In the 12th century, the site was expanded as part of the Archbishop of Canterbury's estate. The castle has a rich history that dates back to 1080 AD when the first of its many buildings was erected. The castle has been used as a working farm and a convalescent home to Canadian soldiers before becoming an iconic wedding and hospitality venue, with our earliest wedding dating back to 1964. Fast forward to 1978 and the castle was used by Sir Paul McCartney and his rock group Wings to record part of their album Back to the Egg. The castle has left us in awe for many centuries and we would love to share that with you.





Experience both medieval and Edwardian eras in the West Drawing Room (West Wing) of Lympne Castle. The room, added during the castle's restoration by architect Sir Robert Lorimer, boasts a stunning view from its large bow window facing the southeast coast. The wood panelling and stone fireplace add to the room's warm and imposing ambiance, making it the perfect setting for your ceremony with a seating capacity of up to 90 guests or your wedding breakfast for up to 50 guests.













In the Great Hall at Lympne Castle, panelled walls, wooden roof beams, and gothic arched windows transport you to a time of lively conversation, clinking goblets, and musical feasts. Perfect for a grand civil ceremony, this room can accommodate up to 120 guests and a wedding breakfast for up to 90.
