Hammersmith is well-served by excellent hotels within walking distance or a short cab ride. We recommend the following for guests:

- **The Seraphine Hammersmith Hotel**—A 5-minute walk from Kindred. Stylish boutique hotel with clean, comfortable rooms and included breakfast. Ideal for guests seeking a peaceful, intimate base.
- **The Novotel London West**—Approximately 8 minutes' walk. Four-star comfort with a bar and restaurant; ideal for guests wanting a bit more polish. Spacious rooms and a fitness suite available.
- **The Holiday Inn Express London Hammersmith by IHG**—Approximately 7 minutes' walk. Modern, reliable chain offering excellent value. Great for guests who want consistent quality without premium pricing.

All are within easy reach of Hammersmith Underground Station, which connects to all central London areas and airports. We'd recommend sharing hotel details with your guests well in advance so they can book early—Hammersmith is a popular area and rooms fill quickly, especially on weekends.

Your Guests

Can we have a rehearsal dinner or welcome drinks somewhere else?

Absolutely. Many couples host a rehearsal dinner or welcome drinks in one of our spaces (The Cellar, The Library & Salon Bar, or even The Hall if available) the evening before. Forkage fees start at £15 per person if you'd like to bring food in from elsewhere. Please discuss timing and logistics with your event manager.

How much time should we allow for photos before the ceremony?

We recommend arriving 90 minutes before your ceremony time. This gives you time for final preparations, couple portraits in the building, and group photos with your wedding party. Our team will help coordinate timing so you're ready to walk down the aisle on schedule. If you'd like extended photography time (e.g., getting-ready shots), discuss this with your event manager—we may be able to open a quiet room for that purpose.

Can we have a first look (seeing each other before the ceremony)?

Yes, absolutely. We have private spaces available where you can have

a first look before walking down the aisle. Please discuss this with your event manager so we can coordinate logistics and timing.

Can we do a ceremony rehearsal?

Yes. We can arrange a brief rehearsal the day before or on the morning of your wedding, depending on availability. Discuss timing with your event manager when you're finalizing details.

How much space do we have for guests mingling after the ceremony?

Depending on which space you've chosen, you'll have plenty of room. The Hall includes a reception area, lounge space, and bar, with access to an outdoor balcony. The Library flows naturally into the Salon Bar for pre-dinner drinks. Both setups give guests room to move, mingle, and feel comfortable while you're having photos or enjoying a moment together.

What if a guest has a last-minute dietary requirement?

Please let your event manager know as soon as possible. We can usually accommodate most dietary needs with advance notice—vegetarian, plant-based, gluten-free, allergies, religious restrictions. We cater for these individually, and our team is experienced in managing diverse dietary requirements on the day. If it's truly last-minute (day-of), let a member of our team know immediately and we'll do our best to support.

Is there a quiet space for guests who need a break?

If a guest needs to step away from the main celebration—for rest, feeding a baby, sensory break, or any reason—our team can direct them to a quiet space. Just let a staff member know.

Music & Entertainment

Can we have live music or a DJ?

Yes. Discuss your requirements with your event manager. If you're bringing a DJ or live band, our AV engineer is a recommended addition to ensure everything runs smoothly. DJs and bands can use our equipment with prior agreement.

For two-floor takeovers, the first 5 hours of AV engineer support is included as standard. For single-space hire, the AV engineer is £275 + VAT for the first five hours, then £50 + VAT per additional hour.

What's the noise policy?

We have a sound limiter in place as part of our licensing agreement. Our AV engineer will manage levels to keep the celebration high-energy while respecting our neighbours. If you're concerned about volume limitations, discuss this with your event manager when booking.

Can we have a specific first dance song or ceremony music?

Absolutely. Bring a playlist or your chosen songs, and our AV team will ensure they play at exactly the right moment. We work with you on timing for all musical moments—first dance, cake cutting, last song, etc.

Ceremony Details

Can we have a receiving line after the ceremony?

Yes. The reception areas (in The Hall) or the flow between The Library

& Salon Bar work well for this. Our team will help coordinate timing, so guests move smoothly from ceremony to cocktails or dining.

Ceremony & Reception Timeline

What's a typical wedding day timeline at Kindred?

- **10:00am** — Vendor access; setup begins
- **10:30am** — Bridal party arrives; final preparations in Butterwick Room
- **2:00pm** — Guest arrival in The Hall
- **2:15–2:45pm** — Wedding interviews in The Library
- **3:00pm** — Ceremony in The Hall
- **3:30pm** — Group photos and confetti on the balcony
- **4:00pm** — Canapés and fizz in The Library & Salon Bar
- **5:30pm** — Guests seated in The Hall
- **6:00pm** — Wedding breakfast and speeches
- **8:30pm** — Cocktail hour in The Library & Salon Bar
- **9:30pm** — Reception and dancing in The Hall
- **10:00pm** — Late-night food service
- **2:00am** — Carriages (*with 2am late licence extension; standard finish is 11pm*)

Of course, this is flexible. Some couples want a longer cocktail hour; others prefer an earlier dinner. Work with your event manager to customize timing that feels right for your celebration.

Décor & Styling

Can we bring a florist to set up?

Yes. Your florist can access the space the day before (usually from 2pm onwards, depending on availability) or on the morning of your wedding. Discuss timing and any specific setup needs with your event manager. We'll provide access and coordinate logistics so your florist has everything they need.

Can we hang decorations from the walls or ceiling?

Most decorations are fine. We do ask that you avoid:

- Nails or heavy fixtures in Grade II listed elements (we can advise on what's okay)
- Anything that damages the historic woodwork or walls
- Exposed flames
- Smoke or haze machines
- Synthetic confetti or confetti cannons

Everything else—from hanging florals to fabric draping to uplighting—can be discussed with your event manager. We work with you on what's possible and beautiful for your day.

Can we bring our own lighting designer?

Yes. If you're bringing a specialist lighting designer or AV person (beyond our AV engineer), discuss this with your event manager in advance. Our built-in DMX-controlled lighting rig in The Hall is already quite sophisticated, but if you want something more bespoke, we can coordinate.

Photography & Videography

Can photographers/videographers move freely through the spaces?

Yes. Our team will brief your photographer and videographer on access, timing, and any quiet moments (like vows) where we ask them to be discreet. We love good photography and will help facilitate it.

Are there good photo locations in and around the building?

Yes. The Hall itself is stunning for formal portraits. The Library has beautiful natural light. Externally, the Queen Caroline Street façade is a classic Hammersmith backdrop, and the building's architecture photographs beautifully. Our team can suggest timing for light and locations you might not have thought of.

What's your policy on videography during the ceremony?

Video is welcome during the ceremony. Discuss any specific shots or angles your videographer wants with your event manager so we can coordinate.



Accessibility & Comfort

Is the venue fully wheelchair accessible?

Yes. A lift serves all three floors, and there are no steps within the floors themselves. Our accessible toilet is on the ground floor. Hammersmith tube and bus station (directly outside) are fully accessible. If you have specific accessibility questions or needs, please let your event manager know in advance so we can ensure everything is set up perfectly.

Can we arrange mobility support for elderly or less mobile guests?

Yes. Let your event manager know in advance, and we can arrange seating near lifts, accessible routes, and any other accommodations to ensure all guests are comfortable.

Is there somewhere for nursing parents to feed or rest?

Yes. We have private rooms available. Let our team know in advance if you'd like us to set one up with comfortable seating.

Post Wedding

Can we have a morning-after breakfast at Kindred the day after the wedding?

Yes. Discuss this with your event manager—availability, space, and catering options. It's a lovely way to spend time with out-of-town guests or the wedding party before everyone heads home.

What if we want to do a larger celebration or second reception somewhere else?

That's a common choice for couples with guests spread across different cities. We're happy to help think through logistics or recommend other venues in London if needed. Our team can also discuss whether Kindred might work for a rehearsal dinner or welcome event if you're planning celebrations in multiple places.

Can we arrange a kids' table?

Yes, absolutely. We understand families are part of the celebration. The Butterwick Room (seating up to 16) is ideal for children's dining, a dedicated kids' space, or a quieter retreat during your celebration. Discuss this with your event manager when planning your wedding—we'll coordinate menu choices, activities, and any logistics to make it seamless for both the children and you.
